### OPEN CLASSES

#### Oriental Grand Premier Male

**IMP – Holder's IMP GD PR MYLYNN MAGNIFIQUE (62 43s) MN 05/09/08.**

Wonderful OLH neuter who I have judged on many occasions. Such a big strong cat with excellent type, excellent balance to strong head with wide top and large well furnished ears set to perfection. Love his eyes, with good green colour and such a snooty expression. Strong almost straight profile and deep chin with level bite. Excellent substance to long body with strong boned limbs and large paws with nice foot fluffs, tail almost balances. His pattern is another matter, registered as Shaded, but it is far too heavy for a good shaded cat, and there is definite spotting in places albeit not clearly defined. He really does fall somewhere between Shaded and Spotted, but at the end of the day it is about the overall cat, and overall he is gorgeous. Coat length good, does have a slight ruff these days but it does not detract, texture very fine and silky. Handled beautifully as always. Excellently presented.

**R – Weaver's GD PR SUNJADE SKIPPER (37k) MN 27/10/07.** This lad looked very good today and was much more outgoing than we last met. Very handsome with stylish head type, top line very good and his ears are large and set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with very good green colour and quite a wicked expression. Small dip to profile centre nose, deep chin lines up with the nose tip, bite level. Tends to hunch his neck a little, body long and substantial, perhaps marginally rotund today, long elegant limbs and long tail to balance. Lovely warm and spicy-toned cinnamon coat, a touch unsound on the lower sides but completely clear of ghosting. Super texture to coat, short sleek and close lying. Handled well and was excellently presented.

#### Oriental Grand Premier Female

**IMP – Lee's GD PR WILLHAVETODO WINNIETHEWITCH (37e) FN**

**27/95/06.** A very attractive lady neuter, not exaggerated in any way but very even and balanced overall. Medium length wedge with very good top of head and large nicely flared ears set in line. Eye shape good with gentle expression, can hold marginally wide at times, colour mid green. Excellent strong profile with deep chin perpendicular to nose tip and level bite. Well covered but body of good length and a fairly trim tummy line, neat limbs and paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Excellent coat qualities, and it was this that won her the certificate, very short and close with excellent sleek texture, dense black beautifully mingled overall in various shades of red with lots of good rich red evident in places, and sound to roots. An easy lady to handle, very gentle and friendly. Excellently presented.

### **Oriental Ticked Tabby Kitten Male**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Janicki’s SHERMESE TICKSALLTHEBOXES (45b) MN 07/07/10.**

A beautifully grown kitten neuter of excellent type. Strong stylish head with excellent top line and very large wide based ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set with naughty expression and olive green colour. Strong profile with broad nose and deep chin, bite level. Excellent substance to long body with long strong limbs and long whippy tail. Super coat pattern, showing 4 bands of ticking, in itself remarkable but even more so given the shortness of his coat, sound at roots, the lightest of dorsal line, and large clear spots to tummy. Super coat texture too. Not overly impressed with me interrupting his nap, but handled okay. Excellently presented.

### **Blue Point Siamese Kitten Female**

**1<sup>st</sup> BOB w/h – James’ SCOTMAR RABOBERG QISSBOMBE (24a) F 28/09/10.**

A dear babe of overall good type, lacking a little in style at present, and with one or two things precluding the awarding of the BOB today. Medium wedge with fairly good top line, ear size good, setting marginally high. Very good eye shape and set with good depth of colour and brilliance of tone. Almost straight profile, chin okay but bite scissored over at present. Well covered body of good length, dainty limbs and neat spoon paws, tail needs a little more length and has a small “pip” at the tip. Mid blue points colour still to clear baby muddy tones. Coat of good length texture for a kitten, but also needs to clear. A friendly girl who handled well. Excellently presented.

### **Chocolate Point Siamese Kitten Male**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Single’s HARTZIE ARCTIC ECHO (24b) M 20/08/10.** A well grown lad of good type. Medium length wedge with good top of head, the ears are in proportion at present but I suspect they will end up needing to be a bit larger for balance, ear set good. Oriental eye shape perhaps marginally deep set, colour brilliant in tone. Profile slightly uneven at present with dip centre nose and a small bump at the tip, chin rounds off a touch but bite level. Well covered body of good length, strong limbs and large paws – going to be a big boy I would think, long tail to balance. Darker but very warm toned chocolate points, typically paler on limbs and tail. Ivory coat, almost un-shaded, soft and baby fine at present. A sweet lad to handle and excellently presented.

## **MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**

### **A.C. British Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Wolfe’s CH BUMPKIN VIENNA (16) F 09/07/09.** A lovely big girl of very good type and substance. Strong head for a female with broad skull and dear little ears with rounded tips set to follow the contours of the head, well curved forehead with neat short nose, deep chin and level bite, just a tad square in the muzzle. Large open eyes with excellent intense copper colour. Strong cobby body with short strong legs and round paws, medium length tail with rounded tip to balance. Powder blue coat, look absolutely gorgeous against that eye colour, showing the minimum of silvery tipping but sound and the texture was really good, short dense and crisp. Excellent temperament and very well presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Day’s WILLOWOOD CHAMAX BLUE BALOO (16) M 18/10/09.** Good type to this boy but he still has some filling out to do and a little outshone by the maturity of the girl. Very good head type with broad skull and full cheeks, ears are

fairly small and well set to compliment the head. Rounded forehead with short-ish broad nose, firm chin and level bite. Round eyes with open expression and super copper colour. Slightly long and rather rangy body at present, perhaps a tad long in the leg with medium length tail. Coat a darker blue, free from tipping and really sound, short, crisp and fairly dense. Excellent temperament and presented in very good condition.

#### **A.C. British (6-9mths) Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Shepherd's TRUBRIT CUSTARD CREAM (17) F 15/07/10.** Absolutely gorgeous kitten, excellent type with that real British look and she was beautifully grown. Super head with broad skull and full cheeks already, ears neat and small, with rounded tips, set well apart. Correct profile with rounded forehead and short broad nose, rounded muzzle, deep chin and level bite. Really open expression to large round eyes with wonderful rich copper colour. Strong cobby body with excellent substance for 7 months, short strong boned legs and round paws, balancing tail with rounded tip. Soft pale cream coat with the bare minimum of pattern evident and sound, short and dense but baby soft at present. Very hard to fault, she has an excellent temperament too – made lovely puddings for me! Presented to perfection.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Winn's ORRIANA PHOOEYLOUIE (79s17) M 30/06/10.** A very handsome boy with very good type and excellent development. Round head with very good width to skull, medium sized ears with slightly curly furnishings and broad base, set well apart. Rounded forehead with short broad nose, whisker pads well padded to give the correct rectangular look, chin firm bite level. Very good shape and expression to eyes of intense copper colour. Excellent substance to rectangular body with the promise of adult muscle tone to come, strong boned medium length limbs and round paws, medium length tail. Dark cream coat, very well rexed overall with a plushy feel and the softest texture. A very sweet lad who handled really well and was very well presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Blagdon's CLEYVIEW QUIANA (75) F 01/07/10.** A neat older kitten of good type, perhaps a touch dainty for 8 months. Well rounded head, skull needs to broaden, ears a little large set marginally close at present. Gently rounded forehead with short nose, good chin and level bite. Round eyes that were quite a pale green. Dainty body but good weight for size, short legs and neat round paws, medium length tail with rounded tip. Light tipping to coat showing faint spotted pattern with lovely rich apricot under-coat to almost four fifths up the hair shaft, a touch long but fairly crisp. Excellent to handle.

#### **A.V. British Limit Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Worsley-Waring's SATINMIST HUDSON (16) M 28/08/10.** Very small for 6 months old, reasonable type. Round-ish head that needs to broaden with ears that are rather large for balance at present. Rounded forehead with short fairly broad nose, firm chin and level bite. Round eyes of paler gold. Body a little long and lacking weight and substance, limbs short but quite dainty for a British and his paws are small and dainty also, good tail. Medium blue coat that was unsound, on the long side and soft in texture. He was a very sweet boy to handle with a lovely purr, bless him.

#### **A.V. British Special Limit Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Winn's ORRIANA PHOOEYLOUIE (79s17) M 30/08/10**

### **A.V. British Debutante Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Bewley’s KHANCOBAN SILVERSTARR (30s) MN03/04/10.** A young neuter boy of basically good type, though not the largest of lads. Well rounded head that lacks full cheeks at present, with medium sized ears set well apart. Round eyes with fairly open expression but one eye very sore looking today, colour pale hazel. Rounded forehead with short-ish broad nose, good chin, level bite. Medium length body a touch rangy as yet, short legs and medium length tail with rounded tip. Spotted coat pattern poor with extensive linkage to spots, particularly on the right side, marginally better on the left, spine line solid from shoulder down to tail. Texture quite good but flat and lying quite close to body, even allowing for the fact that he is a silver cat. Lovely temperament and very well presented.

### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Junior Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Pryor-Collins’ CH ADECIAM TIGERMOON-JAZZMIN (24) F 09/04/10.** Gorgeous girl but oh dear what a madam! Lovely type with stylish and beautifully balanced head, with excellent top line and very large ears wide set, to nit pick she is perhaps a little too fine in the muzzle. Very good eye shape and set but with a “judge eating” expression, I seem to remember she was very feisty as a kitten. Points colour looked rather cool toned today, coat colour also on the cool side with “pepper & salt” shading. Super whippy tail. Excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Mosby’s ADECIAM AKIHIKO (24) M 01/03/10.** A young boy of good type and style, fairly well developed for his age. Good head but showing a slight pinch today and his chin is a mite shallow. Good eye shape and set but colour needs to be deeper for a seal. Good warm toned seal points with pale creamy coat showing very good contrast. An easy boy to handle and excellently presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Dickenson’s CH PURMISQUS MAIHONGSONG-LILY (24c) F 08/11/09.** Very good size and substance to this girl, overall type good, she does hold her eyes quite full but the colour is good. Points colour quite pale but looked marginally blue toned today, possibly the lighting was a contributing factor. A friendly lady excellently presented.

### **A.C. Siamese/Balinese Senior Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Woodhouse’s DORAL JESSICA (32b) F 25/06/08.** A mature lady of good type. Medium wedge with good top of head, ears large and set well. Eyes rather full and need to be deeper in colour for a seal tortie. Very long and slender body, I would like a little more substance to her but she was not in poor condition. Very well mingled seal tortie points showing some areas of good rich red and with excellent contrast to her lightly shaded coat of good length and close texture. Easy to handle and excellently presented.

### **A.V. Novice Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Hand’s HARUAN NEEKODEMUS (24c) M 14/01/10.** A very handsome lad. Very good head with wide top line and large wide based ears excellently set. Good eye shape, set and expression, colour could be deeper but was acceptable for a dilute. Points colour shows soft pinkie tones, apart from the tail that had a slightly fawn-ish overtone. Coat only very lightly shaded, with good close lying texture. Lovely to handle and excellently presented.

### **A.C. Oriental Breeders Kitten**

An excellent class with all these babies worthy of a 1<sup>st</sup> prize.

**1<sup>st</sup> – Dawes' BARBECCO DOLLY MIXTURE (37h) F 12/10/10.** Very promising little girl, dainty and stylish with typy head and huge flared ears that she can hold flat at times. Very good eye shape and set with olive green colour. Super warm tones to chocolate tortie coat. Well mingled throughout with various shades of red and sound to roots. Super whip tail to balance. Excellently presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Smith's LORICHA OOHLAALAA (62 43s) F 06/11/10.** A lovely baby, well grown and very promising for type, coat and pattern. Strong little head with beautifully furnished ears very well set. Coat length very good for age with silky texture, and the shading is well diffused already. I shall watch her progress with interest. Lovely to handle.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Dawe's BARBECCO LAVENDER LIL (29c) F 30/10/10.** Another promising babe also well grown. Super little head with wide top and large very well set ears. She is a touch wide in the eye at the moment, but she was very agitated and it should improve when she settles, colour good. Coat colour promising. Excellently presented.

### **A.C. Oriental Non-Breeders Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Janicki's SHERMESE TICKSALLTHEBOXES (45b) MN 07/07/10**

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Mitchell's BARBECCO PENELOPE PITSTOP (29) F 30/10/10.** A stylish baby, fine boned but well grown. Stylish head with very large well set ears,. Very good eye shape and set with super green colour. Excellent rich warm tones to Havana coat, a little bit unsound and showing quite an amount of ghosting at the moment, should lose this as she develops. Super to handle.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Wheatley's SHERMESE MONTE-CRISTO (29) MN 07/07/10.** A nice big lad, well grown. Quite a strong head with very good top line and good sized ears very well set. Coat colour rather dark, but is redeemed by some warmth of tone, it still shows a fair amount of tabby ghosting on the body but is reasonably sound, length and texture good. A friendly boy.

### **A.C. Siamese Breed 24 or Balinese Equivalent Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Martin's GD PR ABICASA PEER GYNT (24n) MN14/02/08.** A strong and stylish boy with very good head type. Medium length wedge with wide top and very large ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape, set and expression with good depth of colour. Points dark blue-based caramel with the desired brownish over tones, tail almost indigo, paw pads purple. Coat quite heavily shaded in fawnish blue tones. Excellent to handle

**2<sup>nd</sup> – English's MAPU JUDE (24c) MN 22/05/10.** A young boy of very good type and style looking very adolescent at present. Even and well balanced head that needs to strengthen. Points colour are not as pinkie toned as I would like, but it could have been the lighting and his paw pads are correct for lilac. Coat virtually un-shaded and of very good length and texture. Excellent to handle.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – McAlpine's GD PR LYNNOX FRANCESCA (24b) FN 17/05/05.** Excellent size and substance to this lady neuter. Stylish head type although she could be a touch finer in the muzzle and she has a very small excrescence on the back of her skull. Points a touch dark but warm in tone and matching. This lady really knows how to show her self and poses beautifully in her double pen. Excellent temperament.

**A.C. Siamese Breed 32 or Balinese Equivalent Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Hutching's IMP GD PR MAFDET MACARTHUR (32/8) MN 23/04/09.** A stylish boy with lovely eyes for shape set and colour, and his tabby markings are very good, with excellent tail rings that show good sludgy tones. Handled well but I thought he lacked his usual sparkle today.
