Many thanks to Carol & Ron for the judging invitation, I had some lovely cats to judge today. Thanks also to my steward & good friend Barbie James for her expertise and excellent company.

OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Male

GD PC – Hutching's GD PR MAFDET MACARTHUR (32/8) MN 23/04/09. A beautiful boy, not the most masculine of lads but his style is excellent and he is not small by any mean Almost perfect balance to head with excellent top and he holds his ears beautifully at all times. Super eyes for shape, set, expression and colour. Straight profile and firm chin, bite untidy but virtually level. Long elegant but weighty body, long slender limbs, tail needs length to balance. Excellent tabby markings in cool toned lilac-based caramel, I know it is no longer in the SOP, nevertheless he does show a bluish metallic sheen on his scarab, tail rings show along the entire length of the tail. Virtually un-shaded coat, length and texture much better today. Excellent to handle as always, beautifully presented.

R – Mason's PR ROZANDEN RUAIDHRI (32a) MN 06/06/08. Another handsome lad of very good type and lovely substance. Medium length wedge with very good top line and large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with such a sweet expression and good depth of colour. Almost straight profile and firm chin, bite level, marginal pinch. Long, strong and weighty body with long limbs and tail to balance. Bright red points colour, warm white coat with light shading down the spine, length and texture excellent, short sleek and close lying. Excellent temperament, a very relaxed boy, excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Female

GD PC – McAlpine's PR LYNNOX FRANCESCA (24b) FN 17/06/05. This girl look really good posing in her pen, she is a big girl with lovely type and substance. Strong head for a female and very well balanced with excellent top and large open based ears set to follow. Super eyes, for shape set and expression with deep brilliant sapphire blue colour. Bit of a dip to profile, chin okay, bite lacks incisors but looks reasonably level, if I were to nit pick she could be marginally finer on the muzzle. Long elegant but weighty body with an excellent trim figure for a lady neuter of this age, long elegant limbs and tail to almost balance. Points colouring perhaps a touch dark but they were rich and warm in tone, and they matched well. Very good coat for length and texture with the lightest of shading over the hips to tone. Excellent to handle and beautifully presented.

R – Petchell's PR HEATHLANDS SWEET MOLANNA (32/1) FN 10/10/05. A dainty and feminine lady of good type and style. Shorter wedge with very good width to her top line, ears could be a touch larger but set to almost balance. Oriental eye shape and set with gentle expression, colour okay, looks as though it has begun to fade out a touch. Fairly good profile, good chin and bite, small pinch to muzzle. Good length body well covered – perhaps a little too much so, but still shows

elegance, neat limbs and paws, tail just about balances. Very dark seal tabby markings with large clear thumb prints and well ringed tail. Excellent coat texture, beautifully sleek and close with excellent contrast for a seal tabby of this age. A most appealing lady with a gentle nature, and who looked so much better out of her pen. Excellently presented.

Oriental Shaded Neuter

PC & BOB – Hutching’s GD PR WILLHAVETODO IMJUSTDIVINE (43e) FN 04/08/07. An old friend who I have judged so many times, I have little to add to previous critiques other than today she seems to have a marginal unsound grey area at the root of her coat. She is very beautiful but hides it away under a blanket, which is a pity, she was in immaculate condition as always and was my choice for Best Oriental Neuter. What I am pleased to see, is that all the controversy over her pattern seems to have gone away, jolly good job too!

Oriental Bicolour Neuter

PC & BOB – Meekings’ RANTIPOLE REMEMBRANCE (48 40b) MN 23/03/09. A stylish boy, not the largest of lads but surprisingly weighty. Very good head for style and balance with excellent top and large open based ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape set and expression, with good depth of blue for a Bicolour. Almost straight profile and good chin with clean and level bite. Elegant neck, long, substantial and firm toned body, long limbs, well tapered tail to balance. Slightly dark chocolate points, but warm in tone, and again, very good for a Bicolour. White areas good to over the one third, required with inverted “V” on mask, a small smidge on the nose and around the muzzle. His tummy is almost completely white, just a small island of colour around the sternum area. There is a small patch of white on the back and on the flanks, also on the chest and all four limbs. Coat length and texture very good, lying close. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

Tortie Point Siamese Kitten

1st & BOB – Budden’s MYLYNN MIADORA (32b1) 21/07/10. A gorgeous little baby, very promising indeed. Super little head with huge butterfly ears beautifully set. Excellent eye shape and set with a really inscrutable expression and mid blue colour. Baby growth dips to profile as yet, good firm chin and level bite. Long dainty body, really solid in tone, fine spidery limbs and dainty spoon paws, super whippy and string like tail to balance. Seal tortie points rather “black & white” at present but there is the promise of some warmer red tones coming through on the ears and tail. Coat short and close lying, almost clear of shading. A real pocket job and my take home of the day.... Excellently presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.C. Oriental Adult not bred by Exhibitor

1st – Roper’s CH SNOWSEAL SUNNYDELIGHT (37r) F 09/09/09. A neat female of very good type, rather petite but she has some excellent qualities. Head type good and she has excellent green eye colour. Her coat was a touch unsound today, but it is mainly free from ghosting, the colour is lovely and the texture today was superb. Excellent temperament and condition.

2nd – McDougal’s NUTROSTAR JOE’S SMOKEY SKIES (42) M 21/04/07. A huge person going through his ”puppy” stage at present. Type good although he has a somewhat innocent look about him. He too has some excellent qualities, his eyes are a very good green albeit a little full in shape, and his coat is excellent, dense sleek black with a pristine white undercoat half way up the hair shaft. Lovely coat texture too, being a silver cat you would expect this. Excellent to handle.

3rd – Haggar’s GD CH SUSPIRIA SIMPLY SOLARUS (37r) M 21/04/07. This dear lad has the most perfect temperament. Type good, although for me he lacks a little style, he is a nice masculine lad with very good colour. It was a pity today that his coat was not right, he did not help matters by fluffing himself up with pleasure but it was still soft and fine in texture.

A.C. Oriental Maiden Kitten

1st – Janicki’s SHERMESE TICKS ALL THE BOXES (45b) M 07/07/10. He does indeed - superlative kitten, with lovely type and beautifully grown. He has the best ticked coat I have seen for a long time with 4 bands of ticking evident even though his coat is relatively short – presumably homozygous for ticked given his parentage, which probably explains his minimal spine line. Excellent to handle and later my choice for BOV Oriental.

2nd – Johnston’s PIPASTRO LORENZETTI (62 21b) 07/07/10. A well grown and promising baby. Strong head with very good top line, eyes a touch full but very good for colour. Lovely coat colouring with lots of rich red mingling, picking out the underlying tabby pattern on the legs and tail in particular. Coat length also promising, beginning to frill at the lower sides already and the texture is gorgeous. Easy to handle.

3rd – Baxter’s PIPASTRO CHOCOLATIER (62 36b) M 15/07/10. I like this baby very much for type, and his coat length is very good for his age, however, at the moment he has problems with the colour/pattern on the body. It is cool toned mid chocolate interspersed with many paler ticked hairs with little or no clear silver undercoat, hopefully this will sort itself out as he grows, lovely smoky ears flutings though!

I would like to mention kitten no 397, I thought she was very promising but felt she was not feeling 100% today.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Aristocrat Adult

1st – Davis’ ROZANDEN RADZIMIERZ (32a) M 01/09/09. A young male of good type but who lacks strength and maturity at present. Longer wedge with a marginally square muzzle, head top good and ears large. Eyes good for shape and set with mid blue colour. Points a rather pale red but bright in tone. Excellent to handle.

2nd – Cosgrove’s ZAFIRA PENELOPE PITSTOP (32c) F 02/08/09. A neat little queen, dainty but stylish. Points colouring rather warm for a cream. Coat un-shaded of good length and texture. Sweet tempered.

3rd – Mackechnie’s MORALYN RED ROBIN (32a) M 04/03/07. Mature male with a shorter strong head, he needs a better chin, his eyes are slightly straight set but a very good colour. Excellent rich red points. Handled well for a full male.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Maiden Adult

1st – Budden’s JOMESE JAZEERA (32b1) F 29/01/10. A well developed girl for 10 months, of very good type and style. Longer wedge but top line excellent and the ears are very well set. Straight profile and spot on chin of depth with level bite. Seal tortie points are a touch cold in tone and I would prefer to see some richer red. Coat excellent for length and texture but fairly heavily shaded for a young queen. Excellent temperament.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Debutante Kitten

An excellent and closely contested class.

1st - Budden’s MYLYNN MIADORA (32b1) 21/07/10

2nd – Dresou’s ADECIAM LADY-LILY (24n) F 03/07/10. A lovely baby, very promising baby for type as she has wonderful eye colour. Points colouring also well developed for age with clear brownish tones on the ears. Good clear coat of very good texture. One to watch.

3rd – Lodwig’s ATARIQ SOLOMAN (24) MN 03/05/10. A stylish boy, nicely grown for age. Well balanced head and very good eye shape set and colour. Points a little black toned particularly on the ears, warmer on the front paws, coat also rather cool toned for a seal. Excellent temperament.

ex 3rd – Simpson’s DORAL MIDSUMMERBLUE (32/2) F 18/06/10. Extremely well grown for age, type very good with quite a strong head for a girl. Eyes good for shape set and colour although she does tend to squint at times, teething maybe? Very good tabby markings in soft mid blue with excellent tail rings. Sweet tempered.

3rd - Simpson’s DORAL MIDSUMMERBLUE (32/2) F 18/06/10

A.C. Siamese Neuter bred by Exhibitor

1st – Mackenzie-Sproat’s GD PR ADATEAM CINNPONY CHESTER (24k) MN 21/06/07. A lovely boy for type and style, he lacks a little in masculinity but you can’t have everything and he has very good substance. He has such a sweet expression, eye colour could be a fraction deeper but is perfectly acceptable. Excellent points colouring, rich spicy cinnamon and matching. A joy to handle.

2nd – Blore’s CH LUPAZ WENDELLA (32t1) FN 10/12/02. A big strong lady neuter of very good type, and wearing her years well. Well balanced head with very good top and large ears set to follow. Very good eye shape set and set with disdainful expression and good colour. Has a really good tortie tabby pattern with rich red

mingling on the ears. Good to see the oldies giving the youngsters a run for their money! Handled well, in top condition.

3rd – Watson’s PR MALIKASIAM MALAIKA SAEEDA (24a) FN 07/10/07. A neat and tidy lady neuter who would look a whole lot better if she slimmed down a touch. She has very good head type but it appears small in proportion to the body. Very good points colouring, a soft mid blue, almost matching. Coat of good length and texture, shaded overall in fawn-ish blue, some glacial tones show on bib and tummy. Sweet tempered and excellently presented.
