## OPEN CLASSES

### A.V. Oriental Premier

**GD PC – Cruden's PR OOPSEEIDE MAKING WAVES (41n) MN 16/06/08.** A handsome neuter boy of very good type. Strong medium wedge with very good top line and largish ears very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with excellent vivid green colour. Straight profile, chin lines up with the nose tip, bite level. Body has good length but is slightly "comfortable" shall we say, long strong limbs, tail rather short for balance. Very good Classic tabby pattern, with three clear, separated spine lines, well rounded oysters that almost match, butterfly outline good but needs better internal spotting to be perfect. Caramel colouring excellent with clear bluish sheen to the markings on the head and tail. Excellent coat length and texture, very short, beautifully sleek and close lying. An impressive chap with a super temperament, well worth his Grand today.

### Siamese/Balinese Champion Male

**GD CC – Davies' CH KARAMUSHI CHEEKY CHESTER (32a) M 23/10/08.** It is such a pity that this male lacks so much self belief because he really is a lovely boy for type and style. Excellent head with wide top line and large beautifully flared ears set to balance, although he does tend to hold low with anxiety. Oriental eye shape and set with very good depth of colour. Strong straight profile, deep chin lines up with the nose tip, bite untidy but level. Long well defined neck and long well muscled body, long elegant limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Bright mid red points with lightly shaded warm white coat, a little long and fine in texture today. Excellently condition and presentation.

**R – Gibbons' GD CH RICHDAL LONE RANGER (24) 22/02/07** This lad was looking much better than when I last had him, but his coat is still not quite right. Stylish masculine head with wide top line and very large wide based ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could be a little deeper for perfection. Profile a touch uneven, chin firm, bite rather untidy but level, pinch to muzzle today. Long hard body with good coverage over the spine today, long elegant limbs, tail needs a touch more length to balance. Very dark dense seal points, showing warmth of tone on the mask and on the front paws. Good coat contrast for a seal of this age but he still seems to have "pepper & salt" shading down the spine, coat length medium with reasonable texture. Perfect temperament, always handles really well this boy and I had a very nice purr out of him today.

### Siamese/Balinese Champion Female

**GD CC – Stokes' CH LITTLEFEAT POWDERFINGER (32b1) F 05/03/10.** A beautiful female for type. Lovely head with wide top and large butterfly ears excellently set, has a small excrescence on the back of her skull that I decided to ignore because she is so lovely. Very good eye shape and set with brilliant sapphire

blue colour. Strong profile and firm chin with level bite. Elegant neckline, long slender but weighty and firm toned body, long elegant limbs and spoon paws, well tapered tail to balance. Dark seal tortie points, very well mingled with mainly pale red, but has the odd richer red fleck on the ears. Super coat for length and texture, beautifully sleek and close-lying, lightly shaded to tone overall. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

#### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Imperial Grand Premier Male**

**IMP – Gourley & Ward's GD PR DAZZLING BEN HUR (24) MN 15/09/05.**

This is such an endearing chap. Very good type and style with a well balanced medium length wedge and large wide based ears very well set. Gentle expression to eyes of very good colour. Almost straight profile and good chin, bite clean and level - with all teeth in situ. Quite a substantial body without loss of elegance, long limbs and spoon paws, tapered tail just about balances. Very dark but warm toned seal points. Coat very heavily shaded, but there is still some contrast with creamy bib & tummy, coat length and texture excellent. Made the most enthusiastic puddings for me bless him. Excellently presented.

#### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Imperial Grand Premier Female**

**IMP – Pounds' JOMESE JENUINELY GORJUS (32a) FN 04/05/06.** A beautiful lady who I have judged several times quite recently and have little to add to previous critiques. She has lovely type, good points & eye colour, and her coat contrast for a girl of this age is excellent. Coat a little long and fine in texture today but managing to lie close. Excellent to handle and presented to perfection.

#### **Black/Chocolate/Cinnamon Tortie & White Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Hemming's HINDERSLYNE MADAM BUTTAFLY (22) F 06/12/10.** A well grown kitten of overall good type. Fairly well rounded head though marginally wedge shaped in the muzzle, ears smallish in size and set on well but with a tendency to bonnet at times. Very good eye shape with open expression and deep gold colour. Nose perhaps touch long but good definition where it meets the forehead, firm chin and level bite. Medium length body, quite cobby and with good substance, good tail, thick at root and rounded at the tip, short limbs and round paws. Attractive coat coloration, jet black well mingled with mid red, with a little tabby pattern evident in these areas. White areas over the one third, inverted "v" on face, across the chest, down the tummy and on front limbs, with a little on the flanks. Coat length good, texture could be better and lies a little flat at present. Excellent temperament, a very friendly baby. Excellently presented.

#### **Black Silver Spotted Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Sinkinson's LOUREWZ MISS GUCCI (30s) F 16/09/10.** An attractive kitten, almost adult and developing well, very good for type. Round head with good width to skull for age, ears medium in size at present, cheeks just beginning to show. Lovely expression to eyes, round and open with pale green colour. Good profile with short broad nose, firm chin and level bite. Body strong and cobby with short strong limbs and round paws, tail marginally long for balance but well shaped. Spotted pattern generally good, spine line well broken, spots on body mainly well rounded and clear, just a little linkage evident behind the forearms, on mid silver ground, spotting sound to about half way down. Pattern colour a slightly muted black,

a little tarnishing on front paws evident. Coat length good and dense but texture a little soft. Excellent temperament and presentation.

#### **Oriental Shaded Adult.**

**CC & BOB – Bauerfeind’s GD CH SHIMILEETA TOSEXYFORMYFUR (43b) M 18/04/09.** A very large, masculine and handsome chap – but oh my what a girly voice he has! Stylish head with wide top line and very large ears wide set. Oriental eye shape and set with mid green colour. Broad slightly waisted nose which was almost straight in profile, chin good, bite untidy and rather sore with several teeth missing, appeared level. Long well muscled body with long strong limbs, tail almost balances. Medium shaded pattern, there is clear definition between the shading and the warm toffee undercoat that is about two thirds the way up the hair shaft with a slight grey unsound area at the roots. Very good length and close texture to coat. Excellent temperament and presentation.

#### **Oriental Classic & Mackerel Tabby Neuter**

**PC & BOB – Cruden’s PR OOPSOEEIDE MAKING WAVES (41n) MN 16/06/08**

#### **Apricot Point Adult Male**

**CC & BOB – Brown’s HEMLOCK MONTEREY JACK (32fn) M 17/07/10.** A young lad of stylish type, still very much a baby but maturity acceptable for 9 months. Balanced medium wedge that need to strengthen, good top line and large flared ears very well set. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could be deeper and is a touch dull in tone. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Long elegant body with an excellent firm tone to it, long limbs and tail. Well developed apricot points with good hot tones to ears and under the feet Off white coat of very good length and texture, lightly shaded overall to tone. A sweet lad to handle, excellently presented.

### **MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**

#### **A.C. British Radius Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Ward’s WESTENBACH LARNIKAT GRACE (39) 11/07/10.** This lady was a very good size for a young Tipped, very good for type. Rounded head, good width to skull and full cheeks, ears fairly small and well set. Lovely eyes for shape set and expression, colour quite a vivid mid green accentuated by her black eye liner. Well rounded forehead and neat short nose, good chin and level bite. Body cobby and weighty with neat short limbs and rounded paws, medium length tail to balance. Medium tipping to coat, even and well distributed throughout, coat length good, texture quite crisp and fairly dense. I liked her very much. Excellent to handle

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Chesterman’s MENARA BIT O CRUMPET (40 4) M 29/03/10.** Enormous chap of good type. Rounded head but skull needs to broaden and the ears are a little large for good head balance. Well rounded eyes of open expression and clear blue colour. Good profile with short-ish nose, chin firm and bite level. Really weighty and substantial body with broad chest and short strong limbs, medium length tail with rounded tip. Pretty pale lilac points with coat almost clear of shading, coat short and dense, but could be touch crisper for perfection. An easy chap to handle, excellently presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Ross' ADECISH DAISY CHAIN (18d) F 01/07/09.** A neat queen of good type. Good head shape with small ears well set, slight cheeks. Round eyes, pupils very enlarged today, outer edge looked to be deep orange colour. Good profile and neat short nose, good chin and bite. Medium length body, fairly cobby and weighty, short limbs and round paws, well shaped tail to balance. Rich red tabby pattern on paler red ground, with well rounded oysters that matched on both sides, three solid spine lines, fairly clear butterfly over shoulders, and several necklaces. Coat a little long but texture quite good. Very shy but gentle. Excellently presented.

#### **British Black, White, Red Self, Chocolate or Lilac Cat**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Richards' ANGEL AT MIDNIGHT BOBELLS (21c) F 31/07/10.** This cat was actually in the wrong class but I didn't notice until I was doing my report. Just over the 9 months, but well developed and her type was very good. Typical head type with broad skull and small neat ears set really well, good full cheeks for a youngster. Good eye shape, set and expression with deep gold colour. Rounded forehead with short broad nose, firm chin and level bite. Strong cobby body with excellent substance, short strong limbs for a girl with tail to balance. Mid lilac coat colour very well mingled overall in mid cream, has a slightly larger patch of cream under the chin. Coat perhaps a touch long, but dense and fairly crisp. Very friendly and easy to handle, excellently presented.

#### **A.C. British Tabby or Spotted Cat**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Gribben's CRAZIPUSS KALEIDOSCOPE (20e) F 10/06/10.** A lovely lady for type and colour. Round head with good width between neat small ears that were set to follow the contours of the head, and good full cheeks. Expressive eyes of very good shape and intense orange colour. Good profile with short broad nose, deep chin and level bite. Medium length body with good substance, short limbs and neat round paws, medium length tail with rounded tip. Super warm colouring to pattern, she has a lot of red which almost makes her look chocolate except that her paw pads are black. Tabby pattern good with well rounded oysters, three solid spine lines and fairly well defined butterfly. Coat length and texture good but could be denser. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Sinkinson's LIMATZ MISS SIXTY (30s) F 06/08/09.** Another lovely lady, who ran the winner close. Well rounded head with full cheeks, very good width to skull with her neat small ears set well part. Round eyes with open expression and paler hazel colour. Rounded forehead curving to short broad nose, deep chin and level bite. Strong cobby body with short strong limbs and round paws, well shaped medium length tail. Well defined spotting to coat, spine line marginally linked and there was a little brindling within the pattern, minimal tarnishing to muzzle and front paws. Coat short, dense and fairly crisp. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Thompson's DARKCRYSTAL SILVER-SOLO (18) M 21/01/10.** Good size to this young lad who still has a baby look about him at the moment. Fairly well rounded head that need to broaden and develop his cheeks, ears medium in size but set well. Round eyes with slightly innocent expression, colour hazel. The definition between forehead and short broad nose a little shallow, chin firm and bite level. Super tabby pattern, very clear and well defined on pale silver ground, with three almost equally wide spine lines, well matched oysters, good butterfly with many tiny

internal spots and he has spots in between this legs bars right down to his toes. Good length and texture to coat. Rather cross but handled okay. Excellently presented.

**A.C. British Tortoiseshell, Tortoiseshell & White, Bicoloured or Blue Cream Cat**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Hemming’s GD CH HINDERSLYNE HECATE (21) F 08/07/08.** A mature lady of very good type. Super head with broad skull and dear little ears set to follow the contours of the well rounded head. Gently curved forehead and short broad nose, strong chin and level bite. Lovely strong cobby body with short strong limbs and round paws, good tail to balance. Excellent coat qualities, glossy black, beautifully mingled overall in shades of deep and rich red, sound to roots, length and texture excellent, it as short, really dense and crisp, the best coat I had today. Sweet tempered and easy to handle. Excellently presented.

**A.C. Colourpointed British SH Cat**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Chesterman’s MENARA BIT O CRUMPET (40 4) M 29/03/10**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Parr’s PARRADAZY CHOCOLICIOUS (40 9) F 07/06/10.** A neat little queen of overall good type. Rounded head with full-ish cheeks, fairly good width to skull, ears medium in size and set a touch close as present. Well rounded eyes of clear blue colour. Profile good with short broad nose, chin strong, bite marginally under. Weighty cobby body with neat short limbs and medium length tail. Darker chocolate tortie points colour, mingled on all points in mainly pale red with a larger splotch on the muzzle. Coat very good, short and dense, has a fair amount of shading for a youngster, particularly over the flanks. A friendly girl, excellently presented.

**A.C. British Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Minshall’s AMAZOLOU SCOOBYSNAX (79L 39d) M27/09/10.** A really well developed chap of very good type. Head type very good with good width between medium sized ears that were tuft ed at the tips and well set, good profile chin and bite, well padded whisker pads. Eyes virtually round with deep gold colour. Excellent substance to medium length body, with good broad chest, strong medium length limbs and round close toed paws, medium length tail with rounded tip. Long dense and plushy coat, well rexed throughout, has a few knots under his tummy that could have been tidied up, red tipping to coat almost imperceptible and only really evident on the ears at first glance. Excellent temperament, a very friendly boy.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Daniel’s WINDYMEADOW KAISER CHIEF (40 2) MN 10/09/10.** Another boy with very good type, but not quite so well developed as the winner. Good round head with broad skull for a youngster, ears neat small and set well apart, cheeks beginning to show. Open expression to eyes of very good shape, colour mid blue. Medium length cobby body, with short strong limbs, good tail to balance. Medium blue points with tail a tad darker in tone. Pale glacial coat, lightly shaded over the lower back, texture very good, really dense and quite crisp. A very happy chap who handled well. Excellently presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Hemming’s HINDERSLYNE MADAM BUTTAFLY (22) F 06/12/10**

**A.C. British Tabby or Spotted Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Sinkinson’s LOUREWZ MISS GUCCI (30s) F 16/09/10**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Hall’s CATYKES ONMITODD (30as) M 04/12/10.** A nice baby for type. Head shape good, ears are medium in size at present but set well. Open expression to eyes of mid gold colour. Rounded forehead and short broad nose, firm chin lines up with the nose tip and level bite. Medium length body with good weight, quite strong boned limbs, tail well shaped but marginally long. Dark blue spotted pattern showing some linkage on the sides, there is also a fair amount of silvery tipping within the pattern giving an overall indistinct effect. Coat medium to long with soft fine baby texture at present. A friendly boy who handled well.

**A.C. Colourpointed British SH Kitten**

**1st - Daniel’s WINDYMEADOW KAISER CHIEF (40 2) MN 10/09/10**

**British Black, White, Red Self, Chocolate or Lilac Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Anderson-Carter’s GD PR ROCODANNE BLACK JACK (15) MN 04/10/07.** A large and impressive male neuter boy of very good type. Well rounded head with broad skull, very full cheeks and small neat ears with rounded tips set well. Excellent open expression to eyes of deep gold colour. Good profile with short broad nose, deep strong chin that lines up with the nose tip and level bite. Strong substantial and cobby body with broad chest, short strong limbs and large round paws, medium length tail to balance. Excellent coat qualities, glossy jet black that was virtually sound to the roots, short, dense and with a super crisp feel to it. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Griffiths’ MENARA MONTGOMERY (15c) MN 31/03/10.** A large teddy bear of a chap with good type. Head shape good although it did look a little small in comparison to the very large body, good width to skull with medium sized ears set well, fairly full cheeks. Round eyes with mid gold colour. Profile good with short nose, chin good, bite marginally under. Large very substantial and cobby body, short strong boned limbs and medium length tail. Pretty mid lilac coat, that was a little unsound, medium in length and of generally good texture. An easy boy to handle, excellently presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Gains’ COTTAGE BUGSY MALONE (14a) 06/09/07.** A very dear boy in lovely condition but his head is bordering on exotic for type, with very short nose and exaggerated nose break, he also has deep lines running from the corner of his eyes down to the muzzle. His bite is rather untidy with a couple of incisors missing and is scissored under. Good body type, cobby and substantial with strong limbs, round paws and medium length tail. Pristine white coat, beautifully prepared, length and texture very good today. Excellent temperament and presentation.

**A.C. British Smoke or Tipped Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Amarilli’s INSIDER MANFRED (IMP) (TICA CH) (79S 36) MN 13/09/05.** An older boy, overall he is well balanced but lacks masculinity. Round head, good width to skull with medium sized ears. Muzzle has well padded whisker pads but is tending to being rather wedge shaped. Good shape and expression to eyes of pale green colour. Very substantial body with medium length limbs and tail to balance. Attractive smoke coat, but rexing very light indeed and the texture could be better. A friendly boy.

**A.C. Colourpointed British SH Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Ward’s CH LARNIKAT TIGER LILY (40 8) FN 20/05/06.** A lovely girl, excellent type. Rounded head with very good width to skull and super full cheeks, ears small neat and set to perfection. Open expression to eyes of clear blue colour, rounded forehead and short neat nose, strong chin and level bite. Excellent strong and cobby body, short strong limbs and round paws, medium length tail. Pretty mid blue and pale cream points colouring, coat contrast very good with the lightest of pale tortie shading over the lower back. Coat very good for length, just marginally soft in texture. Lovely to handle and excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Riley’s LILACMIST ROLY POLY (40 7) MN 20/01/09.** A huge lad of overall good type. Head shape good with breadth to skull and full cheeks, ears of good size and set. Rounded forehead, nose marginally long and the muzzle could be a little more rounded, chin and bite good. Round eyes of clear blue colour. Very substantial body with deep broad chest, strong boned limbs and round paws, medium length tail to balance. Cream points that were rather warm in tone, coat contrast good, lightly shaded overall to tone with his points, a little long and slightly soft in texture, he was also losing a fair amount of hair today. A dear boy to handle.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Wilson’s ADECISH DAISY DUKE (40 4) FN 13/05/10.** A neat little queen of good type. Round head with fairly good width to skull, ears a touch large but set well. Round eyes with good expression and clear blue colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Not the largest of girls but the body is still nice and cobby with good width to chest, short limbs and neat round paws, medium length tail. Mid lilac points and pale magnolia coat that was virtually clear of shading. Coat length good but texture rather soft. A sweet tempered lady, excellently presented.

#### **A.V. Adolescent Cat**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Clarke’s FOXYPAWS LEXI (37fn) F 25/07/10.** A stylish young miss but rather small and dainty for an adult as yet. Head quite typey with large well set ears, good eye shape and set with very good green colour. Apricot coat colour very good, a rich hot tone, some spotted pattern evident but acceptable for age and it is generally sound. Super condition and temperament – just need to mature.

#### **A.V. Junior Cat**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Freeman’s CH SOLARUS MAILLOT JEUNE (37f) 10/08/09** A handsome lad for type, with good green eyes, and he has a strong well muscled body. Coat colour a little mismatched today with cream head and hot toned apricot body. Sweet tempered.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – White’s LITTLEWILLOW BELLATRIX (24) F 10/02/10.** A neat little queen, not the largest of ladies but weighty and solid. Good warm toned seal points. A friendly lady.

#### **A.V. Senior Cat**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Gibbons’ GD CH RICHDALÉ LONE RANGER (24) 22/02/07**

#### **A.V. Oriental Kitten (not bred by Exhibitor) Male**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Bauerfeind’s TOGHAR RHYTHM-N-BLUES (37a) M 17/11/10.** Overall good type to this boy, he is a touch dainty for 6 months but has plenty of time to develop. Medium length wedge, top line is marginally narrow for good balance. Good

eye shape and set with excellent vivid green colour. Short close coat a darker blue but sound. Easy to handle.

**A.V. Oriental Neuter (not bred by Exhibitor)**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Buckley's CH WESTGART DI NIRO (37k) MN 08/03/09.** Lovely strong type to his masculine lad. Excellent head type and strength with wide top and very large ears set to balance. Naughty expression to hazel green eyes. Cinnamon coat marginally dark and a little unsound today. A very relaxed boy.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Hinson's WESTGARTH SINCLAIR (37r) MN 16/04/10.** An attractive lad of overall good type. Fairly well balanced head with large well set ears. Good expression to pale green eyes. Coat a darker fawn tone and it was rather unsound, but length and texture very good. Excellent to handle.
