BREED CLASSES

A.V. Oriental Champion Female

GD CC – Simpson’s CH BARBECCO ELONIA (37k) F 21/03/09. Lovely type and overall style to this lady – a good start to the day. Stylish head type with wide top line and very large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with snooty expression, colour rather amber toned and could be better, but there is some green evident. Almost straight profile with just a marginal dip to nose, really deep strong chin and level bite, tiny pinch to muzzle. Long well defined neck, long slender and well toned body, long slender limbs and super long whippy tail to balance. Rich warm cinnamon coat with minimal ghosting and completely sound, excellent for length with short sleek and close-lying texture. A little shy, but gentle and easy to handle, excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Male

GD PC – Webb’s CH LITTLEFEAT TEXAS TWISTER (32a) MN05/03/10. This chap has really put on some substance since we last met, he is still somewhat effeminate but not unreasonably so and his type is excellent. Lovely head balance and style with excellent top line and large flared ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with excellent depth of colour and brilliance of tone. Straight strong profile with firm chin and level bite. Long slender but surprisingly weighty body, with long elegant limbs and tail to balance. Bright red points colour with warm white coat of excellent close texture, completely unshaded. Handled beautifully and was presented to perfection .

R – Shore’s PR ROYSTERER RAZZLEDAZZE (32/9) MN20/02/09. A large but elegant neuter boy of very good type. Longer wedge with the top line just marginally narrow for true balance, ears of very good size, set a touch close. Very good eye shape and set with excellent depth of colour, particularly for a fawn tabby. Strong profile with broad nose that was a touch longer than ideal, good chin and bite. Long substantial and well toned body, long limbs and tail. Pale rosy fawn tabby markings with very good tail rings. Virtually unshaded coat of very good length and texture. An easy boy to handle and beautifully presented

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Female

GD PC – Rowe’s CH & PR FOXPAWS MELISANDE (24) FN 20/04/09. Overall this is a neat and well balanced girl. Even medium length wedge with good top of head and large open based ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set with sweet expression and very good depth of colour. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Good length to body with a very nice firm and trim tummy line for a neuter lady, dainty limbs and neat paws, tail almost balances. Dense warm toned seal points

and warm toned medium shading to coat of gorgeous texture. The sweetest temperament, very friendly indeed. Excellently presented.

A.C. British Colourpointed (Ex Cinnamon & Fawn) Kitten

1st & BOB – Blackbourne’s GLAMCATS ANGEL PRINCESS (40 8) FN 15/11/10. Neat and tidy female of overall good type, perhaps a touch small for her age but of good weight for size. Head generally well rounded but she does puff out her whisker pads, which tends to square off the muzzle a little, good width to skull with small ears set well apart. Round eyes with good open expression, colour clear blue on the periphery with pupils very enlarged today. Definition between rounded forehead and short nose perhaps a little shallower than ideal, firm chin and level bite. Medium length compact and cobby body, short limbs and neat round paws, medium length tail with rounded tip. Pretty paler blue tortie points colour, with plentiful mingling in mid and pale cream on all points. Coat marginally long but fairly crisp in texture, and it was virtually clear of body shading. The sweetest temperament and excellently presented.

Oriental Spotted Tabby Kitten Male

1st – Stevenson’s SYBELLA SPOTTED DICK (38k) M 23/02/11. A well grown little boy of good type. Longer wedge head with fairly good top line, ears large and flared but set marginally close for balance. Oriental eye shape and set, colour still developing with green beginning to show through. Good profile and chin with level bite. Firm little body of good length with long limbs, tail of good length and very well tapered, but unfortunately has a fixed deviation at the tip that is visible. Well defined cinnamon spotted pattern with minimal agouti invasion, there is little linkage behind the fore arms, but spotting otherwise very good with well broken spine line and two broken necklaces, pattern virtually sound to roots. Coat very short and close lying. Lovely temperament – such a shame about the tail. Excellently presented.

Oriental Spotted Tabby Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Stevenson’s SYBELLA STARAPEAL (38n) F 24/02/11. Litter sister to the above but much better balanced than her brother. Medium wedge with very good top line, ears are large enough at present and very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with good expression and lovely clear mid green colour. Straight profile, firm chin and level bite. Firm body of good length with fine limbs and neat oval paws, longish tail with a blunt tip. Lilac based caramel spotted pattern on paler ground, nicely sound with minimal linkage and agouti invasion, spine well broken, super spotty tummy. Very good length and texture to coat. Overall a promising kitten – I hope she keeps her spots. Excellent temperament and presentation.

Oriental Longhair Neuter

BOB – Fullerton’s GD PR STARAPPEAL SCENE STEALER (62 43a) MN 25/10/08. A very handsome male neuter with lovely size and substance. Longer wedge with good top of head, ears large, well furnished and very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with such a dignified expression, colour a rather yellow toned green. Straight strong profile with broad nose, good chin and bite. Very good length, weight and tone to body, long strong limbs and large well tufted oval paws, tail rather short for balance.

Coat colour a darker cool toned blue and the shading is quite heavy for a mature cat. Overall coat length very good. he does have quite a well defined ruff which is not

ideal but does not detract, plume very well furnished. Coat texture excellent, very fine and silky. A joy to handle, excellently presented.

Seal Point Siamese Adult Male

CC – Hall & Hall's FURFACE MARIO LS (24) M 27/08/10. A young lad of very good type whom I have given a CC to very recently, he still has a fair amount of maturing to do but is improving. Lovely head with excellent top line and very large ears set wide. Good eye shape and set perhaps held slightly wide, colour mid blue that could be more brilliant in tone. Profile a little uneven, chin has depth but slips away somewhat, bite level. Very good body type, long and elegant with lovely substance and tone, long limbs and tail to almost balance. Mid seal points with a good deal of warmth of tone, contrasting well with its pale, almost unshaded creamy coat of super close texture. Handled perfectly as always and excellently presented.

BOB – Hall & Hall's CH FURRYFACE BERLINGTONBERTIE (24) M 26/12/08. A strong, mature, well balanced boy of very good type. Masculine head of medium length with very good top line and large open based ears very well set. Good shape set and expression to eyes of mid blue colour. Very good profile and chin with level bite. Long strong body with long limbs and longish tail. Warm seal points with medium shaded creamy coat, length and texture good today. A handsome boy who handled well despite his shyness. Excellently presented.

Also considered for BOB – Gillen's CH OWAISSA MASTER CRAFTSMAN (24) M 07/12/09. An attractive male but lacking the masculinity and head strength of the BOB winner. Type very good and his points colouring shows good warmth of tone, however, his coat is quite heavily shaded for a relative youngster and it appears to show evidence of over-grooming on the lower back which tends to spoil the overall appearance. Lovely temperament.

Seal Point Siamese Adult Female

CC – Atkinson's OWAISSA HOO LA BALOO (24) F 06/12/07. An attractive big girl of good type. Well balanced medium wedge with good top of head and large ears well set. Almond shaped eyes well set, colour could be a touch deeper. Good straight profile and firm chin with level bite. Very good substance and tone to long body, long elegant limbs, tapered tail almost balances. Points colour tending to the black side of seal but the front limbs do show a modicum of warmth of tone. Coat colouring also lacks a little warmth, with medium shading overall to tone with the points, length and texture very good. Rather cross but I suspect she was coming into call. Excellently presented.

2nd – Rathbone's BELLIS TAWNY (24) F 23/08/10. A dainty little queen still rather kitten-like at present. Neat medium length wedge, top line okay, ears just about large enough and fairly well set. Eyes, perhaps a touch exaggerated in shape and set, with haws up today, colour mid blue. Good profile and firm chin with level bite. Dainty but surprisingly weighty body of medium length, dainty limbs and paws, tail almost balances. Cool toned seal points with a little brindling on the mask. Coat more white than cream in colour, but contrast good, just lightly shaded to tone. Lovely temperament, very easy to handle. Excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Adult Female

BOB – Williams’ ROYSTERER FREYJA (32/9) F 20/02/09. A stylish girl with excellent substance and lovely colouring. Very good head type with wide top line and large wide based ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with good expression, colour excellent, deep brilliant blue. Profile almost straight, just a small bump near the tip of the nose, chin firm, bite untidy with several incisors missing, but appears reasonably level. Long substantial and well toned body, long tail with a slightly suspect tip to it. Pretty pale fawn tabby markings with well ringed tail. Superb coat qualities, excellent for length and texture and completely unshaded. Excellent temperament, a very poised and confident lady, excellently presented.

Seal Point Siamese Neuter Male

BOB – Howard & Hanby’s GD PR AMARRICHI PRICELESS PRINCE (24) MN 15/05/07. A very dear boy with some good qualities. Even medium wedge, perhaps lacking a little in style but nevertheless very even and well balanced. Gentle expression to eyes with good colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Good length to body that was fairly weighty and well toned, long limbs and tail to balance. Warm seal points colour, pale beige coat with medium shading overall, good contrast still seen, medium in length and fairly close lying. Such an easy boy to handle, he is certainly an appealing chap. Excellently presented.

Also considered for BOB - Rowe’s CH & PR FOXPAWS MELISANDE (24) FN 20/04/09

Chocolate Point Siamese Neuter

PC & BOB – Blackbourne’s PLEZETOBE PRINCE CHARMING (24b) MN 15/05/08. An attractive boy perhaps a touch effeminate looking, but typy and stylish and he is not without substance. Well balanced medium wedge with very good top and large flared ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set with naughty expression and very good depth of colour. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Body of good length when stretched out and it was surprisingly substantial, long limbs and tail. Darker but very warm toned points colour, ivory coat with minimal shading, length and texture very good. Excellent temperament and presentation.

Also considered for BOB – Morgan’s PR ASTRALBLAESE ACHILLIES (24) MN22/03/08. An attractive boy but somewhat overlong in the head. Eye shape and set good with good depth of colour. Almost straight profile, chin okay, bite untidy but level. Very long, elegant but weighty body, long slender limbs, tail rather short for balance. Points colour dark for the breed and lack warmth of tone. Coat length and texture good with a little shading to tone. Very shy today but handled well. Excellently presented.
