OPEN CLASSES

Siamese or Balinese Male Champion

GD CC – Reed’s IMP GD CH AMYDAY SUNSPANGLED (32fn) 18/07/08.

Beautifully balanced male of excellent type. Strong and stylish head with super wide top line and enormous bat ears, that for some maybe a touch low, but for me are perfect. Excellent eye shape set and expression, colour mid blue. Excellent profile, chin could be a mite stronger, bite lacks top incisors but appears level. Long elegant and well toned body with long limbs and neat spoon paws, tail needs a touch more length and has a rather knobbly end to it that you can feel but not see. Apricot points colour on the paler side, but to be fair the lighting was tending to wash out the red series cats today. Medium length coat lying close and lightly shaded overall. The most perfect temperament for a full male and a joy to handle. Excellently presented.

R – Ridgeway’s CH HARTZIE BLAZE-OF-GLORY (24k) 05/06/09. Overall an attractive boy, not the style of the winner but does have some good qualities. Shorter wedge with good top line and proportionate ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could be deeper. Almost straight profile and firm chin with level bite. Long weighty body, but needs to attain muscle tone, tummy line a little full, long limbs, tail needs an inch to balance. Warm spicy cinnamon points, matching, apart from the tail which is rather brindled today. Very good coat qualities, short close and excellent for texture, virtually un-shaded. Excellent temperament and presentation.

Some excellent ladies, with mere whiskers separating them all.

GD CC – CH LAZIZA KISMET (32b8) 31/05/08. A lovely large mature girl with very good type and substance. Balanced head and stylish with very good top and large ears set in line with the wedge. Good shape to eyes – can hold a touch wide at times but good when relaxed, colour very good indeed. Super strong profile with chin spot on and bite level. Excellent substance and tone to long body, long elegant limbs, tapered tail to balance. Blue-based caramel tortie points with clear brownish overlay on mask and tail, mainly mid apricot mingling, picking out the ghost tabby pattern on the hind limbs and tail, with interesting pale tip to tail. Good close lying coat of lovely texture, shaded overall in muddy tones, contrast still evident. A very easy lady to handle – won this class on overall maturity - I do like a good sized girl. Excellently presented.

R – Reed’s CH HELSBELS CHUCHOTEZ-LE (32a) 11/09/08. A slightly dainty but stylish lady with lovely type. Typy head with excellent top line and large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape set and expression with good depth of colour. Almost straight profile, firm chin and level bite, small pinch to muzzle today. Elegant neck with long slender but weighty body, long dainty limbs and long whip to almost balance. Very good bright red points colouring, typically paler on front limbs. Un-shaded warm white coat of good close texture and very good length. Excellent to

handle – not in the least bothered by baby's shenanigans two pens away. Excellently presented.

Tabby Point Male Kitten

1st – FLUTTERBY FRAZZLES (32/10) 08/08/10. Typy baby but a little on the small side for a male kitten of 6 months. Medium length wedge with good top of head, ears large and well set but with a tendency to top at times. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Tiny dip to nose, good chin and level bite. Long body with good weight and coverage for size, long limbs and long whip tail to balance. Warm matte apricot tabby markings developing, quite promising for colour, with good hot toned tail rings. Soft fine baby coat at present, off white in colour and virtually un-shaded. A dear boy to handle and excellently presented.

Tabby Point Female Kitten

1st & BOB – Simpson's SHERMESE SIENNA (32/3) 28/05/10. I like the overall style of this girl, but I would like her to be bigger, she will be adult in just over a week and she has a fair amount of growing to do yet. Having said that she does have very good type and style with a lovely broad top to her medium length wedge and the ears are large, flared, wide at the base and very well set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with very good depth of colour. Quite a pronounced dip to centre nose, chin firm and bite level. Surprisingly weighty body of very good length and tone, long slender limbs and neat paws, ultra whippy tail needs a touch more length to balance. Mid chocolate tabby markings with slight gingery tones to the ears, pattern good with double cheek tracings, clear scarab and thumb prints, paler multi bracelets and well ringed tail. Un-shaded ivory coat with very good length and texture. Excellent temperament and presentation.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Maiden Adult

A quality class

1st – Withers' TINTALLY TIMELORD (24n) M 09/05/10. A lovely young male, very well developed for 9 months and with an excellent weighty and strong feel to him already. Very good for type and style with strong head and large ears. Fabulous points colour, so very well developed for a youngster with excellent sludgy over tones on all points. Super to handle and presented to perfection.

2nd – Skivington's TINTALLY LADY GAGA (32/8) F 09/05/10. (See SP report)

3rd – Sidnell's MYLYNN MARISSA (32fn) F 27/11/09. A dainty and stylish lady with very good head and ear flare. Good eye colour and expression. Good warm toned apricot points and very good coat length and texture. Shy but gentle, excellently presented.

32 Series Kitten or Balinese equivalent

1st - Simpson's SHERMESE SIENNA (32/3) F 28/05/10

2nd - FLUTTERBY FRAZZLES (32/10) M 08/08/10

Novice Kitten

1st – Kincade’s LAZIZA DAISY POPPETTS (32b1) F 15/06/10. A beautifully grown kitten with very good type. Stylish head with excellent top line and very large open based ears set to balance, showing a pinch today. Very good eye shape, set and colour, but haws up a touch. Seal tortie points on the black & white side with cool tones to seal and the red is rather pale at present, well mingled throughout. Excellent to handle.

2nd – Stewart’s EDENPORT MERLIN (48 40dt) M 31/10/10. A dear little baby of good type and style. I am always very sympathetic to breeders of pointed Bicolours of this colour – as a breeder of them myself, I know it is very hard to see the white at this stage of development so I think allowance must be made till they are older. I could see a little on the mask, over one shoulder, the limbs look more developing red then white but can’t be definite on that. Like to see him again in a few weeks. Tabby pattern also hard to discern at this stage but tail is well ringed. Very friendly

3rd – Stewart’s EDENPORT CASPAR (48 40dt) M 31/10/10. Litter brother to the above, not quite as well grown but almost as good for type and he appears to be showing a little more white at present. He obviously has more on the mask because there is little red evident and it can be seen on all four limbs. Good tail rings but like his brother there is not much to see in the way of pattern other than this. Another friendly lad.

ex 3rd – Bunyan’s SARNAU SUNNYINTERVALS (32b8) F 03/07/10. Quite a typy babe but a little on the small side for 7 months. Marginally full in the eye but colour okay. Points rather soft and pretty for caramel at present. Very sweet tempered.

32 Series Breeders Neuter

1st – Reed’s IMP GD CH JOHPAS SENORITA RUMBALITA (32a) FN 01/05/05. Almost at the golden oldie stage but far from it in appearance, this gorgeous lady retains all her style and if anything her points colouring has improved since she was neutered. It was always on the paler side of red, but today it was really good and bright in tone. Love her style and expression and she has a perfect temperament. Deservedly overall BIS for both shows.

2nd – Ellams’ JAKURTZI KOBEJITSU (32fn) MN 02/10/09 (See SPSCC report)
