Congratulations to Maria on an excellent show, it was a pleasure to be judging with everything running like clock work and with some very good cats to judge. My apologies to exhibitors for the lateness of this report and also for not submitting Miscellaneous reports on this occasion.

## **BREED CLASSES**

### **A.C. Siamese Balinese Premier Male**

**GD PC – Sibley's PR ATARIQ FIRORI (24c) MN 25/01/09.** A large but elegant male neuter of very good type. Quite a strong head of medium length with very good top line and large wide based ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with super colour, deep brilliant blue. Almost straight profile, chin lines up with the nose tip and bite level. Elegant neck, long weighty but well toned body, long elegant limbs and neat spoon paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Mid lilac points which looked reasonably pinky toned in the yellow hall lighting, magnolia coat of very good length and texture, with some medium shading down the spine. A very friendly boy, beautifully presented.

**R – Barnes' PR ABICASA CYBER SPIRIT (24n) MN 16/12/08.** Another elegant neuter boy of very good type, he ran the winner very close, in the end it came down to who was the more masculine looking of the two – I do like my boys to look like boys. Stylish head with very good top and large flared ears set to balance. Super eye shape and set with very good depth of colour. Small dip to profile centre nose, firm chin and level bite. Long slender but firm toned body with long fine limbs and tail that almost balances. Lilac-based caramel points with good sludgy overtones, off-white coat with minimal shading to tone and super sleek texture. A lovely boy to handle and presented to perfection.

### **A.C. Siamese Balinese Premier Female**

**GD PC – Meekings' IMP GD CH & PR FIROUSI FREEDSPIRIT (32c) FN 26/03/03.** It is always a pleasure to meet this lovely lady, who never seems to change despite her advancing years, if anything she is better than in her youth. Super head with wide top line and very large wide based ears beautifully set and that remain in place which ever way she turns her head. Snooty expression to eyes of oriental shape and set, colour could be deeper. Strong profile and firm chin, bite lacks incisors but appears to be level, and I love her freckled nose leather. Long elegant body with good tone for a neuter lady of this age, long slender limbs and tail to balance. Perfect cool toned pale cream points so rarely seen, and for this alone I would give her the Grand. Medium length coat of slightly fine texture with light pale cream shading overall, thus excellent contrast. Handled well today – was quite chatty. Excellently presented.

### **British Brown, Blue, Chocolate or Lilac Tabby Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Marsland-Round's CATBALU ELYSIAN FIELDS (20a) F 07/10/10.** A pretty baby, overall type good but perhaps a touch dainty for 8 months. Well rounded head with good width to skull, ears fairly small, set to follow the contours of

the head, cheeks beginning to show. Eyes round with open expression and mid gold colour. Good profile with short broad nose, firm chin and level bite, whisker pads a tad prominent. Medium length body that was quite weighty, short limbs and neat round paws, medium length tail to balance. Mid blue tabby pattern on oatmeal ground, showing good butterfly, well matched oysters, 3 evenly spaced spine lines, 2 necklaces, well barred limbs and tail. Pattern areas clear and with the minimum of brindling, sound to over half way down the hair shaft. Coat length good but rather baby soft at present. Excellent temperament and presentation.

### **Oriental Bicolour Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Price's MAZPAHS DOUBLE TROUBLE (48b) F 17/11/10.** A dainty kitten of overall good type. Fairly well balanced head with goodish top line and large ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with mid green colour. Uneven profile at present, with slight dip centre nose and a small bump near the tip, chin slopes back a touch but bite level. Long slender body with good weight for size, long dainty limbs and neat oval paws, whippy tail to balance. Very dark chocolate colouring to coat, which was rather unsound today, white areas to almost two thirds, on face, on all four limbs and completely under tummy. It is unfortunate that she has several narrow strips of white which show a lot of bleeding into the coloured areas, this is very difficult to tidy up completely, nevertheless some tidying up could have been done. Very good close texture to coat. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

### **Oriental LH Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Hart's LORICHA ORGANZA (62 43s) F 06/11/10.** An attractive baby for type and well grown. Medium length wedge with good top of head and fairly large ears well set and beautifully furnished. Almond eye shape, setting good, colour olive green. Tiny dip to profile, firm chin and level bite. Really firm toned and weighty little body of good length with dainty limbs and neat paws for this breed, tail almost balances. Medium shading to coat at present, it appears to be spotty based and a lot of the spotting is still reasonably well defined with tiny clear spots over the shoulders, however, there are signs that is beginning to lift and diffuse out somewhat in places, so happy to accept her as shaded today. Very good coat length for her age and the texture was lovely. A dear baby to handle and excellently presented.

### **Oriental Tortoiseshell Neuter**

**BOB – Baxter's GD PR SOLARUS ALL THAT JAZZ (37y) FN 21/03/08.** Not a lot to add to very recent critiques of this lady neuter. Her overall type is good and she is a lovely size for a female. Her coat colouring is very attractive with rich hot cream mingling, and her eye colour is also very good. Coat texture super as always. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

### **Red Point Siamese Adult**

**CC – Abbott's CHICKUAI CHENAZZSDIVA (32a) F 29/08/10.** A young female of very good type and style. Tipy head with lovely top line and very large ears set to balance. Eyes a little exaggerated in shape and set but depth of colour excellent. Virtually straight profile with firm chin and level bite, quite a pronounced pinch to muzzle today which spoils the evenness of the head a touch. Lovely long elegant and firm toned body with well defined neck line, long slender limbs and neat spoon paws, excellent whippy tail to balance. Bright mid red points colour, virtually un-shaded

warm white coat of short close texture. Painfully shy but very sweet tempered, just preferred to be back in her pen and under her blanket. Excellently presented.

**Bob – Fairclough’s CH ZAFARA ALLOWEEN (32a) F 02/08/09.** A very stylish mature lady, looked very good today I thought. Super head with wide top line and large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with serene expression and very good depth of blue colour. Profile not quite straight, she has a small bump near the tip of her nose, chin good and bite level. Long elegant yet substantial body, long limbs, tail to almost balance. Mid red points, typically paler on the front limbs, unshaded warm white coat of lovely close texture. Very easy to handle, knows just how to show herself well. Excellently presented.

**A.C. Balinese Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Smythe’s APRIKAT SIMPLYMAGIC (61) F 31/10/10.** A very well grown Bali baby, overall type good. Medium length wedge, top line could be marginally wider, ears a good size for this breed and well furnished, but she does have the tendency to hold them a little upright at times. Oriental eye shape set and expression, colour could ideally be a little deeper but was acceptable. Good profile and chin with level bite, small pinch to slightly rounded muzzle. Long really weighty body with long strong limbs and tail to balance. Dark rather cool toned seal points. Coat is almost white but on the plus side is practically clear of shading. Coat length excellent for a kitten and the texture was just what it should be, beautifully silky and very fine with minimal undercoat. A dear babe to handle, beautifully presented in a snug nest.
