OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Champion Adult Male

GD CC – Smyth's CH NATHIFA GIGALO (32/8) 13/05/08. A lovely male, strong, masculine and with excellent type. Broad medium wedge with wide top of head and lovely large wide based ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape and set with super expression and very good depth of colour. Almost straight profile and firm chin, bite lacks several lower incisors but looks level-ish. Long hard body with very good muscle tone and substance, long strong limbs and long tail to balance. Lilac based tabby markings show good brownish over-tones, with well defined scarab, single cheek tracings and paler leg bars, tail very well ringed to almost three quarter the length. Excellent coat qualities, short and sleek, with lovely close texture and almost un-shaded. A little tense but handled well. Excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Champion Adult Female

GD CC – Lloyd's CH RIDESTAR AFRICAN VIOLET (61dt) 29/03/09. A most attractive Bali lady of very good type. Even medium length wedge with very good width between fairly large, well furnished ears, set to balance. Good eye shape and set though held marginally full at times, colour very good with deep brilliant tones. Good profile and chin with level bite. Body appeared to have good length when I finally managed to stretch her out, neat limbs and paws for this breed, tail needs an inch to balance. Bright red colouring to tabby markings on mask, lacks bracelets, tail rings are quite pale and just about seen when shaken out. Medium length coat lying well and showing some flow to it, texture beautifully silky and fine, un-shaded, plume fairly well furnished. A little shy but sweet tempered and handle well. Excellently presented.

Seal Point Siamese Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Pryor-Collins' ADECEAM TIGER-MOON JAZZMIN 09/04/10. A well grown and promising baby. Strong little wedge with very good top and large ears she needs to grown into, wide set. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour. Baby growth dips to nose, chin okay and bite level. Well covered little body of good length with dainty limbs and paws, whippy tail needs a touch more length to balance. Dark and slightly cool toned seal points at present, shows shadow marks on top of head which should clear. Good close coat for a baby in pale beige, muddy shading clearing. Quite a feisty little thing, but handled okay. Excellently presented.

2nd – Budden's JOMESE JENTLE KISSES 29/01/10. Also well grown, of good type and style. Medium length wedge with good top of head and large ears that she tends to bonnet. Eye shape a little full and the colour needs to be considerably deeper for a seal. Excellent strong profile, chin could be deeper but bite level, pinch to

muzzle evident. Long weighty and well toned body, elegant limbs, tapered tail need a touch more length. Very dark points and rather on the black side of seal. Wonderful coat, beautifully short and sleek, with light seal shading down the spine. Excellent temperament and presented to perfection.

Blue Point Siamese Kitten Female

1st, BOB w/h – Bell's MEDORAS LADY SALMAKIA 20/04/10. A neat baby of good overall type. Medium length head that was a touch narrow between her large ears, thus setting rather too close for head balance. Oriental shape to eyes, marginally straight set at present, colour could be deeper and she was sporting a squint today, possibly because she is teething, chin okay and the bite is almost level, small dip to nose. Firm toned body of good length, dainty limbs, whippy tail need a little more length. Soft mid blue points well matched, her best feature. Soft fine kitten coat as yet with typical muddy baby shading which should clear. A very sweet person, excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Kitten Male

1st – Cruse's SENSUAL DESTRIER WILLOW (32/3) 25/02/10. Good type to this boy, but a little small for his age – if the DOB is correct. Medium length head, perhaps marginally narrow, ears large and set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour. Dip centre nose, good chin and bite level. I did question his DOB, (although I did check with the table and they confirmed it was correct), due to the very sore and swollen gums that he had on the day, with his new canines coming through. Firm body of good length, super whip tail to balance. Warm mid tabby markings developing nicely, tail half ringed. Un-shaded ivory coat of soft fine baby texture. A dear babe excellently presented.

2nd Jones' SARAMESE SUNNYSIDEUP (32/4) 27/03/10. This boy was extremely well grown for his age, overall type good. Long wedge with nose rather too long for the width now, ears large and well flared, set to follow the lines of the head. Good shape and set to eyes but colour needs to be a lot deeper. Good profile and chin with level bite. Long really substantial body for his age, long limbs, tail needs a little more length to balance. I have judged this lad fairly recently and gave him the benefit of the doubt on colour on that occasion, however he really is far too dark and muddy toned now for lilac and I do think he should be re-registered as caramel tabby. Excellent coat for length and texture, completely un-shaded off-white. Lovely to handle and excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Rudge's SANDIMESE SIOUXIE SIOUX (32/3) 10/04/10. A promising baby, and of the tabby kittens she was the most balanced overall, thus the BOB. Shorter wedge with very good top and large ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set with bright mid blue colour. Straight profile and firm chin with level bite. Dainty but firm toned body of promising length, neat limbs and paws, with tail that almost balanced. Warm toned mid chocolate tabby markings developing with well ringed tail. Super coat for a baby, very short and sleek, pale ivory and completely clear of shading. Extremely vocal but not unfriendly, excellently presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Adult Male

1st – Meek’s JOHPAS MINSTREL (24b) M 30/09/09. A gorgeous boy for type and style with an excellent head. His eyes are perhaps a touch small but they do give him an inscrutable expression and the colour is good. Lovely body, long and really weighty. Points colour dark for the breed, but somewhat redeemed by a modicum of warmth of tone. Coat a little cool in tone with light shading down the spine. Wonderful to handle, so relaxed.

2nd – Button’s BETHANE BARNABY (24a) M 07/08/09. A dear boy of overall good type but somewhat dubious colouring. For a youngster he is very dark, he has very definite muddy tones in places, his coat is quite heavily shaded in muddy tones, and his paw pads and nose leather are purple rather than blue. Lighting not helpful but he does seem to be leaning towards caramel rather than blue. A sweet lad to handle.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Adult Female

1st – Smout’s GD CH KAMIK THEONEANDONLY (32b1) F 11/04/06. A quality lady, very correct and well balanced overall. She has superb eye colour, deep brilliant sapphire. Points dark seal well mingled with various shades of red. Coat shaded overall to tone, of good length and texture. In top condition and handled well.

2nd - Lloyd’s CH RIDESTAR AFRICAN VIOLET (61dt) F 29/03/09

ex 2nd – Saunders’ NATHIFA HOT TOTTIE (32b3) F 04/12/08. A very flashy young miss who needs to mature. I love her ear size and set, and she has very good eye shape set but they looked a touch sore today, colour good. Points a dark rather cool toned chocolate, lots of mingling on all points in mainly pale red. Showed herself well.

3rd – Stokes’ LITTLEFAT ROSARITA (32a) F 14/11/07. Attractive female of overall well balanced type with good size and substance to her. Good head but showing a small pinch to muzzle today. Eye shape and colour good albeit a touch large. Super bright red points colour. Easy to handle.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Breeders Kitten Male

1st – Hand’s HARUAN NEEKODEMUS (24c) M 14/01/10. A stylish boy, very good type and lovely substance to him. Medium length wedge with very good width between large flared ears excellently set, strong roman profile. Oriental eye shape and set with superior expression and very good colour. Soft pinkish points, - despite the yellow lighting, and clear magnolia coat. Excellent to handle.

2nd – Lloyd’s RIDESTAR DANDY LION (61dt) M 20/01/10. A huge person, very well developed indeed, type good. Medium length head with good top, ears could be marginally larger but were very well set and nicely furnished. Oval eye shape, depth of colour very good. Super rich red colour to tabby markings with tail rings very evident. Coat length well developed for a youngster, with fine silky texture. A dear boy to handle.

3rd - Jones’ SARAMESE SUNNYSIDEUP (32/4) M 27/03/10

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Breeders Kitten Female

1st – Pounds’ JOMESE JENNI LOTSASPOTS (32b1) F 29/01/10. A gorgeous baby with wonderful ear set, large wide butterfly ears whose set never changes which ever way she turns her head. The eyes are a trifle large in proportion to the head, but expression good, colour has very good depth though lacks brilliance a tad. A bright future for her I would think. Excellent to handle.

2nd (W/C) – Hand’s HARUAN TALEESHA (24b) F 18/04/10. Such a shame this very stylish baby was incorrectly registered. She is very good shade of cinnamon not chocolate. Type very promising, eye shape and set very good but colour could be deeper. Perfectly poised and presented.

3rd – Freeman’s ADECIAM ZSA ZSA (32b3) F 13/04/10. A dear baby of good type with warm toned mid chocolate tortie points, well mingled in mid red with the odd fleck of a richer tone on the ears, most attractive. Easy to handle.

W/C – Button’s BETHANE BAMBY (32b2) F 20/05/10. Down in my book as blue tortie, this baby was in fact a lilac based caramel tortie. She has a purplish nose leather and her tortie mingling is a very nice shade of apricot. Over all type fairly good but needs a wider top of head for balance. Very friendly.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Non-Breeders Neuter Male

1st – Kersey’s GD PR MALIKASIAM WILBUR-MEWZED (24c) MN 06/09/07. This lad is such a dear and a very good example of the colour, soft pinkie lilac – even in the yellow hall lighting. His bite is very uneven with teeth missing but level-ish. Lovely minimally shaded magnolia coat of super close texture. In top condition and handled beautifully.

2nd – Wallace’s IMP GD PR ROZANDEN SIMBA MFALME (32a) MN 12/04/03 An old favourite of mine with lovely type and colouring, but looking a bit under the weather today and lacked his usually sparkle. Coat a little long and soft in texture and his body tone was not as good as in the past. Perfect to handle as always.

3rd Grice’s – PR MATINES LOOKWHOSTALKING (24) MN 27/06/09. Extremely stylish lad, he has a long typy head, lovely top line and very large ears. Very good profile and deep strong chin with distinctly dodgy bite. Points very dark and dense, on the black side of seal. Perfect temperament.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Non-Breeders Neuter Female

1st – Collings & Mills’ GD PR BARBECCO RUBY STAR (32/5) FN 22/03/08. A most attractive lady with a very expression. Head type good, well balanced and even, eye colour looked good today. Good bright red tabby markings and minimally shaded coat of very good texture. Had a lot to say for herself as usual – and not all of it very polite!. Excellently presented.

NON-PEDIGREE MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**Ex-Stray or Rescue Adult or Kitten**

A tough class – all gorgeous!

1st – Plant’s SILVER SAM (LH Black Tipped) MN 10 yrs. Wonderful boy, a beautifully prepared cat in immaculate condition for a 10 year old. He has such a superior expression to his vivid green eyes. His language was slightly blue toned but there was no evil intent and I just love that wicked look.

2nd – Smith’s ROUX (SH Tortoiseshell) FN 9mnths. This lady on the other hand had the sweetest nature. I am assuming she has little or no sight in one eye, as it is cloudy, and she is uncertain when approached from that side, but when she sees you with her good side she is so friendly. Beautiful tortie coat with a crisp texture, very well prepared.

ex 2nd – Warwick’s MINI MINSTREL (Semi LH Classic Brown Tabby) FN 1yr. Another very friendly lady neuter, this one with super vivid green eyes and a lovely silky tabby coat

3rd – Webb’s IGMC ALYS (LH Tabby & White) FN 2yrs 9months. This lady certainly has size and substance, with a beautifully prepared fluffy coat that makes her look ever larger. I just loved her foot fluffs, possibly the most exotic have seen, they must have been nearly an inch long!

A.C. LH Adult or Kitten

1st – Plant’s SILVER SAM (LH Black Tipped) MN 10 yrs.

2nd – Fenttiman’s MATHILDA (LH Tortoiseshell) FN 5mnths. A pretty baby, blue tortie with pristine white bib and socks. Very fluffy and certainly has that “awww” factor, with the sweetest nature.

3rd – May’s CRIMSON KING (LH Red with White) MN 3yrs. Gorgeous rich red colour to this lad, with the white areas persil white. He has such a dignified look to him and he was lovely to handle.
