OPEN CLASSES

Lilac Point Male Neuter

PC & BOB - Bray's PR JOMESE JINGLE BELLS (24c) MN 21/02/06. A dear boy who I have not see for some time, of overall good type and style. Medium length wedge with good top of head, and large-ish ears well set. Oriental eye shape set and expression, colour could be a touch deeper. Profile a little uneven now with flat area above the brow line and slight dip to nose, chin good and firm, bite level. Excellent substance to long body with a good firm tone for a neuter, long limbs and tail. Darker lilac points, a little pinkish tone evident and they match nicely. Lightly shaded coat thus excellent contrast for his age, of good length but has the somewhat "body" feel to it which can be typical of chocolates and lilacs. Excellent temperament and excellently presented.

Tabby Point Female Adult

CC – Skivington's TINTALLY LADY GAGA (32/8) F 09/05/10. This lady still has a baby look about her but she is impressively well developed in size for 9 months. Stylish head type with very good top line and large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape set and expression with very good depth of colour. Almost straight profile, there is a marginal dip above the brow line at present, but nose straight, chin firm and bite level. Excellent substance and tone to long body, with long elegant limbs and long tail to balance. Tabby markings more dark blue than caramel at present but the tail is beginning to develop brownish over tones and with her very dark paw pads I am reasonably happy that she is caramel. Tabby pattern good with very well ringed tail. Off white coat, minimally shaded, of very good length and close texture. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

2nd – Kincade's MAFDET MOVIESTAR (32/1) F 04/10/08. A neat little queen of good type. Well balanced head with good top and good sized ears set well. Basic eye shape good but she tends to hold them wide which only serves to emphasise her rather pale eye colour. Tiny dip to nose, chin good, bite very untidy but appears level. Long body with good weight for size, long limbs and tapered tail to almost balance. Ticked based tabby markings with blurred scarab and single cheek tracings, large thumb prints, pale multi bracelets and tail just about one third ringed. Good length and close texture to coat, lightly ticked overall to tone. Rather grumpy but handled okay, excellently presented.

Judged for BOB only and awarded – Richards' GD CH DEBIKAT GRACIE-MAE (32/1) F 02/08/08. I have always been very fond of this dainty queen. Not the largest of ladies, but very well balanced overall with a stylish head and the most lovely eyes for shape and expression, the colour is extremely good too. Rather heavily shaded now she does still show some contrast, tabby pattern is good for what appears

to be a ticked-based cat, with many tail rings. Excellent to handle, posing beautifully on her throne bed as always.

Tortie Point Adult

CC & BOB – Stokes' LITTLEFEAT POWDERFINGER (32b1) F 05/03/10. I took over this class from Mr Hansson when he was unable to attend, I hope the exhibitors were not too disappointed..... A young female of lovely type and style. Excellent head for style and overall balance with wide top and very large flared ears set to follow, has an almost imperceptible bump on the back of the skull. Very good eye shape and set, held perhaps marginally wide but colour excellent, deep sapphire with a brilliance and intensity of tone. Good profile and chin with level bite. Elegant neck line, long svelte and firm toned body, long slender limbs and long whip tail to balance. Very dark seal tortie points, mingling mainly pale red, but there are odd flecks of richer tone on the ears and tail. Super coat texture, very short and sleek with the lightest of shading to tone. On the shy side but handled well. Excellently presented.

2nd – Ellam's CH LAZIZA KISMET (32b8) F 31/05/08

3rd – Baughan's CH FLUTTERBY KISS ME QUICK (32b3) F 14/04/09. An elegant lady of very good type. Medium length wedge with very good top of head, has large open based ears that are set to follow and from the front view is very even and well balance. The profile is not so good, it is uneven with quite a pronounced dip to nose that also has a small bump at the tip, chin slopes back a touch but bite level. Oriental eye shape and set with fairly good depth of colour. Excellent substance and tone to body of good length, long slender limbs and spoon paws, tapered tail almost balances. Darker chocolate tortie points well mingled in paler and mid red. Medium length coat a touch soft and fine in texture today, lightly shaded overall. Excellent to handle and beautifully presented on a throne bed.

Apricot Point Male Neuter

PC & BOB – Ellams' JAKURTZI KOBEJITSU (32fn) MN 02/10/09. A large stylish neuter with very good type. Longer wedge head but top line very good and with his large ears the head almost balances. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could be a touch deeper. Almost straight profile, good chin and level bite. Excellent substance to body without sacrificing elegance, tone also excellent, long limbs and long tail to balance. Points are warm in tone but still need to develop that hot and really intense colour, but he is young yet and the lighting was not helpful to red series cats today, however coat is quite heavily shaded already, which does tend to be typical of Apricots. Coat length and texture good. An easy boy to handle and excellently presented.

2nd – Wareham's FLUTTERBY YONGZHEN (32fn) MN 14/07/08. A dear boy of good type, a little bit dainty for a mature male neuter. Neat and even medium wedge with good top line and proportionate ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set with the sweetest expression and good colour. Profile almost straight, just a slight rise between the eyes, chin good and bite level. Well covered medium length body with slender limbs and neat paws, tail need a touch more length to balance. This boys points colour is fully developed and is very good indeed, with ear and tail really hot in tone. Coat length good but a little soft in texture, colour off-white with apricot shading overall,

still some contrast evident. A lovely boy to handle, obviously loves the attention. Excellently presented.

Oriental Bicolour Adult

CC & BOB – Stewart’s EDENPORT KAHLUA (48 48dt) M 31/03/10. This boy has very good size and development for his age. Type good with quite a strong head of medium length, top line very good and the ears are fairly large and set to balance. Eyes of good shape but they are rather deep set and the colour could be better. Strong profile with really “fat” nose, firm chin and level bite. Excellent substance and very good muscle tone to long body, long limbs and tail. Good rich red tabby markings, white areas now fully evident and I would estimate he has over the one third required. With inverted “v” to mask, right across the chest, on all four limbs and down the tummy, the coat is completely clear but I am pretty sure that this is not white. Coat length and texture good. A handsome lad who was very easy to handle. Excellently presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Seal Point Siamese Breeders Adult

1st – Howarth’s MIYASAMA MOURINHO (24) M 04/06/09. He is overall a well balanced male although he could be larger and more masculine for my personal taste. Good head type with fairly wide top line and large ears very well set. Good eye shape and set but he needs better eye colour, particularly for a seal. Points colour good but coat tends to white rather than cream, however he does have excellent contrast with very light shading. An easy boy to handle.

1st - Richards’ GD CH DEBIKAT GRACIE-MAE (32/1) F 02/08/08

Novice ex Seal Point Adult

1st – Withers’ TINTALLY TICKERTY-BOO (24n) F 15/05/10. A really big girl for 9 months, impressively grown and of excellent type. Lovely head with very good top line and large flared ears set to follow. Very good eye shape, perhaps marginally large but setting excellent and so is the colour. Wonderful points colour, absolutely no ambiguity here and in one so young too - the muddiest of tones to lilac based caramel, excellent, and my vote for BIS.

1st – Withers’ TINTALLY TIME-LORD (24n) M 09/05/10. (See SCSBE report)

2nd - Skivington’s TINTALLY LADY GAGA (32/8) F 09/05/10

3rd – Sidnell’s MYLYNN MARISSA (32fn) F 27/11/09 (See SCSBE report)

Visitors Kitten

1st – Reed’s JOHPAS SPARKS WILL FLY (32a) M 12/11/10. A gorgeous little boy, well grown and so very promising for type. Points colour very promising too, he handled beautifully.

2nd – Burrows' KAYPEZ STARRY EYED (24c) F 08/11/10. Another promising baby. Short really strong little head for a girl with bat ears set wide. Points colour a rather dark lilac but there is a hint of pink there. A sweet person excellently presented.
