A.C. Oriental Grand Premier Male

IMP – Titterall's GD PR BABADAG ASIFBYMAJIK (37) MN 06/01/09. An excellent male neuter with a strong and stylish head. Medium length wedge with wide top line and very large well flared ears set to balance. Excellent expression to eyes, really snooty and superior, colour olive green. Profile almost straight, just marginally flat above the brow line, chin good, bite untidy with several incisors missing but appeared to be level. Long elegant but weighty body, long limbs and super whip tail to balance. Sleek glossy black coat, sound to roots, length and texture excellent. Handled well today, beautifully poised and presented.

A.C. Oriental Grand Premier Female

1st IMP w/h – Whiston's GD PR MYOKO CHIQUITITA (48 45bs) FN 21/11/08. A neat & tidy lady neuter, type very good. Even medium wedge head with good sized ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with yellowish green colour. Almost straight profile, just a slight dip to nose, chin firm, bite untidy with a few teeth missing, but level. Firm little body of good length, fine limbs and neat paws, good length tail to balance. Attractive Bicolour pattern with about half white to colour, chocolate ticking very dark indeed with the double whammy of silver and white clearly effecting the tone. White in all the correct places and pristine clean. Coat length very good, short and close lying. Easy to handle, a lady who is very correct overall, but for me, lacks that extra style for an Imperial certificate. Excellently presented.

British Blue Kitten

1st & BOB – Conway's COLINSWOOD CALEB (16) M 14/06/11. A really well grown kitten and very promising for type and coat. Well shaped head – perhaps a tad square in the muzzle but he is teething with double canines present, ears small and set well apart. Good profile with neat short nose, chin lines up with the nose tip, bite level. Eyes round and open with deep gold colour developing. Dear little baby body, weighty and fairly cobby already, short strong limbs and well shaped tail to balance. Powder blue coat that was sound to roots, it was short and dense with very good texture for a baby. The sweetest temperament and excellently presented.

Havana Neuter

PC & BOB – Sharpe-Popple's GD CH DENSON LOUISIANA (29) FN 31/08/07. A mature lady neuter of overall good type. Longer wedge head that needs a touch more width between her fairly large ears for balance. Almond shaped eyes well set, olive green in colour. Profile almost straight, chin okay, bite untidy but level, pinch to muzzle. Well toned body of fairly good length, longish limbs and tail. Coat very good for colour, a rich warm Havana that was sound to roots, and it was this that earned her the certificate today, coat length good, texture a touch soft and fine, and there was some evidence of scurf at the base of the tail. Excellent to handle.

Oriental Fawn Neuter

BOB – Baxter’s – IMP GD PR SOLARUS CATHY’S CLOWN (37r) MN 28/07/05. Long time no see this handsome chap. Looking good for his age, he is strong yet elegant. Good head type and style with good width between his large well set ears. Super eyes for shape set and expression, with really vivid green colour. Profile has become rather uneven with flat skull and dip to nose, chin excellent for depth and lines up with the nose tip, bite untidy but level. Long weighty body with fairly good tone for a neuter boy of this age, long limbs and tail. Darker fawn colour to coat, sound to roots, perhaps a touch long and fine in texture. Such a friendly boy, it is always a pleasure to meet him. Excellently presented

Oriental Bicolour Neuter Male

Considered for BOB - Fremont’s PR LUNATORA CATCHMEIFYOUCAN (48 43s) MN 15/06/10. An impressive boy for size, type good. Longer wedge with fairly good width between large well set ears. Eyes oval in shape and set well, expression a touch innocent still, colour paler green. Strong profile and firm chin with level bite. Very long weighty body that still needs to fine down a touch, long limbs and tail. Approximately three quarter white to ticked based shaded pattern, a little tarnishing to muzzle and front paws, coat length and texture excellent today. Handled beautifully as always. Excellently presented.

Oriental Bicolour Neuter Female

PC & BOB – Fremont’s LUNATORA ARIANASTAR (48 43s) FN 25/08/07. An well balanced lady of good type. Even medium length wedge with good top line and large ears set to follow. Well shaped eyes, albeit a touch large in proportion to the head, but colour excellent, a deep vivid green. Almost straight profile, good depth to chin and level bite. Comfortably covered body of good length, whip tail to almost balance. White to colour about half, shading quite heavy for age, and I am not entirely sure she is not ticked rather than ticked-based shaded. White areas attractively balanced with nice even inverted “v” to face. Super texture to coat, beautifully sleek and close which gained her the BOB today. Excellent to handle, a very vocal lady. Excellently presented.

Red Point Siamese Adult

CC & BOB – Reed’s JOHPAS RITA SKEETER (32a) F 12/11/10. Stylish lady, perhaps a touch dainty as yet, but acceptably so for 10 months. Lovely head with wide top line and very large wide-based ears excellently set. Super eyes for shape set and expression with deep and brilliant sapphire blue colour. Good profile and firm chin with a dear little beard, bite level. Long slender body with long fine limbs and long whip to balance. Points colour appeared to be a slightly washed out red but yellow hall lighting not helpful, warm white coat completely un-shaded, slightly fine in texture today. A little shy but handled well. Excellently presented.

Seal Point Siamese Kitten

1st & BOB – Sibley’s ATARIQ ROSSINI (24) M 26/06/11. A gorgeous little boy, very promising for type. Strong head with excellent top line and oh my, those ears,

huge jug-handled jobs set much too low at present, but that's okay because he is a baby and hopefully he will grow into them. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Tiny baby growth dips to profile, chin firm, bite scissored over at present. Solid little body of promising length, whippy tail to balance. Dark and slightly cool toned seal points, warmer in tone on the front limbs, un-shaded pale beige coat with very good texture for a baby. A super little person – my take home of the day! Excellently presented.

Apricot Point Siamese Kitten

1st & BOB – Reed's JOHPAS JESSIE JAY (32fn) F 23/04/11. This baby has come on since we last met and is looking much better balanced. Stylish head with very good top line, ears large flared and very well set. Well shaped eyes, marginally straight set at present, colour good. Almost straight profile, good depth to chin, bite scissored over at present. Long slender body with weight appropriate to size, long limbs and tail to balance. Warm apricot points, darker on the tail. Unshaded off-white coat with soft fine baby texture. Smashing temperament, made wonderful puddings for me. Excellently presented.

Lilac Point Siamese Neuter

BOB – Sibley's GD PR ATARIQ FIORI (24c) MN 25/01/09. A large handsome male neuter of very good type. Long-ish wedge with good top of head, ears large and well set. Oriental eye shape and set with good blue colour. Dip to profile centre nose, firm chin and level bite. Well defined neck and long well toned body, long limbs and tapered tail to almost balance. Darker lilac points with some pinkish tones evident, lightly shaded magnolia coat with very good close texture. Super to handle, a very friendly boy, excellently presented in a double pen.
