Many thanks to Helen and her team for the judging invitation, it was a beautifully run show as always and a pleasure to be here.

### **OPEN CLASSES**

#### **British Cream Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Potter's KABENBE IAM HENRY (31f) M 15/11/10.** An attractive boy of very good type, well developed for age. Well rounded head with good width to skull, ears a little large at present but set to follow the contours of the head, cheeks developing nicely. Open expression to eyes with super deep intense gold colour. Well rounded forehead with very short broad nose, deep chin lines up with the nose tip, bite level. Medium length body with very good substance and the promise of cobbiness to come, short strong limbs and rounded paws, medium length tail to balance. Attractive Bicolour pattern with just over the one third white, with even inverted "v" to face, across the chest, and some on all four limbs, under tummy almost completely white across the width with just a couple of small islands of cream, and there were one or two narrow strips of white over the back. Cream areas medium in tone with a little pattern evident at present but sound. Super coat for a baby, short and dense with a lovely scrunchy feel to it. A friendly boy immaculately presented. Later Best British Kitten, many congratulations.

#### **A.C. Siamese or Balinese Premier Male**

**GD PC – Jakeman's PR SHERMESE THEONLIIOUS (32/2) MN 16/05/08.** A very stylish boy, albeit a touch effeminate looking, having said that he was a good size and weight. Lovely head for style and balance with excellent top line and very large ears set to follow. Love his eyes for shape set expression, colour deep brilliant blue and I think it is this that won me over. Almost straight profile, good chin and level bite. Elegant yet weighty body with a good trim tummy line for a neuter, long limbs and long tail to balance. Darker blue tabby markings, typically lacks thumb prints, good clear scarab and excellent tail rings. Very good length and texture to coat with excellent contrast for this colour. Rather a shy bunny but not unfriendly, excellently presented.

**R – Ellam's PR JAKURTZZI KOBE JITZU (32fn) MN 02/10/09.** A handsome and stylish neuter boy. Longer wedge with very good top of head and large nicely flared ears set wide. Oriental shape to eyes, perhaps marginally deep set, colour mid blue. Good profile and chin, bite rather untidy with several incisors missing but appeared to be level. Long elegant neck and long well toned body, tail just about balances. Warm toned apricot points, well matched, off-white coat of very good length and texture, shaded overall to tone. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

#### **A.C. Siamese or Balinese Premier Female**

**GD PC – Crowley's PR JOHPAS KITTY GALORE (32fn) FN 27/06/10.** A young female neuter of stylish type, but rather on the dainty side. Balanced and even medium length wedge with very good top and super large ears set to follow. Oriental

eye shape and set with mid blue colour, haws up a touch today. Dainty but fairly weighty body of good length with long fine limbs and neat spoon paws, whip tail almost balances. Excellent points colouring, considering she is only 11 months the colour is beautifully developed, a deep muted terracotta, and it is this that earned her the BOB over the boys in the Open class today. Good coat length and texture with light apricot shading overall. Rather shy but handled well, excellently presented.

#### **Oriental Cream or Apricot Adult Male**

**CC & BOB – Maish’s BARDSONG CHIKUAIORLANDO (37fn) M 15/08/10.** A great big chap for 9 months, very adolescent looking at the moment. Overall type good with a medium length wedge head, top line good, ears fairly large and set well. Oval shaped eyes set well with a rather innocent expression at the moment, colour hazel green. Strong straight profile with firm chin and level bite. Long weighty “puppy” body. Strong boned limbs and large oval paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Excellent coat colour, a rich hot apricot tone, there is some tabby pattern evident but not too bad considering his age and it is sound, length texture and overall condition excellent. A happy boy presented to perfection. Congratulations on the Best Adult win.

#### **Oriental Red Male Neuter**

**PC & BOB – Lord’s FIRODILISO PANM REDPANTHER (37d) MN 30/06/10.** A handsome lad of good type and style. Longish wedge head, top line could be marginally wider but looked fine when he relaxed, ears large and well set. Oriental eye shape and set with olive green colour. Almost straight profile with good chin and bite. Long body with good weight and tone, long limbs and tail. Lovely rich red coat, there is a fair amount of spotting evident at present, but hopefully this will fade as he matures. Coat texture excellent, short sleek and close lying. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

#### **Oriental Bicolour Neuter Male**

**PC – Freemont’s LUNATORA CATCHMEIFYOUCAN (48 43s) MN 15/06/10.** A good sized lad of good type, although he has a slightly baby look about him as yet. Quite a stylish head with good top line, ears large, flared and well set, but with a tendency to top them at times. Oval shaped eyes of mid green. Excellent substance to long elegant body, long limbs and tail to almost balance. Coat pattern more ticked than ticked based shaded as there are two bands of colour evident, with clear silver undercoat half way up the hair shaft. White areas to just over the half with large inverted “v” to face, across the chest, completely under tummy and plenty on all four limbs, showing a little tarnishing to muzzle today. Coat length and texture excellent. Super temperament and excellently presented.

#### **Oriental Bicolour Neuter Female**

**PC & BOB – Whiston’s PR MYOKO CHIQUITITA (48 45bs) FN 21/11/08.** A neat lady neuter of good type, style and overall balance. Even head of medium length with good top line and large ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with gentle expression and mid green colour. Almost straight profile and good chin, bite marginally scissored over. Firm toned and quite weighty body of good length, slender limbs and whip tail that almost balances. Attractive balance between white and pattern with white over the one third white required. Dark chocolate shaded pattern quite heavy for her age particularly for a silver cat, white areas on all extremities and

underneath to groin area. Coat medium in length and a touch overfine today. Lovely to handle and presented to perfection.

#### **Seal Point Siamese Adult Female**

**CC & BOB – Richards’ MAFDET BOBBIESOCKS (24) F 27/03/06.** A dainty mature lady of very good type. Stylish head with very good top-line and large open based ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour, has a hint of a “look” now and again. Good profile, pugilistic chin, bite lacks most of the lower incisors. Dainty but well covered and fairly weighty body of good length, fine limbs and neat paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Dark dense seal points with some warmth of tone evident, creamy coat with medium shading overall to tone and good length and texture. Sweet tempered and easy to handle, excellently presented

#### **Cream Point Siamese Adult Female**

**CC & BOB – Ellam’s CH JAKURZZI VON ESPER (32c) F 02/10/09.** A dainty lady of stylish type. Typy head with very good top and large well flared ears set to follow. Expressive eyes of oriental shape and set with good depth of colour. Small dip to profile centre nose, chin and bite good. Surprisingly weighty body of good length and elegance, long fine limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Pale but slightly warm cream points, tail marginally hotter in tone. Good length and texture to creamy white coat, with minimal shading to tone. An easy lady to handle, excellently presented.

#### **Blue Point Siamese Kitten Female**

**2<sup>nd</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup> & BOB w/h – James’ SCOTMAR RABOBERG QISSBOMBE (24a) F 28/10/10.** Of overall good type, but rather small for her age. Medium wedge, top of head good with ears of fairly good size and set. Good shape set and colour to eyes but she was widening them in temper and had a tendency to squint today. Good profile and chin but bite now clearly overshot – having been just over when we last met in March it has become worse. Well covered body of good length tail rather short and has a small defect at the tip. Very good pale blue points, paw pads and nose leather blue. Coat shows very good glacial tones with minimal shading, length and texture very good, short and lying close to body. Rather bad tempered for such a small person. Beautifully presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Hargan’s ADEL FAM HOPE (24a) F 25/11/10.** Another very cross individual, type and style good, but on the small side for 6 months. Longer wedge head with marginally narrow top of head, ears of very good size but set a mite close for balance. Eyes very oriental in shape and set, haws showing and almost half way across the eye today, colour mid blue. Almost straight profile with deep pugilistic chin, and as suspected, bite severely undershot. Well covered body of good length, but unfortunately she has a movable xyphisternum that refused to remain in situ, dainty limbs and paws, whippy tail to balance. Not entirely sure she is blue, she currently is exhibiting all the signs that she is blue-based caramel, points very dark blue with quite a muddy overtone to them, paw pads rather purple toned and her coat is too warm, lacking the glacial tones you expect to see in a blue, and it is shaded overall in muddy tones, time will tell. Excellently presented.

#### **Tabby Point Siamese Kitten Male**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Harrington’s HELLFIRE CASTINGSPELL (32 6) M 12/02/11.** A Very promising little boy for type. Super stylish head with excellent top line and very large well flared ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set with inscrutable expression and lovely deep blue colour. Straight profile, good firm chin and level bite. Firm toned little body of promising length, xyphisternum a touch prominent but remained in situ, hopefully this will disappear as he muscles up, super long whippy tail. Tabby markings are rather warm for a cream, particularly on the ears, the tail is still pale so happy to accept him as cream today but I think his development will have to be watched. Unshaded body with very good coat length and texture. Very sweet temper, beautifully presented.

#### **Tabby Point Siamese Kitten Female**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Bowles-Gowdey’s MYLYNN MISS MIMOSA (32t1) F 01/02/11,** A beautifully grown baby with lovely type. Strong head for a female kitten with excellent broad top line and huge wide based ears set really wide. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could ideally be deeper for a seal tabby, but was acceptable. Strong profile and deep chin with level bite. Excellent tone and substance to body, manubrium slightly prominent at present, long limbs and long whip tail to balance. Very attractive points pattern, very dark seal tabby markings with tiger-moth mottling to ears in various shades of red, and a little mid red on the tail. Lightly shaded close lying coat of very good texture. Posing beautifully in her “princess and the pea” bed, super to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Harrington’s HELLFIRE CASTINGSPELLS (32 10) F 12/02/11.** Sister to the male in the previous class, registered as Apricot tabby, but that were little or no difference between them for colour. Smaller than her brother but also promising for type. Medium length wedge with very good top of head and large nicely flared ears very well set. Oriental eyes of very good shape set and depth of colour. Profile a little uneven at present with baby growth dips to brow and nose, chin could be a mite stronger but bite level, teething pinch to muzzle. Long, dainty but well covered body, long fine limbs and neat spoon paws, tail very whippy but needs another inch or so. Tabby markings somewhere between cream & apricot at present. Coat un-shaded, a little soft and baby fine today. Lovely temperament and excellently presented.

#### **Tortie Point Siamese Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Harrington’s HELLFIRE KINKYMAVINKI (32b1) F 12/02/11.** A neat little babe of good type. Well balanced medium length wedge with very good top and large open based ears set well. Oriental eye shape, setting a touch straight at present, colour mid blue, one eye looked a little sore. Straight profile, firm chin and level bite. Dainty but well toned body of promising length, fine limbs, whippy tail just about balances. Dark seal tortie points, well mingled on all points in mainly mid red with attractive paler red blaze down the nose. Lightly shaded coat of soft fine baby texture. The sweetest person, very friendly and easy to handle. Excellently presented.

#### **Lilac Point Siamese Neuter Male**

**PC & BOB – English’s MAPU JUDE (24c) MN 22/05/10.** A handsome youngster of very good type and style. Even and well balanced head with very good top line and large flared ears excellently set. Super eyes for shape, set, expression and colour, the latter a really brilliant sapphire blue. Good profile and chin with level bite. Very

good substance and tone to long elegant body with long slender limbs, tapered tail need a touch more length to balance. Darker lilac points and I would like to see a little more pinkish tone to them, coat magnolia in colour, lightly shaded, length good, texture a little fine but manages to lie close to body, Excellent temperament and presentation.

#### **Red Point Siamese Neuter Male**

**PC & BOB – Blanks' JOHPAS RED EDDIE (32a) MN 06/08/09.** A good sized lad of very good type. Strong and stylish head with excellent top line and very large ears set wide. Basically good shape to eyes but he does tend to widen them, colour could be deeper. Small dip to nose, good chin, level bite. Excellent substance to long body, long strong limbs, tail rather short for balance. Bright mid red points with lightly shaded warm white coat, length good but texture rather soft and fine. Very cross but handled reasonably well. Excellently presented.

#### **Apricot Point Siamese Neuter Male**

**PC - Ellam's PR JAKURTZZI KOBE JITZU (32fn) MN 02/10/09**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Aggett's PR AMYDAY SOLAR LIGHT (32fn) MN 21/08/07**

### **MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**

#### **A.V. Oriental Junior Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Sharp-Popple's DENSON CHRISTINE CAGNEY (27) F 05/04/10.** A very cross girl of fair type and her temper did nothing to compliment her expression with eyes quite full and of pale green colour. Coat colour fairly warm in tone but very unsound today and the texture needs to be much sleeker for an Oriental cat.

#### **A.V. Oriental Not Won a CC or IC Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Johnson's PIPPASTRO LORENZETTI (62 21b) F 07/07/10.** A big strong girl of good type and style. Eyes a touch wide in shape and you really have to hunt for any green in them. Darker chocolate tortie coat with lots of good red and it was sound to roots. Coat need more length also the plume but the texture was lovely. Excellently presented.

#### **A.V. Oriental Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Smith's LORICHA OOHLAALAA (62 43s) F 06/11/10.** A lovely baby very promising in every way, type, coat and pattern. Super little head with large beautifully furnished ears excellently set. Her coat does show some light spotted pattern but is beginning to diffuse out nicely with the silver undercoat right up the hair shaft. Coat texture excellent and length promising.. A super kitten.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Mitchell's BARBECCO PENELOPE PITSTOP (29) F 30/10/10.** A stylish kitten for type, she has very expressive eyes of a good clear green and her basic coat colour is a good warm toned Havana. However, it does have extensive ticking

interspersed throughout, which is not correct, hopefully this will sort itself out by the time she is adult. A friendly girl.

#### **A.V. Oriental Limit Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Blanks' SHERMESE BLACK DIAMOND (37) MN 18/09/10.** Now this I love, there is nothing like a stylish Oriental Black to catch the eye. He is hard to fault with his stylish head type and jet black coat that was really sound to roots today. Such a wicked expression to his eyes of vivid green. His condition, presentation and temperament were excellent.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – MAZPAHA KITTYKISS BABY (48k) F 17/11/10.** A promising kitten for type and she has well over the one third white required in all the right places. Cinnamon colouring very dark, presumably due to the effect of the white, but sound. She does have extensive bleeding of white into the coloured areas which could have been tidied up a little. Excellent temperament.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Castelli's SENSAY SPOTSNSTRIPES (48 38) MN 07/10/10.** This lad has lovely type and his eye colour and expression is excellent. He has plenty of white, on face, under tummy and on all four limbs, but his spotted pattern is very indistinct and heavily invaded by agouti, I also appears to fairly superficial and lies on the top one third of the hair shaft, the remainder being a warm even toffee colour to roots, and it would not surprise me if he was in fact shaded rather than spotted. A sweet boy to handle.

#### **A.V. Oriental Neuter not bred by Exhibitor**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Ellis' IMP GD PR LYLYNN MOONSHADOW (62 20) MN09/12/06.** A very handsome neuter boy with a really well balanced head and super green eyes of excellent shape and expression. Spots quite superficial, typically for an OLH and the spine is a little solid. Coat could be longer but the texture is gorgeous. A pleasure to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Lord's IMP GD PR DRUIDSWAY BLACKPANTHER (37) MN 07/05/08.** Another handsome chap, head stylish with good expression, eye colour a paler green. Jet black coat of very good length and texture, marginally unsound today. Excellent to handle.

#### **A.V. Oriental Radius (within 25 miles) Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Smith's MOUSTACHES CARMELLE TWIST (37n) MN 13/09/03.** An old friend, a strong, handsome and quite substantial person. He still has his wonderful brownish caramel coat, completely free from ghosting and really sound roots, excellent texture too. A little shy but handled well.

#### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Adolescent Adult**

**1st – Johnston's ANDALYN ANGELICA (24n) F 04/08/10.** A very stylish young miss, dainty and rather kitten-like as yet. Lovely eyes for shape, set, expression and colour. Points colour a little pale at present but she has plenty of time for it to develop and her tail does show some brownish tone. Has pretty leaf veins pattern to her ears. Excellent to handle.

#### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Senior Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Richards' MAFDET BOBBIESOCKS (24) F 27/03/06**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Martin's ABICASA ITHADTOBEYOU (24c) F 14/02/08.** I like the type and style of this female but her points colour – in the available lighting, looked somewhat ambiguous. She is rather dark for a lilac and there looked to be a very definite brownish overtone to the tail. A friendly girl.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Mackenzie-Sproat's CH MERESCLIFF ROLAND (24k) M 04/02/06.** This chap has very good type with a strong well balanced and masculine head. His points colour is warm & spicy, although today it was a little uneven and slightly brindled in places. I do understand it can be difficult with some entire males, particularly the older boys, but this chap was not in show condition today, he lacked weight and musculature so that his spine and manubrium were rather prominent as a result, and his coat needed better preparation. Pity - on type he would have been my winner. Very sweet tempered and easy to handle for an entire of this age.

#### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Maiden Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Kincade's LAZIZA DAISY-POPPETTS (32b1) F 15/06/10.** An extremely stylish young female. Super head with wide top line and huge flared ears set wide. She is a touch full in the eye but the colour is very good. Tortie points more black than seal and the red mingling is generally pale. Lightly shaded coat of very good length and texture. Excellent to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Saxon's KOOSJE VAN TUTTE'S FIREWORKS (24a) M 01/01/09.** For type, overall strength and masculinity this boy is excellent. However, his points colour is dark and slightly muddy toned and his coat lacks glacial tones of any sort, with muddy, heavy shading overall. Very easy to handle and excellently presented in a double pen.

#### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Visitors (more than 25 miles) Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Bowles-Gowdy's MAFDET MINDTHEPAINT (32b2) F 03/06/10.** A very typy female with a lovely head. She has soft pretty blue tortie points and excellent deep and brilliant eye colour. Rather petite but lovely. Excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Richards' MAFDET BOBBIESOCKS (24) F 27/03/06**

#### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Kitten not bred by Exhibitor**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Bowes-Gowdy's LAZIZA MAFDET-MURANO (24) 17/10/10.** Ultra gorgeous and with a temperament to die for – what more can one ask?

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Hargan's ADELFA, CHARITY (24) F 25/11/10** A neat little babe with good points colour and a sweet temperament.

Good eye shape set and expression with mid blue colour. Chocolate points rather dark but do show some warmth, some brindling evident on mask and tail. Good coat for length and texture. A little bit naughty – likes nibbling fingers! In excellent condition.

**A.C. Siamese/Balinese Visitors (more than 25 miles) Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> - English's MAPU JUDE (24c) MN 22/05/10**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Barber's ARTENSA ROCKMYBOAT (24n) MN 20/05/10.** This lad has bags of style, he has a super head with a really wide top and large flared ears beautifully set. If he were a female there is no award I would not have given him today, but as a chap I do look for some size and strength as well. . He is still very young so I am hopeful he is just slow to mature. He also has excellent points colouring, with super sludgy tones to blue based caramel, Excellent to handle.

**3<sup>rd</sup> - English's PR PLEZETOBE AKILA OUBASTET (24b) MN 06/12/08**
