It was my first visit to this show, there was a super atmosphere and some high quality cats to judge, so I am glad we managed to get there. Given the extra classes that I had to take on due to the absence of Mrs Farnsworth & Mrs Starr and the need to leave for home fairly early, I did not take notes for miscellaneous classes and so shall only be reporting on Open classes on this occasion. My thanks to Ross Davies who stepped in at the last minute to steward for me and who did an excellent job, I look forward to the next time Ross.

OPEN CLASSES

A.V. Imperial Grand Champion Male

IMP GD CC – Cassar-Simmond's GD CH FIORDILISO INFIDELITY (29) M 15/01/09. A quality boy, with very good overall type, style and maturity. Strong and well balanced medium wedge with large flared ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set, with just a hint of a "look" now and again, but it does give him a superior expression and the colour is good. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Long body with excellent strength and muscle-tone, long strong limbs and good length tail. Havana coat perhaps marginally dark and hall lighting not particularly good, yet there was good warmth of tone evident, and it was virtually sound to roots. Very good for length and texture, short close and very sleek. A handsome lad who handled really well and was excellently presented.

R – Bauerfeind's GD CH SHIMILEETA TOSEXYFORMYFUR (43b) M 18/04/09. A very stylish boy, showing good strength and masculinity. Excellent head type with lovely wide top and very large flared ears set in line. Oriental eye shape, setting a touch deep, colour good. Profile in two plains that join at eye level, with brow line rather flat then a long broad nose, good chin and bite. Really weighty and well muscled boy of very good length, long elegant limbs and long tail to balance. Shaded coat shows well diffused spotted pattern on the top quarter of the hair shaft, under-coat a warm toffee colour with just a marginally unsound grey area at the roots today. Coat length very good, it was short and fairly close but not quite the texture of the winner. Super to handle, a very relaxed boy who purred throughout. Excellently presented.

A.V. Oriental Premier Male

1st GD w/h – Thirsk's PR TENAJ BRONZE MYSTIC (29) 27/03/09. A large neuter lad of overall good type. Long rather narrow wedge with top line needing a little more width, ears of good size but set upright. Very good colour to eyes but shape rounded rather than oriental. Profile uneven with dip centre nose and bump near the tip, firm chin and level bite. Long well toned body of substance, long limbs and neat paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Darker but very rich and warm-toned Havana coat, medium in length and lying close to body, but unsound today. Overall a

nice boy, I would have been happy to give him a PC. Excellent temperament and presentation.

A.V. Oriental Premier Female

GD PC Weaver's PR FOXPAWS SCARLET (37d) FN 09/06/08. A very stylish lady, quite dainty but much more substantial than she first appears. Typy head with very good top line and large well flared ears set to balance. Wicked expression to eyes of typical shape and set, colour a good clear green, haws up a touch today. Almost straight profile with good chin, bite very untidy but level-ish. Long slender body, very elegant and well toned, long dainty limbs and neat oval paws, tail a bit short for balance. Coat a good bright red colour, shows a fair amount of spotted pattern but it was red to roots, length good, texture slightly soft but lays well. Some of the language was most impolite but she handled okay, excellently presented.

R – Mackenzie's PR MISHKANA MORNING MIST (29c) FN 05/06/06. A dear lady of overall good type. Shorter but fairly well balanced head with good top and proportionate ears well set. Oriental eye shape and set with yellowish green colour. Profile a touch uneven, chin slopes back, bite untidy but level. Body has good length but is rather on the chunky side, neat limbs and paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Soft pinky grey coat that was completely sound, the thicker undercoat gives it a little "body" but the top coat had superb texture. The dearest of ladies, a little shy but handled well, borderline for the certificate on type but her very good coat qualities swung the decision in her favour.

Oriental Shaded Adult

Judged for BOB only and awarded - Bauerfeind's GD CH SHIMILEETA TOSEXYFORMYFUR (43b) M 18/04/09

Oriental Black Kitten

1st BOB w/h – Smout's ROZANDEN BHICTORIA (37) F 14/06/10. A well grown girl of good overall type. Longer wedge with marginally narrow top at present, ears large and well flared but set a mite high for balance. Oval shaped eyes well set, colour two toned green. Tiny dip to nose, chin good and bite level. Solid little body of good length, dainty limbs and paws, tail need a little more length to balance. Dense sleek black coat rather unsound in places at present, but good close texture. Handled well for the most part but had a mini explosion at the end for some reason, no idea why, she just decided she had had enough I think. Excellently presented.

2nd – Bauerfeind's TOGHAR TOTAL ECLIPSE (37) 14/06/10. A very promising baby, for type, albeit a little small for 5 months. Super little head with wide top line and large ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape and set with good green colour. Straight profile and deep strong chin, bite clearly undershot. Good length body with weight appropriate for size, long spidery limbs and teeny paws, whippy tail to balance. Dense black coat, a little baby fine and soft at present, mainly sound. A sweet babe, lovely to handle - what a pity about the bite. Excellently presented.

Oriental Tortie Neuter

PC & BOB – McDermant's CH LORIMNAILE REGAL RUMPUS (37e) FN 10/01/09. A big strong lady of good type and style. Strong medium wedge with good top of head and large ears well set. Oval shaped eyes well set, yellow-ish green in

colour. Almost straight profile, chin a touch shallow, bite lacks lower incisors but looks level. Long weighty body, long limbs and oval paws, tail rather short for balance. Super coat qualities, dense black beautifully mingled overall in various shades of red with some deep rich red picking out the underlying pattern on the hind legs and tail in particular, excellent for length and texture, in tip top condition. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Champion Male

GD CC - Brownrigg's CH CHAPELROSE HOLY MOSES (32fn) M 25/06/09.

An elegant lad of very good type and style. Super head, stylish and well balanced with large flared ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Almost straight profile, good chin and bite. Super long, elegant and well muscled body, with long limbs and long tail to balance. Excellent colour points, rich hot apricot. Excellent coat for length and texture, some shading shows with spots and bars on flanks. Excellent temperament for a full male, beautifully relaxed and easy to handle. Excellently presented.

R – Bauerfeinds's CH PALMIRA MARCUS (32/3) M 19/06/09. A great big lad of overall good type. Medium wedge with good top of head and large ears, fairly wide at base, set to follow. Oval shaped eyes well set with a slight “look”, colour could be a touch deeper but were acceptable. Profile slightly uneven and he has a muzzle pinch that tends to rob his head of strength, chin slopes back a touch but bite level. Long, lean but fairly weighty body, he is still a rangy adolescent in this sense, long strong limbs and oval paws, good-ish tail. Good tabby markings in mid warm chocolate, with clear thumb prints, one and one half cheek ribbons and well, albeit close banded, tail rings. It was difficult to judge his coat with any accuracy as he was such a happy soul, and kept fluffing himself up like a hedgehog, texture appeared a bit soft and fine, but minimally shaded to tone. A nice lad, not without his problems and I must confess to hesitating over the certificate, but in the end felt I had insufficient justification to w/h. Excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Champion Female

GD CC – Bauerfeind's CH PALMIRA BREEZE (32/1) F 19/06/09. A neat little queen of good type style. Well balanced medium wedge with very good top line and large wide based ears set in line. Lovely eyes for shape set and expression with super colour, deep brilliant blue. Virtually straight profile, firm chin, untidy but level bite. Dainty and slender body but good weight for size, slender limbs and neat paws, well tapered tail needs a touch more length to balance. Tabby markings appear to be ticked based and as such are a little indistinct in the head apart from the thumb prints which are large and clear, leg bars close and narrow, tail rings just over the one third. Pale beige coat, lightly ticked overall, slightly long and a little open. Super temperament`

Blue Point Siamese Adult Male

1st CC & BOB w/h - Hogan's SHADOWSQUAD STORMTROOPER (24a) M 06/12/09. A young male, basic type good but needs to mature and strengthen a good deal before he is ready for a CC. Medium length wedge with slightly narrow top of head, ears are of a good size but set marginally close for balance. Eyes excellent for shape set and colour. Slight dip to profile, chin okay, bite untidy and scissored over, pinch to muzzle that tends to square off the wedge somewhat. Firm tone to long body but needs to muscle up, good tail. Well matched points colour of darker blue. Coat

lacks glacial tones and is heavily shaded for such a young cat, but length and texture very good. A sweet tempered boy, excellently presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Premier Male

GD PC – Glaubitz's GD PR LITTLEFEAT DISTANT THUNDER (32a) MN 29/05/09. A handsome lad with lovely type and style, elegant yet substantial. Excellent head type with very good top line and large wide based ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape, set and expression with good depth of colour. Strong profile and firm chin, bite lacks incisors but looks level. Long weighty and firm toned body, long elegant limbs and spoon paws, tapered tail almost balances. Excellent rich red points colouring, typically paler on front limbs. Fabulous coat for length and texture, short close and beautifully sleek, minimally shaded to tone. Super to handle, a very relaxed and obviously well loved boy. Excellently presented.

R – Pounds' IMP GD PR JOMESE THE JOKER (32fn) MN 26/07/04. A dear old friend looking very good today, not without his little imperfections but still a quality boy. Long wedge but with very good top line and large flared ears to almost balance. Very oriental eyes with snooty expression and good depth of blue. Profile rather flat above the brow line and he has a small occipital bump, firm chin, no incisors but level gums. Very long and weighty body – somewhat more substantial than ideal but then he is an older boy, you can just about feel his slightly prominent manubrium, tail good. Super points colour, hot matte apricot, almost matching. Excellent coat for length and texture, with medium shading overall. Excellent temperament, handled beautifully as always. Excellently presented.

A.C. Balinese Neuter Male

PC & BOB – Webb's PR PIPPASTRO BOLSHOI (61n) MN 07/06/08. An attractive Bali boy of very good type. Strong wedge head of medium length with very good top, his large nicely furnished, with long and profuse flutings at the base, are set to balance. Oval shaped eyes that could be a little more oriental in shape and the colour is not as deep as ideal. Good profile chin and bite. Excellent substance to long body, strong limbs and well tufted oval paws, tail to almost balance. Lilac-based caramel points with good brownish overtones. Lovely coat for length and texture, flowing nicely over the body and frilling at the lower edges, lightly shaded to tone. Excellent temperament condition and presentation.
