### BREED CLASSES

#### A.C. Oriental Premier Neuter Male

**GD PC – Cockwell's PR BARBECCO CHIEF CHIRPA (37d) MN25/10/09.** A very stylish male neuter. Strong and well balanced medium length wedge with excellent wide top line and large flared ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with haughty expression and olive green colour. Very good strong profile, chin lines up with the nose tip, bite missing several incisors but looks level. Long elegant but weighty body, long limbs, whip tail just about balances. Rich bright red coat, shows a fair amount of indistinct spotted pattern, red to roots, length and texture excellent, short close and very sleek. Easy to handle, a handsome boy excellently presented

**R – Rice's PR LORICHA LUCKY JIM (62 18) MN 29/10/09.** Another handsome neuter. Strong head with broad top line, ears fairly large, well furnished and very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with good expression and paler emerald green colour. Strong straight profile with firm chin and level bite. Long weighty body with excellent substance, long strong limbs and large paws with long foot fluffs. Tail needs an inch to balance. Black spotting to coat fairly clear and reasonably sound for a silver cat, there is a little linkage of the pattern on the left side, but the spine line was unusually well broken for this breed. Coat length good and the texture was very fine and silky, with plume well furnished. Rather shy but very gentle and handled well. Excellently presented.

#### British Blue Kitten

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Conneally's TANYRALT ATOMIC (16) M 12/10/12.** Not the largest of lads for nearly 8 months but type and substance good. Round head, skull needs to broaden, ears are medium in size and well set, cheeks beginning to show. Round eyes with rather worried expression, colour paler orange. Rounded forehead with shortish nose, firm chin and level bite, has a tendency to puff out his whisker pads. Cobby and weighty body, fairly strong boned limbs of medium length with medium length tail to balance. Mid blue coat with extensive silvery tipping at present, marginally unsound, but very good for length and density, texture a touch soft at the moment. An easy boy to handle and excellently presented.

#### Black, Chocolate or Cinnamon Tortie Kitten

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Wait's SQUISHY MRS PEPPERPOT (21) F 12/02/11.** Super baby, promising for type. Well rounded little head with very good width to skull for such a young baby, and the ears are small and set really well. Round eyes with good expression, colour still developing but a good copper colour showing through baby muddy tones. Well rounded forehead and neat small nose, deep firm chin, bite level. Medium length body, medium length strong boned limbs, tail a little long. Dense glossy black tortie coat which was very sound, tortie mingling to the minimum at the moment but it is well distributed overall and it is a lovely deep rich red, one near front foot is almost solid but tortie breaks seen under paw and higher up the limb. Coat very

short and dense, baby soft at present. Miss personality plus, a very confident and friendly kitten, excellently presented. My choice for BOV British kitten

#### **Oriental Tortoiseshell Adult**

**CC & BOB – Cockwell’s CARBEILE LADY MORGANA (37h) F 08/08/10.** A lovely young female, very good type & style. Typy head with very good top line and large well flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set, colour bordering on amber but a little green just seen. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Dainty and slender body of good length, long fine limbs and neat spoon paws, tapered tail rather short for balance. Very attractive coat colouring, rich chocolate with much bright red mingling giving a lovely overall warm appearance, completely sound to roots, length and texture excellent. A friendly lady, excellently presented.

#### **Oriental Black Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Sidnell’s BERNBECKS KINKYBOOTS (37) F 20/09/10.** Very good type and style to this female but she has a fair bit of growing on to do yet and is rather small for almost adult. Well balanced head with very good top line and good sized ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with clear mid green colour. Long body that was very slender but had good weight for size, long fine limbs and long whippy tail to balance. Glossy black coat that was completely sound to roots, medium in length with good close texture. Lovely temperament and excellently presented.

#### **Seal Point Siamese Adult Male**

**CC – Hall & Hall’s FURRYFACE MARIO (24) M 27/08/10.** A very young boy of just 9 months and looking it I must say. Lovely head type with super top line and huge ears set wide. Eyes of good shape. perhaps a touch wide, colour mid blue that could be brighter in tone. Marginal dip to strong profile, chin goes back a little but has reasonable depth, bite level. Well defined neckline, long elegant body with super tone and weight to it, long slender limbs, whippy tail almost balances. Warm toned seal brown points nicely matching, creamy coat with the lightest of shading to tone and excellent sleek texture. Needs to mature but acceptable for the certificate today. Perfect temperament, and excellently presented.

#### **Seal Point Siamese Adult Female**

**CC – Waltz & Beecroft’s PEBBLEBEACH RUBY (24) F 31/08/10.** A dainty but well balanced young female who has improved since our last meeting. Medium length wedge with good top of head and large flared ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set with good expression, colour could be deeper but in this hall lighting appeared just about acceptable. Strong profile and firm chin, bite scissored over. Long dainty but fairly weighty body, long fine limbs and neat spoon paws, tail needs a little more length and has a “pip” at the tip. Dense seal brown points, now showing a little warmth of tone, cool toned coat with some light shading over the hips, length and texture good. Handled well today and was excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Singleton’s WICCA YING (24) F 30/05/10.** The sweetest person, but rather old fashioned for type bless her. Head wedge shaped - albeit little rounded in the muzzle, but needs more width between her ears, they were of a good size but set close and upright. Almost straight profile, chin lines up with the nose tip but is quite shallow, bite clean and level. Excellent substance and tone to long body, long limbs and tail. Excellent points colour, true warm toned seal brown, warm toned cream coat

with the minimum of shading, coat length and texture excellent, lying beautifully close. Lovely temperament, a very friendly lady, excellently presented.

**BOB - Hall & Hall's CH FURRYFACE BURLINGTONBERTIE (24) M 26/12/08.** This boy was very shy and retiring today, which is not like him at all. Of overall very good type and nicely mature, with strong medium length wedge that was well balanced. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Strong profile with firm chin that lines up with the nose tip, bite level. Long well muscled body with long elegant limbs and well tapered tail that almost balances. Dark dense seal points with a good warm tone to them, medium shaded coat could be better in texture today, it was rather harsh down the spine, he was also showing evidence of stud tail. Won the BOB on maturity.

#### **Blue Point Siamese Adult Male**

**1<sup>st</sup> CC w/h – Button's BETHANE BARNABY (24a) M 07/08/09.** Not the most masculine of boys but overall he has good type and style, and I would have been fairly happy to give him the certificate but for the doubts over his colour. Medium wedge with good top of head, ears large fairly wide at the base and set to balance. Good shape set and expression to eyes of medium blue colour. Almost straight profile, good chin and level bite. Tends to hunch his neck, body good length when stretched out and it has good weight and muscle tone, long limbs and tail to balance. Points colour very dark for a blue with tail darker still, there is a very definite brownish overtone evident in places, and his paw pads and nose leather are purple in colour rather than blue. His coat is off-white and shows no evidence of any glacial tone. It is my opinion that he should be registered as caramel. Sweet tempered and handed well, excellently presented.

#### **Caramel Point Siamese Kitten Female**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Cruse's DESTRIER KIARA (24n) F 23/11/10.** A neat baby of good type and style, rather small for 6 months but has good substance. Stylish little head with very good top and large flared ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could be deeper and the haws were up a touch today. Small dip to profile centre nose, firm chin and level bite, slight pinch to muzzle. Well defined neck, long slender but fairly weighty body, long dainty limbs and neat paws, whip tail to balance. Points colour more fawn toned lilac than caramel at present but she is very young and there does appear to be some brownish tone to the tail. Medium length coat of good length and texture, more magnolia than off-white at present, virtually un-shaded. Excellent temperament and presentation.

#### **Fawn Point Siamese Kitten Female**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Cruse's DESTRIER BAMBI (24r) F 23/11/10.** Sister of the above and fairly similar in size and development. Medium wedge with good-ish top of head, ears of good size but they are set marginally close for balance at present and could be a little more flared. Oriental eye shape and set with sweet expression, colour needs depth. Almost straight profile and firm chin with level bite. Long, dainty but well covered body with long fine limbs, tail needs an inch to balance. Soft rosy fawn points, well matched. Un-shaded coat texture still baby fine. No entirely happy about the eye colour but the hall lighting was not particularly helpful today. Excellent temperament and presentation.

**Lilac Point Siamese Neuter Male**

**PC & BOB – Gray’s CH LYNNOX MONTE CRISTO (24c) MN 24/10/09.** An elegant neuter boy of very good type. Longer wedge with very good top of head and lovely large flared ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with mid blue colour. Profile rather uneven with dip centre nose and a small bump near the tip, chin good, bite level but rather sore looking. Long elegant and well toned body with long limbs and tail to balance. Points appeared a little blue toned but within acceptable limits, coat magnolia with some light shading over the lower back and flanks, length and texture very good. An easy boy to handle and excellently presented.

**Apricot Point Siamese Neuter Male**

**BOB – Crowley & Lambert’s GD PR JOHPAS RAFAEL (32fn) MN 09/05/08.** A very stylish and elegant boy. Longer wedge with very good top of head and large flared ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with mid blue colour, haws up a touch today. Strong profile with firm chin, bite untidy and missing several incisors but looked level. Long elegant but weighty body with very good tone for a neuter, long limbs, well tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Excellent points colour, hot toned apricot with bluish sheen on the ghost scarab on the head. Coat medium in length, of generally good texture and with medium shading down the spine to tone. An easy boy to handle and excellently presented.

**Also considered for BOB - Aggett’s PR AMYDAY SOLAR LIGHT (32fn) MN 21/08/06.** A lovely boy, he posed beautifully on his bed, it was very close for the BOB, just the lightly better colour of the other boy deciding it today. Medium wedge head with good top and large ears very well set. Lovely eyes for shape set and expression with very good depth of colour. Profile almost straight with slight bump on the nose just below the eyes, chin good, bite lacks most of his front teeth now. Comfortably covered body of good length, slender limbs and neat paws, tail almost balances. Warm mid apricot points, hotter on the tail, but which did not have quite the intensity of tone of the other lad. Medium length off-white coat that was a little fine in texture today, lightly shaded overall. Lovely temperament, he is so self assured. Excellently presented.
