OPEN CLASSES

Lilac Point Adult Female

CC & BOB – Dickenson's PURMISQUS MAIHONSONG LILY 08/11/09. An attractive young female of good type and style. Medium length wedge with good top of head and large ears set to almost balance. Oriental shape to eyes, marginally straight set, colour bright mid blue. Tiny dip to profile centre nose, good chin and level bite. Good length to body with an excellent weighty and solid feel to her, long elegant limbs and well tapered tail to balance. Lilac points marginally dark but the correct tone, with tail in particular showing good pinkish tones. Super coat qualities, virtually un-shaded magnolia with wonderful close texture. Super to handle and excellently presented

Seal Point Adult Female

CC & BOB – Brinton's BRINDI ZUMBAH 20/10/09. Dainty young queen of good type. Fairly well balanced head although nose marginally longer than ideal, but top of head good and her large ears are well set. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour. Almost straight profile and firm chin, bite just about meets. Excellent substance and tone to deceptively weighty body of good length, long dainty limbs and good tail to balance. Dark but warm seal points nicely matched. Short close coat shows excellent creamy tones with minimal shading. A friendly girl excellently presented

2nd – Richards' MAFDET BOBBIESOCKS 27/03/06. A very stylish queen who should have been my winner on type, but for a very overshot bite. Mature and very well balanced overall, with very good top line to head and large flared ears wide set. Good shape and set to eyes that she can widen from time to time, colour good. Almost straight profile, chin could be stronger with the aforementioned over bite. Very long and elegant body which could be a little weightier for her size, persistent calling perhaps? Long whippy tail. Dark dense seal points showing a little warmth of tone. Pale beige coat with medium shading to tone, perhaps a touch long and fine but lying fairly close. An easy girl to handle, excellently presented.

Tabby Point Adult Female

CC & BOB – Brinton's BRINDI SHIKANA (32/8) 24/03/09. A neat little queen of good type. Medium length wedge with good top of head and fairly large ears well set. Eye shape a touch full, but she was rather shy, colour bright mid blue. Small dip to nose, chin good and bite level. Very good substance and lovely tone to long body,

slender limbs an neat paws, tail almost balances. Very good tabby pattern with multi tail rings, colour not clearly blue based caramel as yet and I would like to see more brownish tones to her markings, but her tail is appropriately very dark and she is still young. Coat the correct off-white colour with fairly heavy shading for age, coat length and texture excellent. A very sweet lady, excellently presented.

Red Point Adult Female

CC – Cook’s HELSBELS LADYGAGA 06/09/09. A very attractive and stylish young queen. Well balanced medium wedge with very good top of head and large nicely flared ears set to follow. Good shape to eyes that she can widen from time to time, better when relaxed, colour bright mid blue. Straight profile with firm chin and level bite. Excellent substance to long body with a really solid feel to her, she was much weightier than she looked, long slender limbs, tail short for balance. Bright red points, paler on the tail and paler still on the front limbs. Wonderful coat, beautifully short and close, virtually un-shaded. Excellent temperament, condition and presentation. Ran the BOB winner very close.

Judged for BOB only and awarded – Reed’s CH HELSBELS CHUCHOTEZ-LE 11/09/09. From the catalogue these two ladies are litter sisters, despite the differing DOB, and they are similar in many ways. This lady has a little more flash and strength of head, but her body tone and weight is not as good, and her coat is not as short and close – persistent calling perhaps? However, she does have that special expression, and her points colour is an excellent vibrant red, which won her the Bob today. Excellent to handle and excellent presentation.

Lilac Point Neuter Male

PC & BOB – Toth’s TIANLEX PURPLEHAZE 17/09/09. Rather a large person but type good. Slightly heavy wedge of medium length with good top of head and large ears well set. Oval eyes which he tends to widen with a rather worried expression but colour very good and brilliant in tone. Almost straight profile with marginal bump to nose near the tip, good firm chin and level bite. Tends to hunch his neck, body long and substantial with excellent tone, long strong limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Lilac points a touch dark but the correct tone and match well. Good close texture to magnolia coat with light shading over the hips and shoulders. Very sweet tempered albeit a little shy, excellently presented.

Red Point Neuter Male

PC & BOB – Ridgeway’s GD CH HARTZIE CHILLIPEPPER 11/05/06. This boy has a lovely head, a broad medium length wedge with excellent wide top and very large wide based ears set to balance. Snooty expression to oriental shaped eyes, colour deep brilliant blue. Straight strong profile and firm chin, bite rather untidy but looked level-ish. Long strong and weighty body, long elegant limbs and spoon paws, tail well tapered but needs an inch to balance. Bright red points, I fancy that they have improved since he was neutered. Super clear and virtually un-shaded coat, thus wonderful contrast, texture a little soft today. Perfect temperament.

1st - Brinton’s BRINDI SHIKANA (32/8) F 24/03/09

A.C. Novice Adult

1st - Dickenson's PURMISQUS MAIHONSONG LILY (24c) F 08/11/09

A.C. Adolescent

1st – Ringrose's JAKURTZI NIGHTSIDE OF EDEN (32fn) M 21/10/09. Excellent type to this lad and beginning to mature nicely. Super head with strong top line and very large wide based ears excellently set. He has well developed points colour for his age with a typical matte finish to them. Good substance and length to body but typically adolescent in tone as yet. Coat a bit long and fine today but almost unshaded. Super to handle

2nd - Cook's HELSBELS LADYGAGA (32a) F 06/09/09

3rd – Ridgeway's CH HARTZIE BLAZE-OF-GLORY (24k) M 05/06/09. Such a dear boy of good type but lacking in masculinity. He has very good points colouring and his eye colour is good considering. Almost clear coat of good texture. Excellent to handle.

Radius Kitten

1st – Simpson's SHERMESE MASQUERADE (24a) F 09/12/09. I do like the type and style of this female but she is really quite small when you consider she will be an adult in under a months time. Lovely even head with very good top and ears that follow the lines of the wedge very well. Super shape, set and expression to eyes with brilliant colour. Points colour also very good, a soft cool toned mid blue, coat minimally shaded. Beautifully poised and presented.

A.C. Siamese Breeders Neuter

1st - Ridgeway's GD CH HARTZIE CHILLIPEPPER (32a) MN 11/05/06

2nd – Bowles-Gowdey's CH MAFDET ULTRAVIOLET (32b8) FN 23/05/08. A very stylish lady with typy head and huge ears. Eyes marginally large in proportion to the head, but shape set and colour very good. Super lilac-based caramel colour to points with clear brownish tones and good warm toned apricot mingling on all points. Almost unshaded coat of good close texture. Shy but gentle and easy to handle.

3rd – Freeman's KRISTIKATS SIMPLYBLUE (32/8) MN 17/04/09. A very dear boy, obviously well loved. He has very good type but is still kittenish in appearance, although he is not small by any means. Very good tabby markings with excellent brownish over tones to blue-based colour. Super to handle and beautifully presented.

A.C. Siamese Non-Breeders (ex Lilac) Neuter

1st – Janicki's SHERMESE FABULOUS FABERGE (24) MN 10/02/09. A lovely elegant boy for style, with an excellent head, beautifully balanced and even, with perfect ear set. Oriental eye shape, set and expression with very good colour. Dense seal points, showing a little warmth of tone. Coat quite heavily shaded for a youngster but some contrast seen, with creamy toned bib and tummy. If I were to nit pick I would like him a little more masculine looking. Super to handle and presented to perfection.

2nd – Jakeman’s PR SHERMESE THEONLIIOUS MN (32/2) 16/05/08. Attractive boy with a very good head from the front view, with wide top line and large ears very well set. Good eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Really weighty body of good length. Well defined tabby pattern with multi tail rings. Colour interesting, it is clearly blue, albeit rather dark, particularly when viewed against the boy next door who is blue-based caramel. However, his paw pads and nose leather are purple not blue, so, he does seem to fall somewhere between the two colours. Excellent to handle.

3rd – Toth’s ROMEO (White) MN 2yrs 9mnths. A large plump person with a super crisp white coat that was beautifully prepared. Eyes pale green, most attractive against the white. A little bit shy today but handled well.

Friendliest Adult/Kitten

Tough class, they were all friendly!

1st – Miller’s JAMILA MILLER (Blue Tortie Sphynx) FN 2yrs 4mnths. Just gorgeous, such a wicked expression to her. Almost no fur covering to the body which gave off waves of heat, she must make a wonderful hot water bottle. Super chameleon like tail that was almost prehensile. A perfect temperament that belies her naughty look.

2nd - Richards’ IFMC KEVIN THECOUNTRYKAT (Ginger & White) MN 4yrs.

Ex 2nd – Ashman’s KIKI GALORE (Red Tabby) FN 1yr 7mnths. Another Sphynx, this one with a little more covering of fur, but she would still make a good hand warmer! Yellow green eyes with snooty expression but very friendly and easy to handle
