My thanks to Barbara for the judging invitation, it was my first experience as a judge at this very enjoyable show, and to the other Barbara (James), for her very good company as my steward.

## **BREED CLASSES**

### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Male**

**GD PC – Cosgrove's PR BETHANJO THEODORE (24n) MN 18/06/07.** A large handsome neuter boy of very good type. Medium length wedge with wide top of head and very large, fairly well flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with gentle expression and mid blue colour. Strong straight profile, chin okay, bite just about level. Long strong body with excellent substance and tone, long strong limbs, well tapered tail to almost balance. Excellent points colouring, sludgy toned blue-based caramel. Off-white coat that was fairly heavily shaded in brownish blue, but contrast still seen, very good for overall length and texture. Handled beautifully and was excellently presented.

### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Female**

**GD PC – Cook's PR TIANLEX PRETTY FLAMINGO (32a) FN 05/09/10.** A very stylish female, very elegant yet substantial. Super head from the front view, lovely top and very large flared ears set wide. Oriental eye shape set and expression, colour mid blue. Profile not so attractive as there is quite a pronounced bump to the end of her nose, chin good and bite level. Excellent weight and tone to long elegant body, long slender limbs and spoon paws, whip tail almost balances. Excellent rich red points with warm white coat that was almost clear of shading, excellent for length and texture. Very wriggly but not unfriendly. I did hesitate over the certificate because of the profile, but in the end decided that the other excellent qualities that she has outweigh this small problem. Beautifully presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – R w/h – Watson's PR MALIKASIAM SAEEDA (24a) FN 07/10/07.** A neat lady neuter of good type. Shorter but well balanced wedge with good top and large ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set, colour needs to be deeper. Almost straight profile, reasonable chin, bite untidy and marginally over. Body of medium length and far too comfortably covered to show any elegance, fine limbs and neat spoon paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Attractive wedgewood blue points colour, almost matching. Coat shows some glacial tones to bib and tummy but is heavily shaded over the back in fawnish blue, texture sleek and close lying. Very shy but sweet tempered. Excellently presented.

### **British Blue Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Walker's PERCEPTIBLY JEWEL (16) F 28/03/11.** An attractive baby albeit a touch dainty for 6 months. Well rounded head with good width to skull, and small ears set well, slight cheeks. Round eyes with very good expression and mid gold colour. Good profile with short nose, chin good and bite level, tends to puff out whisker pads. Body of medium length, deceptively cobby and weighty, short limbs and neat round paws, well shaped tail to balance. Paler blue coat that was almost

sound to roots, a little baby long and soft at present but really dense. Excellent temperament, purred throughout, excellently presented.

#### **British Blue-Cream/Lilac Tortie/Fawn Tortie Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> BOB w/h – Worsley-Waring’s SATINMIST FAIRY FLAVIA (21c) F 04/06/11.** A tiny babe of fairly good type, only just old enough to be here today. Top of head well rounded but she is rather wedge shaped in the muzzle, ears fairly small but the setting is not quite correct with a tendency to bonnet. Profile correct with short nose, good chin and level bite. Round eyes, colour still developing, but mid gold beginning to show through. Dainty but fairly well covered little body, neat limbs and paws, medium length tail to balance. Pretty pinkie-toned lilac tortie coat colour, well mingled overall in mid cream, with the odd hotter fleck here and there, soundness good. Kitten coat with long wispy guard hairs at present. A sweet person, not up to BOB today but she is very young and could improve as she grows.

#### **A.C. British Colourpointed Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Newman’s MOORMIST MODESTY (40 1) F 25/04/11.** A strong and well developed kitten of good type. Round head with very good width to skull, ears medium in size at present but very well set, cheeks beginning to show. Round eyes with good expression and clear blue colour. Rounded forehead, nose marginally long but well shaped, firm chin and level bite. Cobby and substantial body with a lovely feel to it, short limbs and rounded paws, well shaped medium length tail. Warm seal points almost matched for tone, tail shows ghost ringing at present. Warm toned cream coloured coat almost completely unshaded, perhaps a touch long but texture very promising and developing some crispness. Lovely temperament, an easy baby to handle, excellently presented.

#### **A.C. Oriental Bicolour Neuter**

**PC & BOB – Johnson’s & Norman’s IMP GD CH INLAY JOOP VAN SCALINJO (48) MN 28/06/05.** Good to see this handsome chap embarking on a new career as a neuter. Strong head with good top line and very large well set ears. Oriental shape to eyes with such a noble expression and yellowish green colour. Strong profile with broad imposing nose, not very happy to have his mouth looked at today, it was a little untidy and sore, but bite appeared reasonably level. Long strong body which still retains his masculine musculature, long strong limbs and good tail. Excellent coat pattern, a very good balance between the black, which was sound, and just over the one third white. White areas correct with fairly wide line right down the tummy, on all four limbs and on the face, with nice tidy edges where the two colours meet, and the length and texture was excellent today. Handled well as always. Excellently presented.

**Also considered for BOB – Fremont’s GD PR LUNATORA CATCHMIFYOUCAN (48 43s) MN 15/06/10.** Another handsome chap, unlucky to be up against the other lad for BOB today. He is really huge but is beginning to fine down and has lost some of his puppy fat. Longer wedge, top line need to be a touch wider for balance, ears large and well set. Oval shape to eyes of pale green and a slightly innocent expression. Strong profile and chin with level bite. Very long and really substantial body, could do with losing a bit more for elegance, long limbs and super long tail to balance. High white with about one quarter pattern, a ticked based shaded with silver under-coat right up the hair shaft, length and texture excellent,

some tarnishing to muzzle and front limbs. A very relaxed boy, easy to handle. Excellently presented.

#### **Oriental Longhair Neuter**

**BOB – Ellis’ IMP GD PR MYLYNN MOONSHADOW (62 20) MN 09/12/06.** A lovely boy with excellent type and size. Lovely head with excellent top and large open based, well furnished ears set to balance. Excellent expression to well shaped eyes of vivid green. Strong, straight, broad nose with deep chin and level bite. Long weighty body, strong boned limbs and well tufted oval paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Jet black spotting with fairly good pattern for an OLH, spine line typically linked but side spotting only marginally so and they are quite sound. Excellent coat texture, fine and silky with well furnished plume, could be a little longer down the sides for perfection. A super boy to handle, excellently presented.

**Also considered for BOB – Whitby’s IMP GD PR PIPPASTRO MAGIK FLUTE (62 43 fn) MN 07/07/07.** Lovely for type, but just pipped for the BOB today because the other boy was more masculine. Stylish head - albeit a touch effeminate, excellent top line and large beautifully furnished ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set with sweet expression and excellent vivid green colour. Straight profile and firm chin, bite clean and level. Long elegant and surprisingly weighty body, quite strong boned limbs and neat oval well tufted paws, tail needs at least an inch. Apricot colouring to body and tail excellent, with very hot tones, colouring to head less intense and more hot cream. Coat excellent for length and texture, shaded pattern somewhat dubious but it is very difficult to tell with a OLH of this colour. A dear boy to handle, he really is a big time waster. Presented to perfection as always.

#### **Seal Point Siamese Adult**

**CC & BOB – Hargan’s ADELGAM CHARITY (24) F 25/11/10.** A dainty and stylish lady with some maturing to do, but she is acceptable for 10 months. Stylish head type with very good width between large flared ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape with wicked expression, colour mid blue. Almost straight profile, chin good and bite level. Long slender body with weight in keeping with size, long spidery limbs and neat paws, whip tail needs an inch to balance. Dark dense seal points, a little on the cool side, pale beige coat with medium shading to tone and short sleek texture. Rather cross but I managed to handle her okay. Excellently presented.

**Also considered for BOB – Jordan’s CH ADNIOAM TALIA (24) F 26/12/08.** Lovely size and substance to this lady of good type. Fairly well balanced head, top line could be marginally wider, ears of good size and set. Almond eye shape, setting good, colour could be deeper for a seal. Good profile and chin with level bite, quite a pronounced pinch today and thus tending to square off the muzzle somewhat. Body long and elegant yet really substantial for a female, long limbs and tail. Dense seal points with some warmth of tone, fairly heavily shaded coat of very good close lying texture. A very talkative lady, excellently presented.

#### **Tabby Point Siamese Adult**

**BOB – Davis’ CH DORAL KID KREOLE (32/5) M 11/07/09.** A lovely boy, very stylish indeed. Excellent head with wide top line and large wide beads ears beautifully set. Excellent shape set and expression to eyes, colour could be a touch deeper. Small dip to profile, good chin and level bite. Long elegant and well muscled body with

long tail to balance. Muted red tabby markings, rather lacking in brightness, tail shows good rings. Lightly shaded, warm white coat of rather soft and fine texture but lying reasonably close. An easy boy to handle. Presented in top condition.

**Tortie Point Siamese Adult**

**BOB – Cook's CH JOHPAS MIZ MIXTURE (32b2) F 14/07/10.** A gorgeous lady who never changes – said it all before, almost perfect in every way and a joy to judge. Beautifully presented as always.
