OPEN CLASSES

Siamese or Balinese Male Grand Premier

IMP – Mackenzie-Sproat's GD PR ADATEAM CINNPHONY CHESTER (24k) MN 21/06/07. Lovely boy, not the most masculine of lads but he is deceptively substantial and has style in spades. Super head, not over typed but very even and well balanced with large open based ears set wide. Excellent expression to eyes of oriental shape and set, colour could be marginally deeper for perfection but was perfectly acceptable. Strong straight profile with good chin and level bite. Long weighty and well toned body, long elegant limbs, well tapered tail a touch short for balance. Warm spicy-toned points and matching. Medium length coat of good close texture, lightly shaded down the spine to tone. Excellent temperament, perfectly poised and presented.

Oriental Male Grand Premier

IMP – IMP GD PR MYLYNN MAGNIFIQUE (62 43s) MN 05/09/08. Gorgeous person, love his type, strength and overall presence. Wonderful head, strong and stylish with excellent top width and very large tufted ears set in line with the wedge. Super expression to eyes of excellent shape and set with gooseberry green colour. Strong roman profile with deep chin and level bite. Long weighty body, tail just about balances. Super coat for texture, very fine and silky, length good with attractive frilling at the lower edges. Coat pattern somewhat ambiguous, he still shows reasonably well defined spotting on his sides and flanks in dense black, yet the silver undercoat is well up the hair shaft, so to my mind he falls somewhere between spotted and shaded, in a less good cat this would probably matter. Easy to handle but not quite his usual outgoing self today. Presented to perfection.

Oriental Female Grand Premier

IMP – Goddard's GD PR MYLYNN SWEET-PEA (62 43s) FN 05/09/08. A very attractive lady neuter of very good type. Even medium length wedge, nicely balanced without undue exaggeration, ears large and well furnished. Sweet expression to eyes of correct shape and set with clear mid green colour. Almost straight profile and good firm chin with level bite. Long dainty but well covered body. Slender limbs and neat paws, tail almost balances. Coat pattern quite heavy, and for her age I really would have expected to see better diffusion of the colour, although silver undercoat is right the way up the hair shaft. Super texture and very good length to the coat itself, lying flat over shoulders and back with very good length down the sides and a well furnished plume. I must confess to heart searching over this high award due to her heavy pattern, but she still has a little time for it to improve, and in the light of what I

said about the previous lads pattern it would have been inconsistent of me to have withheld on those grounds given her otherwise very good qualities.

Seal Point Female Adult

CC & BOB – Bett’s HEAVENSENT ANA LOUISE (24) F 10/11/09. A well developed girl for her age with fairly good overall type. Medium length wedge with good top of head, ears could be fractionally bigger for balance but were well set. Oval eye shape, setting good, colour could ideally be deeper for a seal but was acceptable. Tiny dip to nose, chin okay, bite level, small pinch to muzzle. Well defined neck, long weighty body, dainty limbs, tapered tail almost balances. Very good warm seal brown points with pale creamy minimally shaded coat of good close texture. Border line for the certificate on type, but I felt that her correct points and coat colour should be recognised in some way, particularly when so many seals these days seem to be dark & cold in tone. A little tense but handled okay, excellently presented.

Cream Point Female Adult

CC & BOB – Ellam’s JAKURTZI VON ESPER (32c) F 02/10/09. A dainty but stylish little queen. Typical head type with good top width and large flared ears set to follow. Very oriental eye shape and set, colour mid blue. Almost straight profile and strong chin, bite just about level. Long slender but well toned body, long fine limbs and spoon paws, long whip tail to balance. Points colouring rather warmer than ideal for cream, with a definite hot spot above the hocks, I have always suspected this lady may apricot but to be fair she has not become any hotter and so would seem to be somewhere between the two colours, with lighting possibly contributing toward this effect I gave her the benefit of the doubt. Lightly shaded coat of lovely close texture. Good tempered and easy to handle. Beautifully presented.

Apricot Male Adult

CC – Ellams JAKURTZI NIGHTISIDEOFEDEN (32fn) M 02/10/09. A lovely young male, very stylish indeed, maturing well and now has very good substance. Super head but is still rather adolescent and needs to strengthen, top line very good and ears large and beautifully set. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Almost straight profile and good chin, bite very untidy and appears marginally over. Very good length and substance to body with an adolescent feel to it as yet, long limbs and long tail to balance. Excellent points colour, rich hot toned apricot well developed for age. Medium length coat with good close lying texture, minimally shaded to tone. Excellent temperament and presentation.

Judged for BOB and awarded – Reed’s IP GD CH AMYDAY SUNSPANGLED (32fn) M 18/07/08. Wonderful boy, I just love him. Fabulous head with very wide top and huge wide based ears beautifully set. Oriental eye shape and set with lovely expression and mid blue colour. Strong profile and good chin, bite missing many incisors now but appears level-ish. Long weighty and well muscled body with long elegant limbs, tail needs length and has an irregularity at the tip. Muted warm apricot points that could ideally be a touch more intense in tone for a cat of this age. Coat a touch soft and fine in texture, lightly shaded to tone. Perfect temperament for a full male, a joy to handle. Excellently presented.

Seal Point Male Kitten

1st & BOB – Mosby’s ADECIAM AKIHIKO (24) M 01/03/10. Quite a well grown boy of good type. Medium length wedge with good top of head and large open based ears well set. Very oriental eyes, marginally small and a little deep set, colour mid blue that could ideally be a touch deeper for a seal but was acceptable. Super strong profile and deep chin with level bite. Weighty body, nice and solid, whippy tail has a small “pip” at the tip. Warm seal points developing. Pale beige coat almost unshaded, with soft fine baby texture still. Excellent temperament, a very friendly lad, excellently presented.

Tortie Point Kitten

1st & BOB – Bowles-Gowdy’s MAFDET PAINTINGBY NUMBERS (32b1) F 06/06/10. Lovely little baby, very promising for type. Super head with very good top and very large butterfly ears set wide. Oriental shaped eyes of good colour. Tiny baby growth dips to profile with firm chin, bite appears to be marginally over but the lower incisors are very tiny and do appear to be still coming through. Well covered and solid little body of promising length with super whippy tail that almost balances. Warm dark seal tortie points developing, mid red shows on the ears, two paws show minimal breaks higher up the limbs only at present. Soft fine baby coat almost unshaded. Quite a feisty little person, excellently presented.

Havana Female Kitten

1st & BOB – Simpson’s SHERMESE SHAKIRA (29) F 28/05/10. A super baby, very promising for type. Stylish head with excellent wide top and huge bat ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set, colour a slightly muddy green as yet and she has the slightest hint of a “look” at present. Straight profile and good chin with level bite. Firm little body of good length with long fine limbs and long whip tail. Really warm toned Havana coat, slightly uneven with a little ticking interspersed throughout the coat at present, this hopefully will correct itself before she becomes adult, texture very short and sleek for a baby. Excellent temperament and presentation.

Oriental Black Male Kitten

1st & BOB – Cherry’s CIATRA NECROMANCA (37) M 16/04/10. A well grown young man of good type and style. Longer wedge, but has a good top and large well set ears that almost balance. Oval eyes well set, colour mid green. Tiny dip to profile centre nose, chin slopes away a touch but bite level, teething pinch to muzzle with double canines at present. Long firm body, long whip tail. Dense black coat, sleek and close-lying, sound to roots. A dear boy to handle, excellently presented.

Oriental Shaded Male Neuter

PC & BOB – Clements’ PR LUNATORA SILVERMINSTREL (43bs) MN 14/08/07. A nice big neuter lad of good type. Medium length wedge with marginally narrow top of head, ears of good size set to follow. Oval shaped eyes of two toned green. Good profile and firm chin with level bite. Excellent substance to long body with good tone for a neuter, quite elegant limbs, tail well tapered and almost balances. I have not seen this lad for some time and what strikes me about his coat pattern, is that he appears to be more ticked than ticked based shaded now, I would have hoped for more diffusion of the surface pattern in a shaded of this age and he is showing at least two bands of ticking with the silver undercoat only just over half way up the hair shaft. However when the silver gene is involved it is not easy to be sure. Showing

some tarnishing to muzzle and front limbs. Very good coat texture and condition. Handled well, excellently presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Oriental SH Breeders Adult

1st – Mazur's VINDEK CLASSICO (41b) M 06/09/09. A good sized lad of basically good type and he has a well muscled feel to his long body. Head rather narrow for balance and his ears need to be larger and wider at the base. Eye shape good but rather straight set across the top, colour hazel. Classic coat pattern not correct with central spine line showing signs of breaking, the butterfly is superficial, there is a good deal of agouti invasion of all pattern areas and those are quite unsound. Good warm tone to the chocolate colour and his coat was of lovely texture. A sweet boy to handle.

Siamese or Balinese Junior Adult

1st - Ellams JAKURTZI NIGHTISDEOFEDEN (32fn) M 02/10/09

2nd – Cook's CH HELSBELS LADY GAGA (32a) F 11/09/09. A lovely female for type, it was close between her and the winner. She has very good substance, super bright red points colouring and an almost clear coat of excellent close texture. Excellent to handle.

3rd - Ellam's JAKURTZI VON ESPER (32c) F 02/10/09

Oriental SH or LH Junior Adult

1st - Mazur's VINDEK CLASSICO (41b) M 06/09/09

Tabby Point/Provisional Status Breeders Kitten

1st – Simpson's SHERMESE SIENNA (32/3) F 28/05/10. A very promising little babe with lovely warm mid chocolate tabby markings developing, including a very well ringed tail that was really whippy and string-like. Love her ears, they are huge and tilting over at the tips at present. Excellent to handle.

Tabby Point/Provisional Status Non-Breeders Kitten

1st – Sewell's MAFDET FIGARO (32/1) M 08/05/10. This kitten was beautifully grown for his age with bags of substance and style. Super head type with extra large wide-based ears very well set. If I were to nit pick I would like the eye colour marginally deeper, but the shape set and expression was very good. A very poised and confident young man.

Balinese/Oriental LH Breeders Kitten

1st – Woodhouse's DORAL MAESTRO (61n) M 17/06/10. A dear little Bali person, everything about him is very promising, his type - he has a very good head with large ears, his colouring – he shows good brownish tones to the base of his ears already, and his coat - which is a very good length for a baby. I shall be interested to see how he develops. Such a sweet babe to handle.

Oriental SH Non-Breeders Neuter

1st – Falconer’s KYOMI HONEYBEAR (37n) MN 12/02/09. This boy is a lovely size and is in really superb condition. Strong type with lovely broad head top, he does tend to bonnet his ears at times but they are a very good size. Very good eye shape and set but they are somewhat amber in tone with just a hint green if you really hunt for it. He still shows the spotty based pattern that he carries but it is far less obvious than when he was a baby and his coat was really sound today. He really is a very good example of the colour. Super to handle.

2nd - Mazur’s VINDEX CLASSICO (41b) M 06/09/09

Balinese Oriental LH Breeders Neuter

1st - Woodhouse’s DORAL LEBRUIN (61ft) MN 12/1/09. A handsome lad with stylish head type, he could do with slightly larger ears for perfection but the setting was very good indeed. Very good apricot colour to tabby markings, tail rings just seen when shaken out. Coat could be perhaps a touch longer but the texture was gorgeous and it was virtually un-shaded. Excellent to handle.

Memorial Class: AV Adult

1st - Cherry’s ZEPPELIN CIATRA CZARINA (24k) F 27/04/08. A nice big girl of very good type. Head perhaps marginally long in the muzzle, but top of head very good and the ears are large enough to almost balance. Good eye shape set and colour. Very good rich warm cinnamon points and matching. Excellent coat length and texture, very sleek and close. A little shy but handled okay.

NON-PEDIGREE MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Kitten

1st – Brock’s TUESDAY (Golden Tabby LH) F 15/05/10. What a gorgeous little baby, she really did have that “Ahhhh” factor. So pretty for colour with lovely wispy edges to her and long exotic ear fluffs, she also had the most gorgeous emerald green eyes. Completely irresistible!

2nd – Blanks’ SOOTY (Black LH) M 28/01/10. Also rather gorgeous this beautifully prepared youngster with the long coal black coat and deep amber eyes. Lovely temperament, it really was close between these two.

Neuter under 4 years old

1st – Maison’s GARFIE (Ginger SH) MN 3yrs. Super boy, very attractive with his rich red coat and vivid green eyes. Excellent condition overall and his temperament was interesting, he was very friendly and so talkative, Siamese in his ancestry I wonder?

2nd – Hutchison’s ROSINA (Tortie LH) FN April 2007. A plumpious lady with a lovely tortie coat, showing deep rich shades of red, contrasting well with her clear green eyes. In top condition and with a very friendly nature.

3rd – Ellis’ RUFUS (Red Silver Shaded SLH) MN 22/03/08. Very beautiful to look at, but a bit shy bless him. Lovely silky coat with muted red shading on pale red silver undercoat, most attractive against his lovely green eyes. Super condition.

ex 3rd – Toth’s MC ROMEO (White SH) MN 2yrs 10mths. A very sweet boy but he was painfully shy and preferred to be judged in is pen where he was much happier. Lovely soft white coat, pristine and sparkling, huge golden eyes with sweet expression. A gentle boy.

Neuter or Kitten

1st – Jones’ MC TEXAS (Blue Spotted Tabby & White SH) MN 25/03/09. A lovely boy immaculately presented. I do wonder if he is a blue silver tabby and white, judging by the white ground colour showing under his tail. Love his blue eyes a vivid sapphire colour. Perfect to handle.
