OPEN CLASSES

Siamese or Balinese Champion Male

GD CC – Bunyan's CH MAFDET BLUE MOON (24n) 22/04/09. A very stylish lad, he is still marginally immature looking but not unreasonably so for his age. Very good head type with large ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set with naughty expression and very good depth of colour. Excellent, strong profile, good chin and level bite. Long well defined neck, long adolescent body, elegant limbs and spoon paws, long tapered tail to balance. Very good points colour, sludgy toned blue-based caramel with particularly good brownish tones on the tail. Short close off-white coat with medium shading to tone. Excellent to handle and beautifully presented.

2nd R w/h – Hart's CH S*A'FAMOSA WAHANASSATTA (61at) 29/11/08. I like the type and strength of this boy very much, he has very good masculinity and maturity. Strong medium wedge with wide top line, ears could be a touch larger but were very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with medium blue colour. Well muscled and substantial body of very good length, strong boned limbs and large paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Rather a muddy toned blue to tabby markings but paw pads correct for blue. Good tail rings. Overall his coat could have been a little longer and his plume was only sparsely furnished. Unfortunately the texture was not correct today and was rather greasy, which was a pity as I would otherwise have been happy to award the Reserve. Excellent temperament.

Siamese or Balinese Champion Female

GD CC – Pounds' GD CH JOMESE JENNY MANYDOTS (32b1) 03/08/07. This lady has such a beautiful temperament and really knows how to relax and show herself. Very good head with lovely wide top line and large ears that follow the lines of the wedge very well indeed. Oriental eye shape, setting marginally straight, colour could be a touch deeper but was acceptable. Very good profile and chin, bite untidy but level. Long neck with long slender and well toned body, elegant limbs and neat spoon paws, long whip to balance. Dark seal tortie points extensively mingled on all points in mainly mid red, with some deeper tones showing on the ears. Super coat today, very short and sleek, shaded overall to tone. Beautifully poised and presented.

R – Stokes' GD CH LITTLEFEAT TATTOO HEART (32b1) 26/11/05. Another lovely lady, and it was very close between these two. Strong well balanced medium wedge with very good top of head and large wide based ears that she was holding flat with nervousness today. Good shape and set to eyes, held a little full, but very good for colour. Almost straight profile and good chin with slightly untidy but level bite. Well covered body of good length, hiding her neck today, long slender limbs and neat paws, tail almost balances. Tortie points bordering on black rather than seal and it was this, in the end, that was the deciding factor between the girls, mingling very good in paler red, with deeper shades evident on the ears. Good length and texture to coat,

quite heavily shaded overall, but some contrast still seen. Very shy and upset today which was a shame. Beautifully presented.

Tortie Point Neuter

PC & BOB – Dinsdale's GD CH & GD PR APPLEJACK BLUEFENIX (32b) 24/01/06. A dear lady of good type and style. Shorter wedge with good top line and fairly large ears set to almost balance. Oriental eye shape, set and expression with good depth of colour. Straight profile and firm chin with level bite. Comfortably covered body of medium length, neat limbs and paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Dark, slightly muddy blue tortie points with pale and mid cream mingling on all points. Medium length coat of good texture, shaded overall in slightly muddy tones but good contrast still for this colour. Handled well today and was beautifully presented.

Apricot Point Male Kitten

1st & BOB – Ringrose's JAKURTZZI NIGHTSIDE OF EDEN 02/10/09. A really lovely male kitten of excellent type. Very stylish head with excellent top width and large flyaway ears beautifully set. Super expression to eyes of excellent shape and set, colour okay but could be a touch more intense in tone. Straight strong profile with deep chin and level bite. Long body of fairly good weight but he seems to have lost some of the muscle tone over his spine since we last met, long strong limbs and long whip tail to balance. Points colour developing well and beginning to show the desired hot tones, particularly on the ears. Some light shading to off-white coat of slightly fine texture. Super to handle.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.O.C. Siamese Breeders Adult

1st – Reed's IMP GD CH JOHPAS SENORITA RUMBALITA (32a) F 01/05/05. A superior exhibit in every way and of whom I have waxed long and lyrical in the past. Wonderful strong type for a female, if only all Siamese girls had her size and substance. I would just like her points a touch more intense, but that really is nit picking. Perfect temperament, I wish she were mine!

Chocolate Point Siamese Breeders Kitten

1st – Green's BELROO KINDAMAGIC (24b) M 17/11/09. A well grown and quite sturdy little boy of good type. Longer head with large ears that are set a little high. Oriental eye shape, rather straight set at present but good colour. Points are dark chocolate but with a modicum of warmth to them, some brindling shows on mask. A sweet boy to handle.

Breed 32 Siamese Non-Breeders Kitten

1st – Sidnell's MYLYNN MARISSA (32c) 27/11/09. A typy baby with a lovely head and good eye colour. However, although I was not prepared to wrong colour on the day, I do think she is apricot rather than cream. There are suspiciously hot tones to the base of the ears and a hot patch above the hocks, she is also shading up at a very young age, which is generally a good indicator. Super to handle.

Male Neuter (Breeds 32 or Balinese equivalent)

1st – Hutching's PR MAFDET MACARTHUR (32/8) MN 23/04/09. I do love the look of this lad, he has that true expression that sets the Siamese apart from other breeds, and the depth of colour and brilliance of tone was excellent. Super head type with excellent top line and large flared ears excellently set. He is a touch effeminate for a bloke but he has so many other things going for him that that should not really cramp his style too much – just his tail which really is short, albeit very well ringed. Perfect temperament, liquid cat in fact.

2nd – Janicki's PR SHERMESE LIFE O'RILEY (32/1) MN 10/09/08. Another lovely boy, who ran the winner close. Well balanced medium length wedge with very good sized ears set to follow. Good shape to eyes, setting a little straight, colour mid blue. He has matured somewhat since we last met and now has very good substance and tone to body. Ticked based tabby pattern with minimal rings to tail. Super coat for length and texture. A dear boy to handle.

3rd – Blank's JOHPAS RED EDDIE (32a) MN 06/08/09. A simply enormous chap for 10 months, overall type very good. Strong head with good width between large flared ears of very good set. It is a pity that his eye colour is so pale because it does detract somewhat. Points colour very good with rich bright tones to it. A friendly boy.
