Foreign White, Oriental Black or Blue Imperial or Grand Champion Female

UK GD & BOB – IMP GD CH CHAPELROSE CINDERELLA (37) F 25/06/09.

A gorgeous lady, I love her type and style. Supremely stylish head with excellent top and super large ears beautifully set to balance. Lovely eyes for shape set and expression with clear green colour. Straight profile, good chin, bite marginally scissored under. Long, elegant but substantial body – she is much weightier than she appears, long whip to balance. Dense black coat, sound to roots, a touch fine in texture but lying close. Wonderful to handle, one of my favourite ladies. Later BOV Oriental Adult, many congratulations.

Oriental Black Pre-Campion Male

CC – Harvey's ENIGMATIC MR VAIN (37) M 27/11/10. Such a handsome lad and beautifully developed for his age. Excellent strong head with super top line and very large ears set to balance. Wicked expression to eyes of very good green. Strong profile and firm chin, level bite. Long strong and well muscled body, tail almost balances. Super glossy jet black coat, very sound and of perfect texture. Apart from the odd rude word, he handled really well.

Oriental Black Pre-Campion Female

CC – Sharpe-Popple's DENSON ROSA PARKS (37) F 07/10/11. An attractive girl, not extreme but very correct overall. Neat medium length wedge, top of had good with proportionate ears well set. Tiny dip to nose, chin firm and bite level. Oval shape to eyes, colour mid green. Well covered body of good length with tail to balance. Super coat qualities, short sleek and boot polish black, and which won her the certificate today. Excellent to handle.

Oriental Blue Pre-Champion Male

CC & BOB – Bauerfiend's TOGHAR RYTHM-N-BLUES (37a) M 17/11/10. A large handsome lad of very good type. Longish wedge, but top line very good and with ears large enough to balance. Strong profile and good chin with level bite. Good eye shape and set with very good clear green colour. Long muscular body, whip tail needs an inch to balance. Superb coat in mid blue that was excellent for length and texture, soundness and clarity. A little shy but handled well.

2nd – Bayliss’s SOLARUS SPIRIT IN THE SKY (37a) M 02/08/10. Good type and style to this lad, not the largest of chaps but he is weighty and substantial. Even head of medium length, well balanced with good top of head and large flared ears well set. Oriental eye shape set and expression with good clear green colour. Straight profile with firm chin and level bite. Body of medium length and slightly “chunky”, tail needs an inch to balance. Soft mid blue coat, clear of ghosting and sound to roots, texture could be sleeker and has a little “body” to it, there is also a touch of scurf to the lower back. A dear lad who was rather worried by the crowds, but not unfriendly.

Havana Kitten Male

1st & BOB – Ellis’ MAZPAHS MOSAIC (29) M 24/05/11. A beautifully stylish and well grown boy. Lovely head with excellent top line, ears large, flared and set to balance. Strong straight profile, deep chin lines up with the nose tip, bite level. Oriental eyes well set, of slightly muddy green colour. Long strong body with very good substance, super long whippy tail. Rich warm toned Havana coat, some light ghosting to sides and marginally unsound at present but he is very young, texture really super for a baby, short glossy and sleek. A very promising little by who was excellent to handle. Later BOV Oriental Kitten, many congratulations.

2nd – Spendlove’s EASTPOINT GEORGIEPODGY (29) M 23/03/11. A well grown boy, good for type and style. Fairly well balanced head with good sized ears well set. Straight profile and firm chin with level bite. Oval shaped eyes of bright green colour. Excellent substance and tone to long body, tail length good but with a slightly blunt tip to it. Coat a darker Havana colour but almost sound to roots, albeit a touch ghosted on the sides, but texture super, very sleek and glossy. A handsome lad who handled well.

3rd – Sharpe-Popple’s DENSON GEORGE-BIZET (29) M 03/03/11. A big strong lad of good type. Medium length head, top line okay, ears of good size and set. Almost straight profile and firm chin, bite scissored under, slight pinch to muzzle. Oriental eyes of good green. Very good substance and tone to long body, long tail with a small defect at the tip. Darker Havana colour to coat, fairly warm in tone and mainly sound, length and texture excellent. Overall a nice boy with a good temperament.

4th – Miller’s SAMBOUZOUKI OTHELLO (29) M 19/07/11. A dear little boy, very much the baby of the class, overall type good. Medium length wedge, top of head marginally narrow, ears of good size and set. Good eye shape and set with mid green colour. Slight dip to nose, chin goes back a touch but bite level. Nicely covered body of good length with neat limbs and paws, tail to balance but unfortunately visible kink to the tip. Very good coat colour, marginal ghosting to the sides but almost sound, length and texture very good for a baby. The sweetest person to handle, a pity about the tail.

Havana Kitten Female

1st – Davies’ SHERMESE SWEETGEORGIABROWN (29) F 16/04/11. A very nice kitten with very good type, perhaps a touch twee for 7 months but she was solid and weighty. Well balanced head, top line good, ears large and well set. Good shape set and expression to eyes of olive green. Good profile, super deep chin and level bite. Long body, weighty and firm toned, whippy tail to almost balance. Coat a marginally

dark Havana, but warm toned and virtually sound to roots, slightly long but very sleek in texture. An attractive female with an excellent temperament.

2nd – Miller's SAMBOUZOUKI JASMINE (29) F 19/07/11. An attractive kitten, type and style good. Medium wedge, top line good, ears of good size and set. Almost straight profile, good chin and level bite. Good eye shape set and colour. Baby body of promising length, weighty and firm toned, whip tail to balance. Very good coat colour, a warm toned chestnut that was fairly free from ghosting and reasonably sound, length and texture very good. Easy to handle, very loud and vocal – a very big voice for such a little person!

3rd – Sharpe-Popple's DENSON GRACE KELLY (29) F 04/04/11. This baby was very upset, which was a pity, her type was good and she was well grown. Medium wedge, quite well balanced with good top and large ears well set. Good eye shape and set with mid green colour. Well developed body and good tail. Coat a trifle dark but sound to roots, length and texture very good. It was a pity she was so upset, I do hope her next showing experience is better for her, she was just frightened by the surroundings today.

4th – Miller's SAMBOUZOUKI APHRODITE (29) F 19/07/11. A young baby of good type. Medium length wedge, top line fairly good, ears of good size but with a tendency to hold rather upright. Tiny dip to nose, very good chin and level bite, baby pinch to muzzle. Basic shape to eyes good but held very wide with apprehension, colour paler green. Dear little body, firm toned and of good weight for size, whippy tail almost balances. Lovely rich warm Havana coat almost sound to roots, length and texture good for a young kitten. Rather overawed by the occasion but handled well.

Oriental Bicolour Kitten Male

1st – Clothier's ADELFSH ARTFUR DODGER (48b) M 09/04/11. A stylish kitten. Longer wedge, top line good with large ears well flared and very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with mid green colour. Good profile, chin okay and bite level, slight pinch to muzzle. Long body fairly weighty, good tail. Two thirds white to colour, with white completely down tummy, some bleeding of the white into the chocolate, which was a touch dark but sound. Coat a little long but texture sleek and close. Excellent to handle.

2nd – Baileys's CHEZ DIZZIE RASCAL (48b) M 19/05/11. Very nice for type and fairly well grown for his age. Good head, well balanced with very good top and large ears set to follow Good profile and chin with level bite, teething pinch to muzzle with double canines present. Good shape set and expression to olive green eyes. Body length good but very full tummy line today, good length whip to balance. Three quarters white to dark chocolate, with extensive bleeding of the white into colour on the left side in particular, coat a little long and fine in texture at present. A lovely kitten and actually my preference of the two for type but unfortunately he was monorchid – a withholding fault in an Oriental kitten. This will not be a problem once he is neutered and he should do well. Excellent to handle.

Oriental Bicolour Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Titterall's FIRODILISO STRIKEAPOSE (48 40) F 31/03/11. A lovely female. Quite dainty looking still, but very nice for type and style and she has a

good weighty feel to her. Super head, very well balanced with excellent top and large ears set to follow. Oriental eyes with a lovely expression and excellent depth of blue given the amount of white she has. Medium length body with a slightly full tummy line today, good tail. Just over the half white to fairly warm seal, completely under tummy with plenty on the mask and ears, has attractive “tash” to muzzle. Very good length and texture to coat. Super to handle

2nd – Clothier’s KASSALIC DESTINYINTHESKY (48e) F 04/03/11. A very stylish female, although her head needs to catch up with her body size and development. Typy head with very good top line, ears large, flared and very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with excellent expression and olive green colour. Good profile chin and bite. Very long body with full tummy, good tail to balance. Virtually one third white to colour, very borderline given the narrow line down the tummy that just about meets, but she has plenty across her chest and right down her front limbs so she possibly just has the required third. Black tortie pattern very attractive with large rich red patches that were sound, coat length and texture very good. Excellent to handle, purred throughout.

3rd – Davies’ WICCANWAYS EVANESCENCE (48d) F 29/06/11. The baby of the class and she was very overawed by the occasion. Type and development good. Neat little medium wedge, top line very good and ears very well set. Basic eye shape good but she was widening them with worry today, colour mid green. Weighty and firm body, tail rather short for balance. Just over the one third white to red, completely down tummy but not right across, plenty on chest and some on all four limbs and on face. Red areas show distinct spotting at present, coat baby long and fine. A sweet babe, promising.

Foreign White, Oriental Black or Blue Imperial or Grand Premier Male

UK GD PC – Titterall’s GD PR BABDAG ASIFBYMAJIC (37) MN 06/01/09. A super boy, very stylish and handsome. Excellent head, beautifully balanced with wide top and large wide-based ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape and set with wicked expression and good colour. Really weighty yet firm toned body of very good length, tail needs a touch more length to balance. Superb coat, glossy black completely sound to roots, short sleek and lying close to body – I could almost see my face in it! Excellent temperament – purred throughout.

Oriental Black Pre-Premier Male

PC – Blank’s SHERMESE BLACK DIAMOND (37) MN 19/09/10. A stylish neuter, very dainty and elegant. Typy head with very good width between his very large flared ears. Good profile and chin, bite scissored over. Excellent eye shape set and expression with good green colour. Body very long and slender with whippy tail to balance. Very good coat, short and close, sound to roots with a nice glossy sheen to it. I have to come clean on this one, I had written him up as a female neuter in my report on the day, which due to his daintiness was understandable, but does not excuse me from checking, so my apologies to the exhibitor for my inattention. Excellent to handle.
