I was very pleased to see a large class of Red Point female kittens entered in my book but so disappointed to find them all absent. I took over a good few of Mrs Jones miscellaneous & club classes, which means that only my opens will be full reports. Many thanks to Kathy Baxter for her stewarding expertise and very good company.

### **OPEN CLASSES**

#### **A.C. Oriental Bicolour Neuter Male**

**IC – Midson's MYOKO SUPER TROUPER (48 43bs) 21/11/08.** An elegant and typy neuter lad. Longer wedge, but top of head very good with well set ears that were large enough to almost balance. Olive green eyes of oriental shape and set with good expression. Marginal dip to profile centre nose, firm chin and level bite. Long and very slender body, fairly weighty, he is not the biggest of cats but he is acceptable for his age and has time to mature. Long slender limbs and neat paws, super long whip tail to balance. Supposedly Shaded pattern, but with the large amount of white he has and with no pattern on the body it is impossible to tell, I assume he was registered thus because of his parentage. Tabby markings on tail and on the two spots on his head dark cold chocolate on silver ground. Coat length and texture very good. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

#### **Red Point Siamese Adult Female**

**CC & BOB – Reed's IMP GD CH JOHPAS SENORITA RUMBALITA 01/05/05.** A gorgeous girl who is hard to fault. With excellent type, and wonderful size and strength for a female, yet extremely elegant, she was my choice for Best Siamese Exhibit. Lovely head for balance, with wide top line and very large ears beautifully set. Super shape set and expression to mid blue eyes. Almost straight profile, good firm chin, bite a little untidy now with a couple of lower incisors missing. Excellent length and substance to firm toned body with long limbs and long whip tail to balance. If I was to be critical, her points colour could be richer but it does have a good bright tone to it, and I love her freckled nose. Coat a touch long today but lying close and of good texture, shaded overall in pale red. Perfect to handle and beautifully presented.

#### **Tortie Point Siamese Adult**

A very good class with all the these ladies worthy of a certificate.

**CC & BOB - Miller's CH ATLANTIC CHANEL (32b1) 17/07/08.** A large but elegant girl of very good type and style. Well balanced medium length wedge with very good top of head and large ears set to follow. Oriental eyes that were marginally deep set with haws up a touch, but a good deep blue colour. Straight profile and good chin with level bite. Long weighty and firm toned body, long elegant limbs and spoon paws, long tapered tail almost balances. Super warm-toned seal brown tortie markings with plenty of good red mingling, attractive pale red blaze down the nose

almost divides the mask in two. Excellent coat for length and texture, very sleek and close with medium tortie shading overall. A very friendly lady, excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Smyth’s S\*TAMMEE’S KNOCK OUT ROSIE (32b2) 17/10/08.** I did like this stylish lady and she the winner close. Very good head type, medium in length and evenly balanced with lovely large flared ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set, colour mid blue but she does have a slightly paler outer rim to them. Good profile, chin goes back a smidge but bite level. Very good length and substance to body with quite dainty limbs and paws, long whip tail to balance. Excellent tortie points colouring, a good soft pale blue with plenty of pale cream mingling. Superb coat texture, very short and beautifully sleek with minimal shading to tone. Very sweet tempered, beautifully poised and presented in a snug nest.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Cockwell’s ADSETAM ONEFORSO (32b1) 09/07/07.** A mature lady of very good type. Well balanced medium wedge with good top line and large flared ears set to follow. Good shape and set to eyes with mid blue colour. Dip to profile over nose, chin lines up with nose tip but could be a little deeper, bite level, muzzle lines spoiled by a pinch today. Long fairly substantial body, long limbs and well tapered tail that almost balances. Dark seal tortie points well mingled with some good red mingling evident, particularly on the ears. Coat rather long and fine in texture, shaded overall to tone. A very sweet tempered lady, beautifully presented.

#### Cream Point Siamese Female

**CC & BOB - Cook’s CH JOHPAS SABINA PURDITA 09/05/08.** A big strong girl of very good type. Strong head with excellent top and large wide based ears set to balance. Good shape and set to eyes with good expression, colour could be marginally deeper. Tiny dip to nice “fat” nose, good firm chin and level bite. Excellent substance and tone to long weighty body, with long elegant limbs and spoon paws, long whip tail to balance. Mid cream points, paler on the ears but hotter in tone on the tail. Very good length and texture to coat, shaded overall to tone. Had some very rude things to say for herself but handled okay. Beautifully presented.

#### Tortie Point Siamese Kitten

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Baughan’s FLUTERBY KISS ME QUICK (32b3) F 14/04/09.** A stylish kitten, almost adult but with a fair amount of growing to do yet, having said that she has a nice solid feel to her. Well balanced medium wedge with very good top line and good sized ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour and brilliance of tone. Tiny dip to nose, firm chin and level bite, marginal pinch to muzzle. Long slender but weighty body, dainty limbs and long whip tail. Well broken mid chocolate tortie, points with plenty of good red evident, pale red blaze down the nose. Pale coat, lightly shaded to tone, with very good length and texture. Excellent to handle and beautifully presented.

#### Caramel Point Siamese Neuter Male

**PC & BOB – Barnes’ ABICASA CYBERSPIRIT 16/12/08.** An adolescent male neuter of very good type. Stylish head with very good top and very large ears that were wide at base and well flared, setting excellent. Oriental eye shape and set with good blue colour. Strong profile with good chin and level bite. Long, typically adolescent body, long limbs, tapered tail needs a touch more length to balance. Lilac-based caramel points, well developed for age with clear brownish tones to the

base of the ears and on the tail. Very lightly shaded off-white coat with excellent close texture. A most attractive boy with a lovely nature – just needs to mature. Excellently presented

#### **Apricot Point Neuter Male**

**PC & BOB – Muir-Taylor's JOHPAS FATBOYSLIM 12/02/09.** A young neuter of lovely strong type. Broad medium length wedge with wide top and huge wide based ears, tilting over at the tips a touch, set wide. Eye shape and set a little exaggerated but not helped by the hairs at the corner of the eyes covering the eyes and making them look smaller than they actually are, colour mid blue. Strong profile with broad nose, good chin and level bite. Long well covered but elegant body, long limbs and super long whip tail. Good apricot points colour beginning to show a slightly dingy overtone to them in places. Coat marginally long and fine but lying fairly close, lightly shaded to tone. Super temperament and condition. Excellently presented.

### **MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**

#### **A.V. Adult Not Bred by Exhibitor**

**1st – Martin's GD CH GLENTHORNE CONSTANTINE (24) M 04/12/05.** A very stylish and masculine boy with a strong well balanced head. Seal points have warmth but eye colour lacks brilliance and could ideally be deeper. Easy to handle and excellently presented,

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Miller's CH ATLANTIC CHANEL (32b1) 17/07/08**

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Hatchett's NUTROSTAR IMPERESLISTIC (37n) M 07/11/06.** A dear boy of overall good type. Coat colour good and virtually sound. Eye colour very good indeed. A little shy but handled well

#### **A.V. Junior Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Reed's CH AMYDAY SUNSPANGLED (32fn) M 18/07/08.** I have handled this boy many times and my opinion has not changed. He is wonderfully stylish and although I would like his points colour and eye colour to be marginally more intense, he is overall a quality exhibit. Not noticed his dear little beard before. Perfect to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Cook's CH JOHPAS SABINA PURDITA 09/05/08**

**ex 2<sup>nd</sup> - Miller's CH ATLANTIC CHANEL (32b1) 17/07/08.**

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Meeking's RANTIPOLE ENIGMA (32t8) F 06/12/08.** A neat and overall well balanced female, quite dainty as yet and needs to mature. I am not entirely convinced she is caramel but it is early days yet. Lovely temperament

**ex 3<sup>rd</sup> – Martin's ABICASA AMAZING GRACE (24) 26/02/09.** A good solid girl of good type. Eyes rather full, but colour excellent.

#### **A.V. Senior Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Martin's GD CH GLENTHORNE CONSTANTINE (24) M 04/12/05**

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Cockwell's ADSETAM ONEFORSO (32b1) 09/07/07**

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Pinington's SPINDIAMOND SONGSINGBLUE (61p) F 22/08/06.** A dainty Bali lady, quite kittenish looking for a mature adult. Looked more blue tortie than blue-based caramel tortie today. Very sweet tempered.

#### **A.C. Breeders Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Hart's HARTRIDGE HIFIVE (61fn) M 05/05/09.** A well grown kitten, type good and coat promising for age. Points promising and have warmth of tone. A sweet lad.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Pinington's SPINDIAMOND IAMISAID (61c) M 02/07/09.** It is my opinion that this kitten is caramel not lilac, the ears are very dingy in tone with no hint of the desired pink. I do not wrong colour kittens of this age unless it is something very obvious such as blue rather than seal, but I do think he should be re-registered. Eyes a little full with mid blue colour. Handled well.

#### **A.V. Debutante Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Lodwig's WILLHAVETODO VOODOOAJIC (37) M 22/08/09.** Gorgeous little boy, with a lovely head on him and very good eye colour. His coat was excellent, short, sleek and very sound. Mummy needs to attend to one or two paler hairs in the groin area! Super temperament, a very outgoing little boy.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Freemont's LUNATORA FOR YOUREYESONLY (45s) F 21/07/09.** Another very promising baby for type and well grown. Super eye colour, vivid green. Super coat with good pattern, showing two bands of ticking and clear silver undercoat, and the texture was excellent. Easy to handle.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Pinington's HARTRIDGE HOT DIAMONDLIL (61e) F 05/05/09.** A sweet babe, overall type good but rather on the twee side for 7 months. Head fairly well balanced but the ears need to be bigger. Eye colour good and coat well developed for age. A sweet person.

#### **A.V. Limit Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Baughan's FLUTERBY KISS ME QUICK (32b3) F 14/04/09**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Cockwell's CARBEILE PAIGE CHERRY (32/5) F 22/06/09.** A little on the small side for 6 months. Head rather narrow and needs better top for balance. Eye colour basically good but marginally paler on the outer edge. Good bright red tabby markings. Excellent temperament.

#### **A.V. Visitors Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Hutchings MAFDET MCARTHUR (32/8) M 23/04/09.** A super little boy for type and style, rather dainty for age but has a good solid feel to him. Very good eyes for shape, set and colour. Caramel colour to tabby points good with dingy overtone to tail rings in particular. Still minus his accoutrements I see. Super temperament

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Meekings' RANTIPOLE REMEMBRANCE (48 40b) MN 23/03/09.** This lad's white has become more obvious since our last meeting, - now that he has begun

to shade up a touch, and it is now clear that he enough Very good head type and his chocolate points are reasonably pale and warm in tone a bicolour. Very cross today, not like him at all.

**3<sup>rd</sup> - Freemont's LUNATORA FOR YOUREYESONLY (45s) F 21/07/09**

**A.V. Adolescent Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Titterall's BABADAG ASIFBYMAGIC (37) MN 06/01/09.** A beautiful boy, hard to fault, with excellent strong head, good green eyes and an almost perfect glossy black coat. A joy to handle as always.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Muir-Taylor's JOHPAS FATBOYSLIM (32fn) MN 12/02/09**

**ex 2<sup>nd</sup> - Janicki's SHERMESE FABULOUS FABERGE (24) MN10/02/09.** It was virtually equal between 2<sup>nd</sup> & ex 2<sup>nd</sup> and when it came to Best Siamese Neuter judging later in the day I decided to chose this boy because of the very excellent eye colour that he has, coupled with his very good warm seal points. He is still a bit dainty but he is only 10 months and hopefully will improve as he matures. Very long whip tail. Super temperament

**3<sup>rd</sup> - Midson's MYOKO SUPER TROUPER (48 43bs) 21/11/08**

**A.V. Senior Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Lee's CH & IMP GD PR WILLHAVETODO OIJA BOARD (37p) FN 27/05/06.** My beautiful old friend looking very serene and relaxed today. With excellent type and colouring, both for coat and eyes, she is very hard to fault . In tip top condition as always and excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Corps' CH & GD PR PANDAI NEASSA (32b1) FN 20/02/05.** Mature and stylish lady neuter who I have not seen for some time. Good head type with large flared ears. Very dark seal tortie points with good red showing on the ears, coat quite heavily shaded but contrast still seen and the texture was good. Very sweet tempered, obviously enjoying her day out.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Esterford-Howard's CH & PR MAPU MALACHITE (32/8/) MN 18/06/07.** I love the type and overall balance of this lad and would be happy to give him high awards – if he were a female. His eye colour is really brilliant, which is unusual in caramel, but then I have always thought he was lilac, his colour is just too pretty for a caramel tabby of this age. Perfect to handle, a very relaxed boy.

**A.V. Aristocrat Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Crumpler's SARNAJES SULTANOSWING (24b) MN 03/02/08.** A very stylish boy with a good head, although showing a pinch to muzzle today. He has very good eye colour but his points are rather dark for the breed, however, they do show a modicum of warmth. Excellent to handle.
