OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Sismese/Balinese Premier Neuter Male

GD PC – Woodhouse's PR DORAL LE BRUIN (61fnt) MN12/10/09. A handsome and good sized male neuter of very good type. Medium length wedge with good top of head, ears just about large enough to balance and very well set. Oriental eye shape and set with gentle expression and mid blue colour. Good, almost straight profile, chin firm, bite lacks some incisors but appears to be level. Long weighty body with strong limbs and large well tufted paws, good tail. Warm toned apricot tabby markings, tail rings can just be seen when shaken out. Lovely coat texture, beautifully silky and fine, it could be a touch longer down the sides ideally, but plume well furnished, lightly shaded overall to tone with points. A very sweet tempered and confident lad excellently presented.

2nd , R w/h – Johnson's PR ADNIOAM JUST ABOUT ME (24n) MN 07/02/09.

Not the largest of boys, but good for type and style. Well balanced head with good width to top line and large nicely flared ears well set. Oriental eye shape set and expression, depth of colour good. Marginal dip to nose, good chin and level bite. Blue-based caramel points showing clear brownish over-tones, I note he has lost his ear fur, and unfortunately, he has also lost pigment on his paw pads which is incorrect. Off white coat showing very good contrast to points, a little long long and rather fine in texture. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Neuter Female

GD PC – Blore's CH & PR LUPAZ WENDELLA (32t1) FN 10/12/02. A lovely big girl who's looks and condition belie her age, very good for type and style. Very good head type with super top and large ears set to balance. Such a wicked expression to eyes, she does have a slight "look" to her but that does not detract, and the depth of colour and brilliance of tone is very good. Strong profile with broad nose, good chin, bite lacks incisors but appears level. Long strong and substantial body with long elegant limbs and long tail. Excellent points pattern with both elements clearly evident, well defined tabby markings on head and tail with excellent rich red mingling mainly on the ears and tail. Good contrast to coat for a seal tortie tabby of this age, overall length and texture excellent. I just love her haughty look – even if she was rather naughty today. Excellently presented.

British Blue Kitten

1st & BOB – Brown's ACRESWAY QUIANA (16) F 03/11/10. A well grown baby of good type. Round head with cheeks developing well, ears a touch large at present but set well apart. Eyes round and open, colour rather a pale gold. Well rounded forehead and short broad nose with good definition between the two, firm chin, bite just about meets, tends to puff out her whisker pads at times. Medium length weighty body, limbs short and strong with large round paws, medium length tail. Mid blue coat, with some silvery tipping and marginally unsound today, but length and density very good, just a touch baby soft at present. Extremely vocal but handled well.

Oriental Blue Adult

CC & BOB – Titterall’s SENSUAL SKY BLUE (37a) F 12/10/08. A dainty lady of very good type. Stylish head with very good top line and lovely large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape with good expression and clear mid green colour. Almost straight profile, good chin and level bite. Long slender body well covered and well toned, with good weight for size, long dainty limbs and neat spoon paws, whip tail to almost balance. A fairly dark blue colour to coat, but it was free of ghosting and sound to roots, medium in length and of good close texture. Rather shy but sweet tempered and handled well. Excellently presented.

Oriental Lilac Neuter

PC & BOB – Cockcroft’s SOLARUS MONT VENTOUX (29c) MN 10/08/09. An attractive boy of good overall type. Head even and well balanced but a touch effeminate, ears of good size and set. Well shaped eyes set correctly, colour mid green. Good profile and chin, bite a little untidy but level. Good length and substance to body, long limbs, tail almost balances. Mid lilac coat with a slightly ruddy overtone – cinnamon in the pedigree perhaps? Mainly sound, a touch long and fine in texture lying close to body. Superb temperament, ten out of ten for ease of handling. Excellently presented.

Oriental Black Neuter

PC & BOB – TITTERALL’S BABADAG ASIFBYMAJIC (37) MN 06/01/09. An extremely handsome chap. Strong stylish head with excellent width to top, ears large, wide at the base and excellently set. Hazel green eyes of very good shape and naughty expression. Strong profile, not quite straight with a slight bump at brow level, chin lines up but could be a touch deeper, bite untidy but level. Long strong and well toned body, long strong limbs, tail to balance. Dense, glossy, boot black coat, marginally unsound on the sides today but excellent for length and texture. Not the happiest of bunnies and glowering at me from the depths of his nest as usual. Beautifully presented.

Caramel Point Siamese Adult Male

CC & BOB – Withers’ TINTALLY-TIME LORD (24n) M 09/05/10. I really like this boy, he has such strong head type and is beautifully developed for his age. Medium wedge with broad top line and very large wide based ears set to perfection. Oriental eye shape and set with a very superior expression and good depth of colour. Strong roman profile with firm chin and level bite. Excellent length and substance to body, slightly “puppy” like at present but with the promise of adult muscle tone to come, long strong limbs and good tail to balance. Excellent points colouring with clear brownish over tones to tail and ears. Almost un-shaded off-white of excellent sleek texture. Perfect to handle, a relaxed and friendly boy – I could have taken him home! Presented to perfection.

Caramel Point Siamese Adult Female

CC – Ellam’s JAKURTZZI KARAMELMYST (24n) F 12/12/09. A stylish and elegant lady. Longer wedge that is perhaps a touch over-fine in the muzzle, ears large and flared, set to follow the lines of the wedge. Oriental eye shape and set with very good depth of colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Elegant neck-line, long slender but firm toned body, long slender limbs and long tapered tail to balance.

Super points colour with very good brownish overtones, matching well on all points. Virtually un-shaded coat of very good length and texture. Very wriggly but good tempered. Excellently presented.

Seal Point Siamese Kitten

1st & BOB – Bowles-Gowdy’s LAZIZA MAFDET-MALRANO (24) M 17/10/10.

Ultra typy lad, very OTT at present and it will be very interesting to see how he develops. Head rather out of balance at the moment with very broad top line and the most enormous ears with F.A. cup handles, held on the low side. Super expression to eyes of excellent shape set and colour. Almost straight profile with firm chin, bite a touch uneven. Very long body that is deceptively weighty and substantial, long limbs and super long whippy tail. Dense but warm toned seal points with lightly shaded, creamy coloured coat of lovely close texture. Fabulous temperament. Another one to take home!

2nd – Hall’s FURRYFACE MARIO LS (24) M 27/08/10. I have judged this lad on several occasions and always placed him well, but he was unlucky to meet the winner today. He also has a very typy head though not as extreme, lovely top line and very large bat ears set wide. Oval eye shape, colour could ideally be a little deeper and more brilliant in tone. Strong roman profile, chin slopes back a touch but the bite is level. Long really solid body, long limbs, tail quite whippy bit needs an inch. Warm mid seal points with pale beige coat that is lightly shaded overall to tone, length and texture excellent. A lovely boy to handle and beautifully presented as always.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.C. British Debutante Adult

1st – Shepherd’s TRUBRIT FRUITCAKE (21) F 15/07/10. A lovely big girl for 9 months, very good type and style. Super head, round with good width to skull, cheeks full, ears really neat and small following the contours of the head. Rounded forehead with short broad nose, deep chin and level bite. Excellent expression to round eyes of intense deep copper colour. Strong cobby body with excellent substance, short strong limbs and medium length tail to balance. Glossy black coat beautifully mingled throughout in rich shades of red, marginally unsound on the sides, super for length and texture, short dense and crisp. She has that typical “naughty tortie” look about her, but handled perfectly. Excellently presented.

2nd – Brown’s CHARMODEN SIMPLY-BAXTER (16) 22/04/10. A young lad of good type, typically adolescent. Round head with good width to skull and cheeks developing well, ears small and set well apart. Round eyes with open expression and deep gold colour. Well rounded forehead curving to short-ish nose, firm chin and level bite, perhaps a little prominent in the whisker pads. Medium length body, stands on short strong limbs, tail medium in length with rounded tip. Lovely coat colour, a lighter blue, most attractive, there is some tipping to it but it is very sound, of good length and density but a little soft in texture. A really happy boy, very friendly indeed and did not want to go back in his pen. Excellently presented.

3rd – Martin’s WELLMAR SOLITAIRE (18e) F 12/06/10. A pretty lady of good type. Neat well rounded head with smallish ears set on well, cheeks just beginning to show. Good profile with short nose, chin lines up with the nose tip and bite level. Round eyes with open expression and deep gold colour. Medium length body, fairly

weighty, neat short limbs and paws, medium length tail. Attractive coat pattern, dense black tabby markings on mid silver ground with all elements of the pattern present, a little obscured in places by the patches of muted red, some tarnishing evident on muzzle on front paws. Coat length good, density and texture good for a silver cat. Rather naughty but most of it was just noise. Excellently presented.

A.C. British RADIUS Adult

1st Taberer's ADSETSH PEARL OF SICORN (39) F 22/04/07. A neat little queen of good type. Round head with slight cheeks, ears small and set well apart. Round eyes with paler green colour and black eye liner. Rounded forehead curving well to short broad nose with bright pink nose leather, good chin and bite. Body medium in length and lacked a little substance today, short neat limbs, tail a touch long for balance. Tipping light and mainly evenly distributed, just a slightly darker area shows over the lower back, changing her coat by the look of it and losing some hair, but of generally good length and texture. Excellent to handle.

Wrong Colour – Palmer's DIXYLAN BONJOUR L'AMOUR (40 5) M 05/04/10.

A nice big lad for his age with good type. Round head with fairly full cheeks and small ears set well on broadish skull. Clear blue eyes that were slightly deep set and lacked open expression. Good profile with short broad nose, good chin and bite. Body a little long and rangy at preset but has plenty of weight and substance, short limbs and medium length tail. Points colour a very hot cream and not red as down in my book. Coat rather long and fluffy, lightly shaded over all in warm cream. Super temperament and handled really well. Excellently presented.

A.V. Visitors Adult

1st – Debowska's GD CH CHAPELROSE CINDERELLA (37) F 25/06/09. (See my report for Bedford CC)

2nd – Hall's CH FURRYFACE BURLINGTONBERTIE (24) M 26/12/08. Very handsome with lovely warm toned seal points. Looking very good today I thought

3rd – Gray & Johnson's CH TOGHAR MAID TOORDER (32/1) F 12/10/08. Dainty and stylish, overall a very attractive queen.

A.V. Visitors Adult

1st – Cook's JOHPAS MIZMIXTURE (32b2) F 04/07/10. Now this I love, I have watched her progress since a tiny baby when she took my breath away, and I could not stop myself going back to have another look at her. Wonderful type and she knows just how to show herself. Not entirely sure she is blue tortie, she does have a slightly dingy look about her in places, and one hind leg lacks tortie breaks, but almost perfect.

2nd – Richard's GD CH DEBIKAT GRACIE-MAE (32/1) F 02/04/08. (see Bedfordshire report)

3rd – Bowles-Gowdys MAFDET MIND THE PAINT (32b2) F 03/06/10. A very dainty lady but stylish. She is dark for a blue tortie and there are some very definite muddy tones to her ears mask & tail. Good eye colour.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Breeders Kitten

1st - Hall's FURRYFACE MARIO LS (24) M 27/08/10

2nd – Hall's FURRYFACE SACAJAWEA (32/1) F 24/08/10. A dainty female kitten, very stylish with length everywhere. Fairly well defined tabby markings with large thumb prints and single cheek ribbons, tail just on the half ringed. Coat texture very good today, sleek and close lying. Excellent to handle.

3rd – Hirst's TOGHAR ANASTASIA (32b2) F 17/11/10. Rather small for age but nice and compact. Type promising, but eye colour could be deeper and the bite is becoming undershot which is a pity. Pretty pale blue tortie points. Super temperament

A.V. Senior Neuter

1st – Whitby's IMP GD PR PIPPASTRO MAJIK FLUTE MN (62 43fn) 07/07/07. Very good for type and with the sweetest expression, he is not the most masculine of lads, nevertheless, has lovely weight and substance to him. Excellent hot tones to apricot colour over the back and tail, head a little paler. Shaded pattern difficult to see as there is minimal contrast between pattern and ground colour. Coat length and texture excellent. Super to handle as always.

2nd – Meeking's IMP GD CH FIROUSI FREEDSPIRIT (32c) FN 26/03/03. A quality senior lady who can certainly give the youngsters a run for their money with her perfect powdery cream points and excellent type. Lovely eyes, but eye colour could be better. Excellent temperament

3rd – Goddard's IMP GD PR MYLYNN SWEET-PEA (62 43s) FN 05/09/08. Overall a very neat and tidy lady with a well balanced head. Shading very heavy for an older girl. Excellent condition and temperament.
