OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Siamese or Balinese Champion Male

GD CC – Simpson's CH MYLYNN MATINEE IDOL (24b) M 04/01/08.

Attractive boy, not the largest of males, but very handsome and stylish. Lovely head type with wide top-line and large flared ears set to balance. Expressive eyes for shape and set with good depth of colour. Almost straight profile, chin okay, bite a touch untidy but level. Long fairly well muscled body, long limbs and long whip tail. Very good points colour, and it was this that won him the certificate today, they were warm toned mid chocolate with the minimum of brindling, and unusually, they were even and almost matching in tone on all points, particularly when the colour is this good, with mask fully developed. His coat was quite heavily shaded for a chocolate, but there was still plenty of contrast, length good, texture a little soft and fine but laying fairly close. Perfect temperament for a full male and excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese or Balinese Champion Female

GD CC – Palmer's CH STYPERSON TOP DRAWER (32/1) F 01/07/08.

The gorgeous lady with OTT ears, I do love her size and substance which puts some males to shame. Strong head with excellent top and the huge flag like ears that have a tendency to droop lower than they should and have to be encouraged to be not quite so "relaxed". Very superior expression to eyes of good colour, perhaps marginally deep set. Strong profile and chin, bite has only 2 two incisors remaining but looks reasonably level. Wonderful weight and tone to long body, long strong limbs and long tail to balance. Tabby pattern interesting, she is clearly spotty based from the shading on the body, yet the extremities are not as clearly marked as you would expect for this pattern, the tail rings are widely spaced with a lot of ticking in between and she lacks cheek ribbons. Gorgeous coat today, very short, close and almost pelt-like, with super sleek texture. A joy to handle as always and beautifully presented.

R – Ellam's CH LAZIZA KISMET (32b8) F 31/05/08. An elegant little queen of very good type. Stylish head with very good top and large nicely flared ears very well set. Good shape and set to eyes although she has a tendency to hold them a little wide at times, colour bright mid blue. Good profile, firm chin and level bite. Long slender and firm toned body with weight appropriate to size, long elegant limbs and neat paws, tail very whippy and almost balances. Very good points colouring, blue-based caramel tortie with clear brownish tones to the mask and tail, and good apricot mingling, with particularly rich almost orangey tones to the ears and ghost ringing on the tail. Lightly shaded coat of good length, a touch fine in texture today but laying fairly close. A little tense but very sweet tempered. Beautifully presented.

A.C. Balinese Adult Female

1st CC & BOB w/h – Archer's RIDESTAR TIGER LILY (61dt) F 29/03/09. The sweetest person or goodish type, but rather small and kitten-like for an adult albeit a very young one. Short wedge, small in proportion to the body size at present and needs a little more width at the top plus a slightly longer muzzle to balance, ears of good size but set rather upright. Eyes full in shape of bright mid blue colour. Slight bump to profile near tip of nose, good chin and bite, small pinch to muzzle. Long quite weighty body, very good for substance and tone, longish dainty limbs and tail that almost balances. Excellent vibrant red colour to tabby markings, tail rings quite obvious today. Super coat texture, beautifully fine and silky, coat length on body acceptable but could be longer down the sides, plume rather sparse but better than when we last met. Excellent temperament, condition and presentation.

Chocolate Point Siamese Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Bowles-Gowdy's ARTENSA MYLYNN MERCEDES 25/10/09. A strong and well grown baby promising for type. Strong shorter wedge at present with very good top line and large ears very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Baby dip to nose, firm chin and level bite. Good length to solid and weighty little body, quite sturdy limbs and large paws, long whip tail to balance. Chocolate points marginally dark but fairly warm in tone, coat colour cooler in tone but un-shaded, with very good length and texture for a baby. Super temperament, a very confident young miss, excellently presented.

Chocolate Point Siamese Neuter Male

PC & BOB – Morgan's PR ASTRALBLAESE ACHILLES 22/03/08. A dear boy with good overall type and size. Longer wedge that need a touch more top width for good head balance, ear size good, set to follow the lines of the wedge. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour. Quite a strong profile with long fairly broad nose, firm chin and level bite. Long and elegant body with good weight and tone, long limbs but well tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Warm mid chocolate points, paler on limbs with mask not quite complete. Fabulous coat, beautifully sleek and close with minimal shading to tone. Very shy but handled well. Excellently presented.

Chocolate Point Siamese Neuter Female

PC – Simpson's FLUTTERBY TUK'S IN LUCKYLAND 08/02/07. This lady neuter has a very stylish head, it is medium in length with wide top and large wide based ears set to balance. Very good shape and set to eyes with "man eating" expression and very good depth of colour. Very good profile with deep strong chin perpendicular to nose tip and level bite. Long dainty body with good weight or size, slender limbs and spoon paws, tail need a touch more length to balance. Points colour dark for the breed standard, there is some warmth to them but it was for this reason that the BOB went to the male - for all that I preferred her type. Coat fairly heavily shaded and it was rather fine and open in texture. Not too happy and very vocal in her objections. Excellently presented

Tabby Point Siamese Neuter Male

PC – Janiki's SHERMESE LIFEORILEY (32/1) 10/09/08. A very typey neuter boy who still looks somewhat adolescent in appearance. Longer stylish head with excellent top and very large flyaway ears very well set. Very expressive eyes of good colour, they are still rather straight set even though his head has lengthened since we

last met. Strong profile with nice “fat” nose, good chin and level bite. Excellent tone to long deceptively weighty body, long limbs and good whip tail that almost balances. Very dark seal ticked-based tabby markings, scarab somewhat indistinct and tail rings to the minimum. Excellent coat for length and texture, pale beige and very lightly ticked overall to tone. Excellent temperament, a really lovely boy to handle. Excellent condition and presentation.

2nd – Esterford-Howard’s CH & PR MAPU MALACHITE (32/8) 18/06/07.

Another lovely boy, quite different in style from the winner but with some excellent qualities, and it was very close for the 1st place. Lovely head for style and balance but lacks a little masculinity. He does have beautiful eyes for shape, set, expression and colour. Profile shows a dip centre nose, chin firm and bite appears level but he now lacks incisors. Long fairly substantial body with a good trim tummy line, elegant limbs, tail need an inch to balance. I still have my reservations over his true colour, he really is more lilac than lilac-based caramel for me, being simply too pretty a colour for caramel which by his age should be dark and rather dirty looking, and this decided the placings today. Good pattern with super tail rings. Excellent coat for length texture and contrast, but more magnolia than cool toned off white. Outstanding temperament, he is so relaxed and loves being handled. Excellently presented.

Judged for BOB only and awarded – Bennett’s CH & PR DAZZLING SWEETALKING GUY (32/8) MN 21/02/07.

This boy on the other hand does have the correct colour for a lilac-based caramel tabby. Type, style and strength excellent, with strong, broad medium length wedge and very large wide based ears set to balance. Oriental eyes with typical expression and very good colour. Strong profile and chin with level bite. Excellent body type. Long, substantial yet elegant with very good muscle tone for a neuter, long limbs and excellent long whip tail. Correct dingy overtones to spotted based tabby pattern with excellent tail rings. Off white coat lightly shaded to tone, with super length and texture today. If only he had more self confidence and didn’t hide under his blankets, a shy but gentle boy excellently presented.

Also judged for BOB – Goddard’s PR DEBIKAT MARMALADY (32/3) FN 24/12/08.

A neat and stylish little lady neuter who is actually deceptively substantial and weighty. Well balanced medium length wedge with very good top and large butterfly ears set to balance. Good shape and set to eyes, perhaps marginally wide and sporting a slight “look” from time to time, medium blue in colour. Good length and tone to body, long dainty limbs, longish tail almost balances and has a small “pip” at the tip. Warm toned mid chocolate tabby markings well matched, with well ringed tail. Super coat today, minimally shaded and with excellent length and texture, from certain angles it almost sparkled. Excellent to handle as always and beautifully presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Maiden Adult

1st – Bunyan’s MAFDET BLUE MOON (24n) M 22/04/09. A large handsome lad with good maturity for age. Medium length wedge with good top line and large ears well set. Excellent strong profile and deep spot on chin with level bite. Blue-based caramel and excellent for points colour development at this young age with clear

brownish over tones to ears and tail and brownish shading to off white coat, the latter with very good length and texture. Excellent temperament.

2nd – Bunyan’s MYLYNN MEANTOBEE (32c) F 11/04/09. See SPSCS report.

ex 2nd – Godfrey & Turner’s MAFDET MISS MOSS (32/1) F 14/05/09. Gorgeous little female but with the emphasis on little at the moment. Although nice and solid she is more large kitten than adult at present. Lovely head with broad top and large butterfly ears set wide. Super eyes for shape, set, expression and colour. Excellent short close coat. She will be a force to be reckoned with if she grows up. Excellent temperament.

3rd – Gould’s MYLYNN MAISEE B (32a) F 11/04/09. See SPSCC report

Senior Adult

1st – Wither’s STYPERSON STARGAZER (32/1) F 26/01/08. A stylish girl with a well balanced and even head from the front view, but not quite so good from the side as the profile has quite a dip to the nose and the chin slopes back somewhat. “Classic” tabby markings with wide oddly spaced tail rings and faint oysters visible on her sides. Overall an attractive girl. Easy to handle.

2nd – Green’s BELROO ELKIE (24n) F 03/02/07. A good sized lady of good type Head a well balanced medium wedge with large well set ears. Eye shape, set and colour good but slightly red rimmed. Points colour could be a little more brownish in tone for a 3 year old but coat colour the correct cool-toned off-white. Plenty of weight and substance to her but body soft in tone. Her coat was a little long, fine in texture and open, overall I suspect she was touch out of sorts today. Lovely to handle.

Novice Kitten

This was s very good class with some excellent kittens.

1st – Reed’s HELSBELS CHUCHOTEZ-LE F 11/09/09. This I liked very much, well grown and very promising indeed. Excellent head, well balanced for a baby. Teething pinch to muzzle today which should sort it self out. Super expression to eyes of very good colour. Long really solid body and super long whippy tail. Points colour very promising with rich bright tones, unshaded warm white coat of good length and texture for a baby. Excellent temperament.

2nd – Godfrey & Turner’s PALMIRA DE-ZIRE (24) F 15/09/09. What a huge beautifully grown female for 5 months. Type very promising with strong head for a girl and large wide based ears, good to see a seal with deep blue eyes. Points colour very dense for a baby, her nose looks as though she has been dipped in tar, but there is some warmth to them. Correct creamy tones to coat of good length and texture. I am most interested to see how she develops. Beautifully poised and presented.

ex 2nd – Ellam’s JAKURTZZI VON ESPER (32c) F 02/10/09. Dainty baby of very good type. Typy head with large flared ears, very good eye shape set and colour particularly for a dilute. Points colour very good, soft pale cream, with unshaded coat. Long slender but solid little body with excellent whippy tail. Promising. Easy to handle.

3rd – Basham’s KEVELS LABASH LADYTALULA (32b3) F01/09/09. A dear little baby, type good with nice warm toned chocolate tortie points.

32 Breeders Neuter

1st – Smout’s KAMIK FIRECRACKA (32a) MN 18/07/08. A wonderfully stylish lad, I would still like him a little bigger and more masculine for my personal taste but he does have very good weight and substance now. His points colouring is excellent and his eyes are vibrant blue so I suppose you can’t have everything. Congratulations on becoming Overall BIS – again this year.

2nd – Duncan’s GD PR BRYTHAIS SIMLY RED (32a) MN 30/05/02. This handsome lad is in immaculate condition for a 7 year old. A nice big boy with the sweetest of expressions, very good points colour and excellent coat texture. Showing a slight pinch to muzzle today. Handled beautifully.

Radius Neuter

1st - Bennett’s CH & PR DAZZLING SWEETALKING GUY (32/8) MN 21/02/07

2nd - Goddard’s PR DEBBIKAT MARMALADY (32/3) FN 24/12/08.

Siamese/Balinese Adult (Loyalty Class)

1st – Reed’s GD CH AMYDAY SUNSPANGLED (32fn) M 18/07/08. This boy has a wonderful head, with wide top line and huge flyaway ears. He is not without his minor imperfections – apricot points could be little more intense as could his eye colour, and he does have a small pip to his tail. Having said all this he is still an impressive lad overall and has a temperament to die for. Beautifully presented.
