### OPEN CLASSES

#### A.V. Oriental Grand Premier Male

**1<sup>st</sup> GC PC w/h – Boddy's PR EMERPUS LUCIFER (41b) 06/06/06.** A big strong lad of good type and style. Fairly well balanced head, top line could be a touch wider for perfection, ears large and well set but need a little more flare to them. Eyes slightly full in shape, colour paler green. Almost straight profile and firm chin, unfortunately bite undershot by quite a degree, he is losing his incisors so may – once they have all gone, get away with it. Long heavy but still elegant body, long strong limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Classic tabby coat pattern, all elements present and reasonably well defined, the side spine lines are beginning to break but the oysters are complete. Overall it does show some agouti invasion, but the soundness was good for a Classic. Rather a shy lad but handled okay. Excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Woolley's PR GENTANTIQUE ATHOLDORN (29) 12/09/07.** Another large lad of good type. Head quite well balanced with good top line and reasonably large ears well set. Good shape and set to eyes, perhaps a touch full, colour yellowish green. Profile shows slight dips to nose and above brow, chin good, bite untidy with several incisors missing but looked level. Good length to body, but he does need to fine down and tends to lack elegance, medium length limbs, oval paws, tail needs a touch more length to balance. Darker Havana coat not correct today, it did show some warmth of tone but it was very unsound with a clear paler area about half way up the hair shaft, there were also a few white hairs scattered about and some brindling on the lower sides. Coat length and texture very good and lying close. A very dear boy with an excellent nature. Excellently presented.

#### A.C. Siamese/Balinese Grand Premier Female

**GD PC - Spencer's GD PR SCOTMAR CLASSIE LASSIE (24a) FN 09/04/07.** A neat and dainty lady, not over flashy but stylish and well balanced overall. Medium length wedge with very good top line and large well flared ears set in line with the wedge. Super eyes for shape set and colour, they were deep but brilliant blue. Almost straight profile, firm chin, clean and level bite. Dainty but well covered and firm toned body of good length with a nice trim tummy line for a lady neuter, fine limbs and neat spoon paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Mid blue points, cool in tone and virtually matching, just the tail typically a tad darker. Good close texture to short-ish coat, showing glacial tones on bib and tummy with medium blue shading down the spine. The sweetest temperament, lovely to handle and beautifully presented.

**Havana Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> CC w/h – Tosun's CH ADSETSH RUDOLPH 25/12/06.** A big boy of good type. Medium length wedge that needs a touch more width between his fairly large ears. Oval shaped eyes that he holds a little full, colour pale green. Slight dip to nose, chin could be firmer, bite level. Long body, but for all his size and weight he lacked muscle-tone and his spine was prominent today. Coat colour warm in tone but appeared rather sun-bleached in places, it was also not completely sound, of medium length but rather soft and fine in texture and losing good deal of hair, there was also evidence of stud tail. A very sweet boy to handle and very friendly, but lacked show preparation today.

**Oriental Cream or Apricot Adult**

**CC & BOB – Linton's SIARUNG THEFUTUREISORANGE (37f) M 02/08/08.** A young male of very good type, still with some maturing to do but perfectly acceptable for his age. Longer wedge with top line a touch narrow, ears large and well flared, set perhaps a mite close but better when he relaxed. Good shape to eyes. albeit a little full, colour a good clear green. Almost straight profile, good chin and level bite. Long weighty adolescent body with a good deal of substance but as yet to attain the hard muscle-tone of the mature male, long limbs, tapered tail needs a touch more length to balance. Coat colour a good hot toned Apricot, if I had checked my book I would have realised that he was suppose to be cream not apricot and he would have been wrong coloured, so he was a lucky boy today. He is actually a very good apricot so I would strongly recommend that he is re-registered. Excellent coat length and texture, beautifully short sleek and close lying. An easy lad to handle and beautifully presented in a snug nest

**Oriental Cinnamon Adult**

**CC & BOB – Hamilton's CH ADVISH WISTFUL WILLOW F 31/10/05.** A most attractive lady of very good type. Stylish head with very good top line and large open based ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with excellent vivid green colour. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite – puffing her whisker pads out today. Long slender but firm toned body, dainty limbs and neat paws, whip tail needs an inch to balance. Good warm toned mid cinnamon coat colour, showing a touch of ghosting on the lower sides but mainly sound, medium in length with good close texture. Excellent temperament and presentation.

**Havana Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Woolley's TARTANROSE MOQUITA F 14/05/09.** A dainty baby of overall good type. Head a little unbalanced with slightly narrow top, ears of good size set to follow. Eye shape rather full, of hazel green colour. Profile chin and bite good, teething pinch to muzzle today. Dainty but really weighty body of good length, fine limbs and neat paws, whip tail needs an inch to balance. Mid Havana coat that was marginally unsound, should improve when she changes her soft fine baby coat. Very friendly and sweet natured, excellently presented.

**Foreign White Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Hull's BURNTHWAITES BEDAZZLED M 22/12/08.** Down in my book as male but appeared to be a male neuter. A very stylish chap with a medium length wedge, the ears are very large and well set but he does have a tendency to top them. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour, haws up slightly today. Tiny

dip to nose, firm chin and level bite. Excellent substance to long body, if anything he is marginally too comfortably covered but then he is approaching adolescence, tapered tail almost balances. Excellent coat qualities, pristine white, beautifully prepared, with short sleek texture. A lovely boy to handle, excellently presented.

### **Oriental Black Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Hamilton’s ADNIO SH BLACK LACE F 09/05/09.** A nicely grown little girl, promising for type. Medium wedge with very good top of head and large ears very well set. Eye shape basically good but she has a tendency to widen them, colour olive green. Baby dips to nose and above the brow as yet, good chin and level bite. Firm little body of good weight, dainty limbs and neat spoon paws, whippy tail almost balances and has a small “pip” at the tip. Dense black coat, sound to roots, with very good close texture for a baby. A very sweet person, excellently presented.

### **Seal Point Siamese Adult**

**CC & BOB – Robb’s KERAF GERALDO M 28/11/08.** A young male of stylish type with excellent size and development for 9 months. Typy head that was perhaps marginally longer than wide but which should improve as it strengthens and matures, ear size and setting very good. Oriental eyes, marginally deep set but excellent for colour. Strong, almost straight profile with very good chin and level bite. Excellent substance and tone to body with the promise of mature muscle-tone to come. Long strong limbs, long tail with a very slight thickening at the tip. Seal brown points, perhaps a touch cool toned on the ears but warmer on the mask and front limbs. Excellent coat for length and texture, perhaps marginally cool toned cream with very light shading to tone. A lovely boy to handle. Excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Fraser’s SERAPIS FREE SPIRIT M 17/07/08.** Not quite the type and style of the winner but he had wonderful seal colouring. Slightly heavy medium wedge with good top of head and large ears well set. Eye shape rather full, better when he relaxed, colour an excellent vivid blue. Tiny dip to nose, good chin and level bite. Long weighty body but rather soft in tone, long strong limbs, tapered tail needs an inch and has a small “pip” at the tip. Lovely warm seal brown points, rarely seen in seals these days, super cream coat, with warm seal shading, over the shoulders in particular, length and texture good. Easy to handle and beautifully presented.

### **Blue Point Siamese Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> CC w/h – Gibson’s RIVANESS QUALITY STREET (24a) M 01/01/08.** A young male of very good type and with a good substantial feel to him. Balanced though not the most masculine of heads, with very good top line and large ears well set. Very good shape and set to eyes with good depth of colour. Dip to nose, good chin and bite. Weighty body of very good length and muscle-tone, long elegant limbs, tail needs length and has a “pip” at the tip. Points colour dark and has a good deal of fawny/brown tones to it in places. Paw pads and nose leather tending towards purple rather than blue. Coat heavily shaded in brownish blue, length and texture good. The over all impression to this lad is that his colour lies somewhere between blue and blue-based caramel, the lighting was not helpful but he was certainly not a good blue. Excellent temperament for a full male and excellently presented.

**Tabby Point Siamese Adult****CC & BOB - Brown's FISEPO THISTLEWAY-AURORA (32t8) F 03/12/08.**

Very stylish female not yet 10 months but with very good size, substance and maturity for age. Very good head type with wide top and large open based ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour. Straight profile, good chin and level bite. Both her neck and body were of a good length when I finally managed to persuade her to uncurl, the latter with excellent substance and tone, limbs long and slender, long whip tail to balance. Good lilac-based caramel colour to points, pattern predominantly tabby with the bare minimum of tortie breaks on the ears and paws, tabby pattern very good with excellent tail tings. Excellent coat for length and texture completely un-shaded. Very shy bless her, but gentle natured and fairly easy to handle. Excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Robb's Rivaness MARDI GRAS (32/8) F 01/08/09.** Blue based caramel tabby lady of good type, rather kittenish looking and immature for her age. Medium wedge with good top of head and large ears set to balance. Basic eye shape and set good, though she does hold them a little full, colour medium blue. Dip to profile, good chin with level bite, pinch to muzzle. Firm toned body of good length, long elegant limbs, tail rather short. Dark blue tabby markings that could show a little more brownish over tone, pattern good, shows slight thumb prints, good scarab, multi bracelets and well ringed tail, paw pads and nose leather correct for colour. Lightly shaded off-white coat of very good length and texture. Another very shy but gentle lady, excellently presented.

**Red Point Siamese Kitten**

**W/C - Paterson's KHERAF RED OKTOBER (32a) M 09/04/09.** A beautifully grown lad for 5 months, type and style generally good. Longer wedge with top line marginally narrow, ears of very good size set on slightly high, he was quite agitated in the morning but looked a good deal better in the afternoon when he had settled down. Oval eye shape, a touch straight set and there is a tendency to squint which I put down to teething today, colour rather pale. Good profile and chin, bite marginally over at present. Well developed and weighty body of good length, long strong limbs and large oval paws, tapered tail needs an inch and has a small "pip" at the tip. Points colour apricot and not red as registered, he is in fact a very good example of apricot with colour well developed for his age. Long coat with baby soft and fine texture, fluffing himself up today. A friendly boy, very well presented.

**Tortie Point Siamese Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> BOB w/h - Edwards' ADNIOAM SHAMELESS MIMI (32b1) F 11/01/09.** A dainty female with stylish type but rather small for 8 months. Balance medium wedge with very good top line and large flared ears wide set. Oriental eye shape and set, colour needs a good deal more depth to it, particularly for a seal tortie. Good profile and chin with level bite. Dainty body of good length with weight appropriate to size, fine limbs, whip tail to balance. Beautifully mingled dark seal tortie points with breaks on all points of mid and rich red. Lightly shaded coat of good close texture. A very poised young miss that was easy to handle, excellently presented.

**Tabby Point Siamese Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> BOB w/h Greer's DREAMCATCHER ORENDA (32/3) F 16/02/09.** This kitten was beautifully grown for her age, overall type generally good, but head rather long

and narrow for balance, with her large ears set follow. Oval shape to eyes that were rather pale in colour and she has a tendency to squint. Excellent strong profile and good chin with level bite. Very good length and substance to body with strong limbs for a girl, tail well tapered but needs an inch to balance. Warm toned mid chocolate tabby markings, pattern appears ticked based with single ribbons and narrow banded bracelets, tail just about one third ringed. Medium length and o texture to un-shaded ivory coat. Easy to handle and excellently presented.

### MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

#### A.V. Oriental Adult Not Bred by Exhibitor

**1<sup>st</sup> – Linton’s SHADOWSQUAD STARDUST (37g) F 10/03/07.** A very beautiful lady for type and style. Typy head with very large ears, eye shape, set and colour very good. Coat colour mid blue with a good deal of pale cream mingling overall. She was perhaps a touch light weight and rather out of sorts today.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Hull’s MAZPAHS CH CHANABLACK (37) F 05/03/08.** An elegant female with quite a stylish head. Eyes are a little full but the colour is a very good vivid green. Excellent coat, dense glossy black, sound to roots. Excellent temperament.

**3<sup>rd</sup> - Tosun’s CH ADSETSH RUDOLPH (29) M 25/12/06**

#### A.V. Adolescent Adult

**1<sup>st</sup> – Tosun’s PALMIRA NERISSA (24b) F 05 09 08.** A very stylish lady, not in the best of moods today – which I must say did give her a very wicked look. Super head, very well balanced. Good eye shape and set with excellent brilliant colour. Chocolate points on the dark side but fairly warm in tone. Presented in excellent condition.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Fraser’s SERAPIS FREE SPIRIT (24) M 17/07/08**

**3<sup>rd</sup> - Linton’s SIARUNG THEFUTUREISORANGE (37f) M 02/08/08**

#### A.C. Oriental Tortie, Ticked Tabby, Red or Cream Adult

**1<sup>st</sup> - Linton’s SHADOWSQUAD STARDUST (37g) F 10/03/07**

#### A.V. Radius Kitten

**1<sup>st</sup> - Hamilton’s ADNIOASH BLACK LACE F 09/05/09**

**2<sup>nd</sup> (WC) – Boddy’s EMERPUS FANDANGO (38m) F 04/05/09.** This lady was originally in my tortie class, which was clearly wrong as she is what her breed number suggests - tortie tabby, but she is also the wrong colour. With black paw pads and nose leather she is a brown tortie tabby. Pattern not very clear with most of the spotting in red rather than the base colour, but then tortie – and she has a lot of red, can confuse things at times. Good type, handled well.

#### A.V. Visitors Kitten

**1<sup>st</sup> (WC) - Paterson’s KHERAF RED OKTOBER (32a) M 09/04/09.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Woolley’s TARTANROSE MARKOPOLO (38b) M14/05/09**

**A.C. Oriental Spotted or Classic Tabby Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Fyfe’s EIREACHDAIL SLINKY MALINKI (38a) 06/03/09.** A typy boy, but he had a problem with his coat length and texture today which made it very difficult to see his pattern, it was long soft and very open, with an almost plushy texture. It was possible to see the spots after some judicious smoothing, there is a little linkage on the lower sides but the pattern is fairly sound. Super green eyes. handled well.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Woolley’s TARTANROSE MARKOPOLO (38b) M 14/05/09**

**Havana, Oriental Lilac or Cinnamon Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Fyfe’s BETABIL MYFAIRLADY (29c) FN 05/08/08.** A neat lady neuter of good type and style. Medium length head fairly well balanced when she relaxes, eyes marginally wide but good clear green in colour. Coat colour looked very good indeed today, soft grey with a clear pinkish overtone, mostly sound and of good close texture. Gentle , if slightly shy, and handled well.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Woolley’s PR GENTANTIQUÉ ATHOLDORN (29) 12/09/07**

**Oriental Spotted or Classic Tabby Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Boddy’s PR EMERPUS LUCIFER (41b) MN 06/06/06**

**Seal Point or Blue Point Siamese Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Spencer’s GD PR SCOTMAR CLASSIE LASSIE (24a) FN 09/04/07.**

**Red or Cream Point Siamese Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Rankin’s KHERAF REDSENTINEL (32a) MN 25/09/08.** A large and elegant boy with a very long wedge that needs a touch more width between his very large ears, and which he does tend to bonnet. Eyes very exaggerated in shape, set not strictly oriental and the colour needs to be a good deal deeper. Unfortunately his bite is undershot. Super points colour, rich vibrant red. Excellent short close lying coat, heavily shaded with clear spotting. Not the happiest of persons today.
