BREED CLASSES

Siamese or Balinese Male Champion

GD CC – Withers' CH TINTALLY TIME LORD (24n) M 09/05/10. Gorgeous boy, lovely strong type and he is so mature for his age. Strong masculine head of medium length with super broad top line and very large wide based ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape and set with lovely expression and excellent depth of colour. Strong profile, chin goes back a touch but has good depth and the bite is level. Long strong and well muscled body, long limbs and well tapered tail that almost balances. Very good points colour with obvious brownish over tones to tail in particular, and he has that toffee coloured fur under his feet, colour beginning to run over the top of the skull I note, but there is still plenty of contrast. Off white coat of excellent length and texture, lightly shaded overall to tone. Perfect temperament, he was a joy to handle. Excellently presented.

R - Howarth's CH MIYASAMA MOURHINO (24) M 04/06/09. A handsome male of overall very good type and style. Very good balance to medium length head, top line very good and the ears are very well set in line. Basic eye shape good although he tends to widen at times, colour mid blue. Good profile and chin, bite lacks a couple of incisors but looks level, small pinch to muzzle. Long lean but well muscled body, long limbs, tail to balance. Very dark dense seal points but showing a good deal of warmth of tone, particularly to the limbs. Coat impressive for contrast, pale and creamy toned with light warm seal shading down the spine, length and texture excellent, beautifully short and sleek. Another entire who was super to handle – makes my job so much easier and much more enjoyable. Excellently presented.

Siamese or Balinese Female Champion

GD CC – Cook's CH JOHPAS MIZMIXTURE (32b2) F 14/07/10. Possibly the loveliest female I have seen, fulfilling all the promise that she showed as a kitten and if anything is even better. Simply fabulous my notes say, wonderful head with huge ears, and a perfect set that never changes. I love her eyes they have such a deep expression and the colouring is excellent. She has a tiny dip to her profile without robbing it of strength, chin good and bite level. Lovely size and substance for a young queen, long elegant limbs, to nit pick her tail could do with being a little longer. Darker blue tortie points which seem to have lost most of that slightly muddy overtone she had as a kitten, plentiful pale cream mingling on most points apart from the hind limbs where you have to hunt for the couple of cream hairs that are there. Excellent coat showing good glacial tones, lightly shaded overall, short close-lying and very sleek in texture. Perfect to handle, beautifully relaxed and so sure of her own worth. Have run out of superlatives but she really is perfection personified.

R – Withers' CH TINTALLY TICKERTY BOO (24n) F 15/05/10. Another lovely female who was very unlucky to be up against the other girl today. Stylish

head with lovely top and super large ears beautifully set. Oriental eye shape and set – perhaps marginally wide, but colour excellent, with very good depth and brilliance of tone. Tiny dip to strong profile, firm chin and level bite. Elegant neck, long weighty and firm toned body, long slender limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Wonderful points colour – this has always been her best feature, lilac-based caramel with the best brownish overtone tone you are likely to see in such a young cat. Excellent coat contrast too, cool toned off-white with minimal shading to tone, coat length and texture excellent. Excellent to handle and beautifully presented.

Lilac Point Female Kitten

1st & BOB – Freeman’s FLUTTERBY MY VALENTINA (24c) F 14/02/11. An attractive baby of good type and style. Medium wedge with good top of head, ears fairly large, nicely flared and well set. Super eyes for shape set and expression with really brilliant colour. Almost straight profile, chin lines up with the nose tip but could be marginally deeper, bite level. Dainty but firm toned baby body of promising length, long fine limbs and neat paws, super whippy tail to balance. Mid lilac points, perhaps a touch blue toned, but the lighting may have been responsible for that, completely clear coat with very good length and texture for a baby. The sweetest person, very poised in her little nest. Excellently presented.

Caramel Point Male Neuter

PC & BOB – Ellis’ CH TINTALLY JUST THE TICKET (24n) MN 15/05/10. A lovely boy with excellent type and super development. Strong head with broad top line and very large ears set to balance. Good profile and firm chin with level bite. Very substantial and weighty body of very good length, long strong limbs and tapered tail that almost balances. Super points colour, blue-based caramel with clear brownish over-tones to ears and tail, paw pads purplish brown, his coat is heavily shaded but there is a little contrast still evident, coat texture really lovely, it was very short, close and sleek to the touch. Perfect temperament, handled beautifully. Excellently presented.

Also considered for BOB – Johnson’s PR ADNIOAM JUST ABOUT ME (24n) MN 07/02/09. A dear boy who is always so easy to handle. Type and style good with medium length wedge, top of head could be a touch wider for perfection but looks better when he relaxes. Good eye shape and set, colour could be a touch deeper. Almost straight profile and good chin, bite a little untidy, with the odd top incisor missing, but level. Long weighty body, well toned and elegant, long limbs, tail needs an inch to balance. Dark blue-based caramel points with a little brownish over tone on the tail, off-white coat with medium shading to tone, today it was rather long and over-fine in texture. Very sweet tempered, excellently presented.

& Turnbull’s PR MALIKASIAM MICKALA-MAY (24n) FN 02/05/08. A neat lady neuter of overall good type. Medium length wedge with good top of head and fairly large ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour, but tends to squint somewhat when she is cross. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Dainty but well covered and firm toned body of good length, dainty limbs and paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Lilac.-based caramel points well matched. Almost clear off-white coat of super sleek texture. Not entirely happy but handled okay. Excellently presented.

Red Point Female Kitten

1st & BOB – Rigby's JOHPAS SUMMALOVIN (32a) F 12/10/11. A typey little babe but rather small for 7 months. Stylish head with very good top line and large flared ears very well set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with lovely colour and brilliance of tone. Good profile and chin with a dear little beard, chin goes back a touch but has good depth, bite level. Body has good length and is reasonably weighty but needs to be firmer in tone, if has a rather soft feel to it, long limbs and tail. Bright red points colour, warm white coat completely unshaded, however it was rather long, fine and open today and I was concerned that she was not feeling 100% today, however it would appear that she was changing her back teeth. Lovely temperament, handled really well, excellently presented

BREED CLASSES

Champ of Champs Male

GD CC – Simpson’s CH SHERMESE KUDOS (37k) M 28/05/10. Very good type and strength to this lad. Strong stylish head with very good top line and large wide-based ears set to follow. Eyes more oval than oriental in shape, setting good, colour olive green. Marginal dip to profile, firm chin and level bite. Long well muscled body with long elegant limbs, tail needs an inch to balance. Rich toned cinnamon colour to coat, virtually sound and free from ghosting, it was very short and close but a little greasy and there was evidence of stud tail, it was therefore touch and go for the certificate today, however, I do understand that boys can sometimes be difficult to present properly and felt he had other very good qualities to justify it. Excellent temperament.

Oriental Blue Male Kitten

1st & BOB – Bauerfeind’s TOGHAR RHYTHM-N-BLUES (37a) M 17/11/10. Overall a nice boy and well grown. Longer wedge with top line a touch narrow, ears large, set on well but a little close. Oriental eye shape set and expression, colour a slightly yellow toned green. Rather a pronounced dip to profile at present, chin firm and bite level. Long firm body, with long limbs and tail to almost balance. Coat a darker shade of blue, but it was sound and the length and texture was very good. A sweet chap excellently presented.

Oriental Bicolour Male Neuter

PC & BOB – Finn’s PALANTIR SNOWSTRIPE (48n) MN 02/11/07. There were some very good Bicolours here today and the CC & BOB were hotly contested. In the end I went for the overall style of this lovely boy. Super head type with wide top line and very large flared ears beautifully set. Expressive eyes of very good shape and set with yellowish green colour. A fair old dip to nose, chin deep and in line with the nose tip, level bite. Very long and slender but deceptively weighty body, long elegant limbs and neat oval paws, very good whip tail to balance. Dark lilac-based caramel coat which was virtually sound, with just on the one third white, on face and all four limbs, under tummy with a couple of narrow ribbons over the haunches, coat length and texture was excellent. He is rather a shy chap but he handled well. Excellently presented.

2nd – Freemont’s LUNATORA CATCHMEIFYOUCAN (48 43s) MN 15/06/10. Super size and substance to this neuter boy. Head seems to have lengthened since we last met and thus the top line is now marginally narrow for balance, ears of very good size and set to follow the lines of the wedge. Eyes oval in shape and he can widen them at times, setting good, colour olive green. Strong profile and good chin with level bite, tiny pinch to muzzle. Huge weighty, “puppy” body at present that needs to

fine down, long strong boned limbs, tail almost balances. Light black shaded areas to coat, over back on the head and a little over the shoulder with tabby tail, white areas to almost two thirds, some tarnishing to muzzle evident. Excellent length and texture to coat. A lovely boy to handle, presented to perfection.

3rd – Smith’s PATCHESTY PUSS IN BOOTS (48 40) MN 03/02/10. Overall a very nice boy for type and style, but border-line for amount of white. Medium length wedge with good top of head and large ears well set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with mid blue colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Long well toned and substantial body, longish limbs, tail needs a touch more length to balance. Very dark seal points and quite heavily seal shaded areas to coat, however, they did show a good deal of warmth of tone for a Bicolour. He has white across the chest, a little on the mask, some on all four and limbs, with a narrow white line down the tummy, all in all I don’t think he has the one third white required, unfortunately. Coat length and texture very good. An easy boy to handle and excellently presented.

Oriental Bicolour Female Neuter

PC – Dinsdale’s APPLEJACK VANILLA-SKY (48b) FN 26/05/07. A large girl of overall good type. She has quite a heavy head but it is reasonably wedge shape with a good top line, ears are just about large enough and well set. Oval shaped eyes, well set with a lovely clear green colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Substantial and weighty body of medium length, strong limbs, tail rather short for balance. Coat pattern predominantly white and almost “Van” patterned, chocolate areas very dark in tone but sound. Super coat texture, short sleek and close lying. Handled well, excellently presented.

Also considered for BOB – Whiston’s GD PR MIYOKO CHIQUITITA (48 45bs) FN 21/11/08. A very attractive and well balanced lady neuter who ran the winner close for BOB. Medium length wedge, it is a very feminine head, with good top line and large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with mid green colour. Marginal dip to nose, good firm chin, bite a tad over. Excellent tone to long weighty body, slender limbs and neat oval paws, tail almost balances. Chocolate shaded areas to coat very dark indeed, almost black, but the paw pads are chocolate, shading quite heavy for her age. White areas in all the correct places, to nearly a half, coat length and texture good today. Handled beautifully as always, excellently presented.
