## Breed Classes

### A.C. Grand Premier Neuter Male

**GC PC – Lord & Lord’s PR FIRODILISO PANM REDPANTHER (37d) MN 30/06/10.** A very stylish boy with maturity in keeping with age. Well balanced medium length wedge with very good top line and lovely large flared ears very well set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with yellowish green colour. Slight rise between eyes to profile, deep strong chin lines up with the nose tip, bite untidy and surprisingly is marginally over. Well defined neck, long weighty but elegant body, tail almost balances. Rich red coat with some indistinct spotting evident, red to roots. Super coat texture, very short sleek and close-lying. An easy boy to handle, excellently presented.

### A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Neuter Male

**1<sup>st</sup> GD PC w/h – Barber’s PR ARTENSA ROCK MY BOAT (24n) MN 20/05/10.** This boy is ultra stylish but unfortunately he is effeminate looking for a male, if he had been a female I would have had no hesitation in awarding the certificate. Super head with wide top line and huge wide based ears beautifully set. Oriental eye shape and set with excellent expression and deep brilliant sapphire colour. Slight bump between the eyes to profile, good chin, bite scissored over, small pinch to muzzle. Long body that was weightier than it looked and with a good firm tone to it, long dainty limbs and whip tail to balance. Excels for points colour, a dark sludgy toned blue-based caramel with clear brownish overtones to tail in particular. Off-white coat that was a little long and fine in texture, shaded overall in muddy tones. The sweetest temperament, excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Turvey’s PR STYPERSON BIJOU (24b) MN 07/08/06.** An old friend of good type and style. Longer wedge with good top line, ears of good size set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour, haws up a touch today. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Long weighty but elegant body of good length, long limbs, tail almost balances. Points colour a dark chocolate with just a little warmth of tone apparent on the front limbs only. Some tonal shading to ivory coat of very good length and texture. A very dear boy, wearing his years well, a shame he is so dark. Excellently presented.

### Havana Adult

**1<sup>st</sup> CC w/h – Sarpe-Popple’s DENSON DIONYSUS (29) F 29/04/10.** A well developed female of fairly good type. Medium length wedge, top of head requires more width between ears that could be larger and wider at the base. Eye shape almost round and lacking oriental expression but colour very good, a clear mid green. Good profile and chin with level bite, small pinch to muzzle. Longish weighty body with long limbs and neat oval paws, tail well tapered but needs an inch to balance. Coat

colour and texture completely wrong today, it was a good warm tone but showed evidence of sun-bleaching in many places, there was also a good deal of tabby ghosting on the sides and extensive ticking interspersed throughout the coat, it was a little long and far too soft and fine for an oriental cat. Hopefully she is just changing her coat and it will improve. Easy to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Spendlove's DENSON CAROLINA (29) F 31/08/07.** A neat little queen, type good but she was small for a mature girl. Shorter wedge head, top line rather narrow and the ears need to be larger for balance. Oval shaped eyes of mid green. Profile almost straight, just a small bump near the tip of the nose, - particularly emphasised when she swore at me, firm chin and level bite. Well covered medium length body with good weight for size, tail rather short for balance. Lovely warm toned Havana coat, correct for the SOP, unfortunately today is was very unsound with paler undercoat to almost three quarters the way up the hair shaft and she also showed extensive tabby ghosting, texture too soft and fine. Difficult to handle, she appeared to be frightened more than anything and was better in her pen. Very well presented.

**Considered for BOB only but not awarded – Sharp-Popple's CH DENSON CHRISTINE CAGNEY (29) F 05/04/10.** This girl was also small for an adult, type fair only with short unbalanced head that needed much bigger ears and a wider top line. Eyes almost round in shape with pale green colour. Good warm coat colour but texture wrong, could be the time of year but it is far too fine and lacks sleekness and close ness to the body. Handled fairly well.

#### **Oriental Black Adult**

**Considered for BOB only but not awarded – Hirst's CH TOGHAR PUTASPELLON YOU (37) F 30/10/09.** This girl looked out of balance today, the head was marginally longer than ideal, top line good and ears well set. Eyes could be a touch more oriental in shape set and expression, colour pale green. Dip in profile, chin and bite okay. Good substance to long body, tail a little short and has a pronounced knobble at the tip. Good sleek dense back coat of very good texture and sound. Excellent temperament. I have seen her looking better.

#### **Oriental Tortoiseshell Adult**

**Considered for BOB only and awarded – Moore's CH KINKAJEWSDEN EILEENNA (37p) F 31/10/09.** Good size and substance to this lady of very good type. Well balanced medium wedge with very good top line and large open based ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape set and expression with yellowish green colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Long strong body with long slender limbs and neat paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Most attractive coat for colour, brownish toned caramel, plentifully mingled with warm apricot, sound to roots and of generally good close texture, it was just a little harsh over the lower back today. Excellent temperament and excellently presented.

#### **Chocolate Point Siamese Adult**

**CC & BOB – Gray & Johnson's TSAICHIN SUMMER SOLSTACE (24b) F 12/04/10.** A big strong girl of very good type and style. Very good head with wide top line and large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with bright mid blue colour. Strong roman profile, chin rounds off a touch and the bite is marginally scissored over. Excellent length and strength to body for a female, elegant limbs and

spoon paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Chocolate points on the dark side but they are redeemed by a good deal of warmth of tone, shows a touch of brindling to the mask and tail today. Coat quite heavily shaded for a chocolate, particularly for one so young, but she still has good contrast, coat length good, texture a little soft and slightly open today. Lovely temperament and excellently presented.

#### **Cinnamon Point Siamese Adult**

**Considered for BOB only and awarded. – Ridgeway's GD CH HARTZIE BLAZE-OF-GLORY (24k) M 05/06/09** This boy has the most endearing nature, of good type and style, he now has very good size and substance to him, but he just lacks that oomph factor. Medium length wedge, top line good but ears need to be larger for balance. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Good profile and chin with level-ish bite. Well toned, comfortably covered body, fairly long limbs, tail needs an inch to balance. Lovely warm spicy-toned cinnamon points with pale, almost clear and unshaded coat of slightly fine texture today. Handled well and was excellently presented.

#### **Caramel Point Siamese Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Bowles-Gowdy's MAFDET MANJULA (24n) F 01/04/11.** A promising and well grown kitten. Stylish head with good top line and large flared ears excellently set. Basic eye shape good, tends to hold a touch wide at times, colour okay though ideally could be deeper, one eye tends to wander – due to teething perhaps? Good profile and chin, bite level and yes, she is teething. Firm little body of good length and tone, dainty limbs and paws, good whip tail to balance. Points colour promising at this stage, it is early days, but there does appear to be some brownish tone to the base of the ears and the tail. Coat of good close texture for a baby, unshaded. A confident young miss with an super temperament. Excellently presented.

#### **Tabby Point Siamese Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Bowles-Gowdy's MYLYNN MISS-MIMOSA (32t1) F 01/02/11.** A gorgeous baby, super type and beautifully grown. Strong typy head with excellent top and huge butterfly ears with attractive lynx tips, excellently set. Oriental eye shape and set with excellent expression, colour acceptable but could be a touch deeper for a seal torte-tabby. Good profile and chin with level bite, tiny pinch today. Long firm and weighty body with long limbs and long tail. Points excellent, a very good balance between tortie and tabby, shows lovely tiger moth mottling on the ears and some red on the tail, tabby pattern well defined with fairly good tail rings. Lightly shaded coat of very good length and texture for a kitten. Lovely to handle and presented to perfection..

#### **Seal Point Siamese Neuter**

**PC & BOB – Powell's SHERMESE JENNY WREN (24) FN 16/01/10.** A neat young lady neuter of good type and style. Medium wedge with good top of head and large ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set, colour acceptable but could ideally be deeper for a seal. Slight dip to profile centre nose, chin okay, she was most reluctant to have her bite examined, but then it was rather sore with one or two incisors missing already, appeared to be level. Slender and well toned body of good length with long dainty limbs and long tail to balance. Lovely warm seal points, good to see, pale beige coat with medium shading to tone, length and texture very good. Sweet natured and excellently presented.

**Chocolate Point Siamese Neuter**

**PC & BOB – Mawson & Weston’s BEACONHILL COCO TANG (24b) MN 31/03/10.** Excellent size to this stylish lad of very good type. Stylish head with very good top line and large fared ears set to balance. Eye shape and set good, although he does tend to widen them a little, colour acceptable but could ideally be a touch deeper. Straight strong profile and firm chin with level bite. Excellent substance and tone to long strong body, long strong limbs and tapered tail that almost balances. Chocolate points a tad dark but fairly warm in tone. Virtually unshaded coat of good close texture. Handled well and was excellently presented.
