OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Grand Premier Male

Imp – Glaubitz's GD PR LITTLEFEAT DISTANT THUNDER (32a) MN 29/05/09. A handsome boy with very good type, he has lovely substance to him, without any loss of elegance. Longer wedge with very good top of head and excellent ears size, flare and set. Oriental eye shape and set with naughty expression today and mid blue colour. Strong profile with broad nose, bite lacks a few incisors but looks level, though not too happy about having his bite examined today. Long weighty and well-toned body, long limbs and tail to balance. Bright mid red points colour and warm white coat of very good length and texture, lightly shaded overall to tone. Very tense today, beautifully presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Grand Premier Female

1st – IMPGD PC w/h – Webb's GD PR APRIKAT SUNSPLASHED (61e) FN 30/03/07. The dearest of ladies, her type is good and I have given her a Grand in the past when her coat was very good, but for me she lacks that something extra for an Imperial certificate. Medium length wedge with good top-line and proportionate ears well set. Basic eye shape good but a little on the full side, colour has good depth. Dip to nose, strong chin, bite untidy but level. Well covered body of medium length, neat limbs and well tufted paws, tail need an inch to balance. Very dark tortie points, which looked rather cold in appearance today with mainly paler red mingling. Coat needs length, the overall texture was good but it lacked the required flow, plume reasonably furnished. The sweetest temperament, handled beautifully as always, excellently presented.

A.C. Oriental Premier Male

GD PC - Webster's PR NANPEMA FLAMENCO (37d) MN 08/03/10. A strong neuter boy who was very well developed, type and style good. Strong head with very good top and large wide based ears set to balance. Almond shaped eyes well set colour rather yellow toned but some green just seen. Strong profile with broad-ish nose, good chin and bite. Long weighty and substantial body, long strong limbs, tail rather short for all that body length. Mid red coat fairly bright in tone, showing rather a lot of spotted pattern at present, hopefully this will fade somewhat as he matures, excellent for length with sleek close texture. Excellent temperament and presented to perfection.

A.C. Oriental Premier Female

1st GD PC w/h – Brider & MacKenzie's PR MISHKANA MORNINGMIST (29c) FN 05/06/06. Overall an attractive lady for type, she also has very good size and substance to her, however, her coat was not correct today. Good head type, fairly well

balanced and even, without undue exaggeration, I would just like her ears a touch larger, but they were well set. Small dip to profile, good chin, bite untidy and marginally over. Comfortably covered body of medium length, slender limbs and neat oval paws, tail short for balance. Coat colour a rather dark lilac but does show some pinkish tone and it is very sound, however, it seems to have a lot of body to it and the texture is plushy rather than sleek, particularly around her neck, which is not correct for an oriental. A dear lady who I would have been happy to give a PC today, but not a Grand.

British Bicoloured Kitten

1st , BOB w/h – Wood's CHARMODEN NORTON (31a) M 14/10/10. An attractive boy of good type, but I felt he was a touch effeminate looking for a male of nearly 7 months at the moment. Well rounded head with fairly good width to skull, ears medium in size at present but set well. Eyes round in shape with good expression, colour more green than gold. Profile could be more rounded and there could be better definition where it meets the nose, chin firm and bite level. Body of medium length, good for weight and substance, short strong limbs and round paws, tail rather long for balance, but nicely rounded at the tip. Medium blue areas to coat that show a little tipping and some tabby ghosting to the body, and the tail in particular, but it was sound. White areas show inverted "v" to face, across chest, under-tummy but not completely across the width of it, legs show white with islands of blue, so overall he appears border line for one third white. Coat very promising, really short and dense with good texture. Very sweet tempered and excellently presented.

Oriental Tortoiseshell adult

Judges for BOB only and awarded – Brownrigg's CH BECKSTAR FANTASIA (37e) F 09/04/10. A lovely little queen, very dainty and stylish. Super head with very good top line and large flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with gentle expression and mid green colour. Marginal dip to profile centre nose, firm chin and level bite. Elegant neck, long and slender but deceptively weighty body, long dainty limbs and neat paws, tapered tail need a touch more length to balance. Glossy black tortie coat, well mingled in mid and paler red, length good, texture rather fine and could be sleeker today. Beautifully poised and presented

Oriental Caramel Adult

IC & BOB – Chivers' DEDANNAN TREASURE-ME (37n) M 28/05/09. A big strong lad of good type. Good head type albeit rather jowly which spoils the overall balance somewhat, top of head good with the ears fairly large and well set. Oriental eye shape, set and expression with paler green colour. Tiny dip to nose, chin could be little firmer, but bite level. Tends to hunch his neck and the body, although of good length, is on the chunky side, strong limbs, tail rather short. Coat colour acceptable for lilac-based caramel, he does have some blue-ish sheen to his head, but I would like him to show a more brownish overtone overall, there is a little tabby ghosting to the lower sides but the coat generally is sound, length and texture good. Very shy but handled okay. Excellently presented.

Oriental Spotted Tabby Kitten

1st & BOB – Stevenson's SYBELLA SIMMERING STRUMPET (38c) F 13/12/10. A promising baby, head type good with good width to top of head and large flared ears well set. Good expression to eyes of oriental shape and set with clear green

colour. Almost straight profile and firm chin with level bite. Long, really solid little body, with long fine limbs and whippy tail to balance. Not entirely sure that she is lilac, she does appear to have some brownish/caramel overtones in places so her development may very well have to be watched, but I was happy to accept her as lilac on the day. Pattern promising, spots mainly clear and well defined, there is a little linkage behind the forelimbs but the spine is well broken and there is minimal agouti invasion of the pattern. Good to see a spotty with real spots, lets hope she keeps them. Super coat length and texture for a baby. Excellent temperament and presentation.

Oriental Blue Neuter

Judges for BOB only and awarded – Anderson’s GD PR FIORDILISO EARL GREY (37a) MN 21/06/08. I really do like the type of this neuter boy. Strong stylish head, with wide top-line and very large ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with wicked expression and good clear green colour. Straight, strong profile with firm chin that lines up with the nose tip, bite scissored over. Long weighty and well toned body with long elegant limbs and oval paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Darker blue coat that was only marginally unsound, medium in length and of good close texture. Not in the best of moods today but handled okay. Excellently presented.

Tortie Point Siamese Adult

CC & BOB – Webster’s SHADOWSQUAD KIERA CARAMIA (32b1) F 23/01/09. A neat & tidy little queen of good type and style. Good top line to medium length wedge with ears of good size and set. Oval shaped eyes set well, colour medium blue. Straight strong profile and deep chin, bite a little untidy but appeared level. Long, quite narrow yet surprisingly weighty body, generally well toned but tummy line a little full today, long limbs and tail. Dark seal tortie points well mingled on all extremities in paler and medium red. Good close coat lightly shaded overall to tone. Rather shy but handled well. Excellently presented.

Tortie Point Siamese Kitten

1st & BOB – Brider & MacKenzie’s NANPEMA HOLLY-GOLIGHTLY (32b1) F 08/12/10. A promising baby well grown for her age. Head type good with large flared ears very well set. Basically good shape to eyes but held a little wide, setting good and with deep blue colour. Straight strong profile with deep chin and level bite. Solid little body of good length, with long dainty limbs and a whip tail that almost balances. Seal tortie points very dark with pale red mingling, has in interesting pale red tip to tail. Almost un-shaded coat of very good length and texture for a baby. Very friendly and easy to handle, excellently presented.

Tortie Point Siamese Neuter

PC & BB – Marshall’s NANPEMA CERYS-CARIAD (32b1) FN 08/03/10. An attractive lady neuter of very good type, and with lovely size and substance. Strong head with wide top and large ears very well set – could be a touch finer in the muzzle. Good profile and chin with level bite. Excellent substance to long body without loss of elegance, long quite strong limbs for a girl, tail almost balances. Warm toned dark seal tortie points, mingling mainly pale with the odd darker red fleck on the ears and

tail. Coat good for length and texture, lightly shaded overall in pale seal tortie. Rather shy, but gentle and handled well. Excellently presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.C. Oriental Non-Breeders Adult

1st – Cassar-Simmonds GD CH CIATRA BASHFUL BRUNO (37) M 12/01/08.
A strong, stylish and very handsome boy. Super head for style and balance, very good bright green colour to eyes with wicked expression. Glossy black coat, sound today. Excellent to handle.

2nd – Brownrigg’s CH BECKSTAR FANTASIA (37e) F 09/04/10

3rd - Chivers’ DEDANNAN TREASURE-ME (37n) M 28/05/09

A.C. Oriental Debutante Adult

1st – Enwistle’s SYBELLA SINNBAD (37fn) M 08/07/10. A lad of overall good type but very much a big baby at the moment. Good head with largish ears and clear green eyes. Good apricot coat colour with nice hot tones, some spotting evident on body at present. A friendly boy in excellent condition.

A.C. Oriental Non-Breeders Neuter

1st - Brider & MacKenzie’s PR MISHKANA MORNINGMIST (29c) FN 05/06/06

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Aristocrat Adult

1st – Bohanna’s JOMESE JAMBALAYA (24) F 09/04/10. A neat and dainty seal queen of very good type. Typy head with excellent top and very large ears set wide, good profile and chin, pinch to muzzle today. Points very dark and a touch cold in tone. Excellent temperament.

2nd - Webster’s SHADOWSQUAD KIERA CARAMIA (32b1) F 23/01/09

A.C. Siamese Adult

1st – Brock’s CH KEVELS TWICE AS NICE (24b) M 18/04/10. Very handsome with an even and well balanced medium wedge and very large ears. Excellent expression to eyes of very good colour, good profile and chin but bite scissored over. Good warm chocolate points, fairly well matched but tail very brindled today. Lightly shaded coat. Excellent to handle, a very relaxed boy.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Maiden Adult

1st – Gurney-Taylor’s ADECIAM CADMUS WARRIOR (24b) M 06/06/10. A good sized boy for his age, with excellent muscle-tone to body. Type fairly good but head out of balance and needs much larger ears. Eye shape and set good but colour needs depth. Chocolate points dark and cold in tone, not as required by the SOP. Very cross, excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Limit Adult

1st – Hall & Hall’s FURRYFACE MARIO LS (24) M 27/08/10. Very typy boy with a super head for style, with huge jug handled ears set wide. Eye shape and expression good, colour could be a tad deeper for a seal. Profile strong but chin goes

back rather – bite level. Lovely warm seal points and it was this that won him the class.

2nd – Weatherill’s BURNTHWAITES BABE-MAGNET (24) M 13/08/10. Another very stylish kitten, he is very long and elegant with an especially long tail. Head type good and the eye colour is also very good, but, the points are black not seal, which is not correct. Super friendly and presented to perfection.

ex 2nd – Hall & Hall’s FURRYFACE SACAJEWEA (32/1) F 24/08/10. A dainty female kitten of very good type, almost adult but has a fair amount of developing to do yet. Good tabby marking and almost clear coat of very good texture. Handed well and was excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Maiden Kitten

1st - Brider & MacKenzie’s NANPEMA HOLLY-GOLIGHTLY (32b1) F 08/12/10

2nd – Master’s SYBELLA SILK BOW (24r) F 13/12/10. Overall this is very attractive baby, her type is good and her points colour is lovely, a soft fawn with rosy tones. However, her eye colour is very poor, it is almost pale grey rather than blue and it has what appears to be a pale yellow outer rim, a great pity, she is the sweetest person too.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Novice Kitten

1st - Brider & MacKenzie’s NANPEMA HOLLY-GOLIGHTLY (32b1) F 08/12/10

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Limit Kitten

1st – Helm’s VELVETENA FAWNTOCAPTIVATE (24r) F 19/08/10. A well grown baby of very good type. Head perhaps a touch long, but ears large and very well set. Eye shape and set good with mid blue colour. Pale rosy fawn points and pale virtually un-shaded coat. Excellent to handle.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Aristocrat Neuter

1st – Deacon’s RICHDALÉ PAGAN STAR (32/1) MN 19/10/09. A handsome chap with the most wonderful temperament. Stylish head and lovely expressive deep blue eyes. Very elegant body with good substance and tone for a neuter. Well defined tabby markings. A huge time waster in excellent condition.

A.C. Siamese Neuter

1st – Webb’s PR LITTLEFEAT TEXAS TWISTER (32a) MN 05/03/10. I have always like the type and overall style of this boy, I just wish he were more masculine looking, although to be fair he has put on some size and substance since we last met. Super head with wide top and very large, flared ears excellently set. Lovely expression to brilliant blue eyes. Handled beautifully as always.

2nd – Prescott’s MOEI COLOUR OF MAGIC (32a) MN 16/04/10. Another neuter boy of very good type and style albeit a little small and dainty as yet. Very good head for style but is somewhat effeminate at present, hopefully this will change as he matures. Excellent expression to eyes with very good depth of colour. Mid red points

and almost clear coat of very good texture. A very dear boy who just needs to mature. Excellently presented.

A.C. Balinese Neuter

1st – – Webb's GD PR APRIKAT SUNSPLASHED (61e) FN 30/03/07

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Maiden Neuter

1st – Rowe's CH FOXYPAWS MELISANDE (24) FN 20/04/09. Neat lady neuter of overall well balanced type. Good head with large ears well set, and sweet expression to eyes of good colour. Dainty body, but good weight for size, good tail. Points very dark and a touch cold in tone, warmer on the front limbs. Coat very good for length, texture and contrast. Excellent to handle.
